

Instructions:

(Be sure to fully charge the speaker before using for the first time).

1. Charging the Speaker

 Open rubber seal cover, Connect the provided charging cable to a power source and to the micro USB port on the speaker (6).

The LED indicator light will glow red when charging and turn off when fully charged.

2. Bluetooth® Setup:

- Press and hold ON/OFF Button, LED Indictor will then flash BLUE and RED.
- Turn on the Bluetooth function on mobile device, Select "Diagonal BT" pairing name.
- LED will flash BLUE if successfully paired

- Speaker will automatically pair if the mobile device has been paired before.
- Press and hold ON/OFF button to turn off
- the device

3. Call Function:

- Press (4) once to answer a incoming call, press and press again to end call
- press and press again to end call

 Press and hold to reject the incoming call
- Press (4) twice to redial last called number from the speaker.

4. AUX Function:

- Open rubber seal cover(6) to find the speakers AUX-IN port, plug in supplied 3.5mm AUX cable into the port and connect to the mobile device.
- LED will turn BLUE when connected.
