



Pairing Your Device

Using the iBT68 Pairing is the set-up process to introduce your Bluetooth-capable device to the iBT68. Once your device is paired, the iBT68 can recognize it and you can play your audio through it.



- Turn on your Bluetooth device and make it "discoverable" by turning on Bluetooth mode Icheck in Options or Settings).
 - 2. Slide the Power Off/On Switch to ON to turn on the iBT68. The first time the unit is powered on, it will enter auto-pairing mode and attempt to connect to a Bluetooth device (if so, skip to step 4). Otherwise, follow step 3 to begin pairing.
- 3. Press and hold the Bluetooth Button for 2 seconds. The iBT68 will beep and the Bluetooth status indicator light on top of the unit will flash quickly.
