


Caller ID display


You can identify the Caller ID of an incoming call.

First,

The battery is not charged when it is first delivered to the user. Charge the battery with the provided charger before using VOSSOR.

Charging the battery with Cigar lighter adapter








• It takes about 4 hours to fully charge the battery.

■ External Battery LED Indication



Charger Connected

1. LED-Red Off : Done or suspend On : Charge-in-progress

2. LED-Green On : Full

3. LED-Yellow On: Medium

4. LED-Red On: Low **LED - Green/Yellow/Red (all 2,3,4 On) : Full

LED Indicator

1. LED-Red Off : Not under charging status

2. LED-Green Off : Medium 3. LED-Yellow Off : Low

4. LED-Red Off : Discharged



Setting up VOSSOR

First, place the upper holder of VOSSOR to the top side of the rear-view mirror in your car.
Push VOSSOR closely to the mirror and place the lower holder of VOSSOR to fit completely.





Tips Place VOSSOR in the center of the rear-view mirror in your car. If not, the sound could be diminished.

Setting up the Battery

Put the enclosed battery clip in the groove on the lower side of the battery.



Fix the battery using the enclosed clip.



Using the earphone(Option)

You can have a private conversation with the earphone.

For this function, please make the speaker mute by double clicking the Audio Transfer button(A/T).
Please refer to the Page 7 for Speaker mute.




Options for power supply

You can select an option out of as below;

Option1 VOSSOR+Battery

The first time you use VOSSOR, please fully recharge the battery first.

Option2 VOSSOR+Battery+Cigar lighter adapter

Pairing with a Bluetooth mobile phone

After pairing the Bluetooth mobile phone with VOSSOR, you can use it as a handsfree unit.

Power on

Turn on the Power switch.



Power off

Turn off the Power switch



Speaker Volume control

- For higher volume, press ▲ button .
- For lower volume, press ▼ button.



Microphone Volume control

In order to increase the volume of the microphone, press SEND and END button simultaneously until you hear the "beep" sound.

Repeat four times to go back to initial stage.



Speaker mute

Double click the Audio Transfer button.

- The speaker will mute after the beep sound is heard. (The sound will still be heard through the earphones.)
- To cancel the mute function, double click the Audio Transfer button.



Press the END button for more than 2 seconds.

•The blue LED will flash once a second with a melody.



From the handset, search for and register VOSSOR.

- Please refer to the user's manual of the handset.
- •Enter "0000" when a pincode(or passcode) is requested.
- when the pairing is completed, the blue LED of VOSSOR flashes every 4~5 seconds with a melody. If it flashes once a second, please try again from the beginning.




 Once your phone is paired with VOSSOR, it will automatically recognize VOSSOR.

I Pairing can be done with up to a maximum of 3 handsets. I

- VOSSOR stores up to 3 different phones in memory.
- Keep in mind that the latest phone number removes the earliest one when the memory is full.
- Priority is given to the most recently paired handset.
- If you want to change the handset priority, try to connect VOSSOR from the handset.
- If the latest paired handset supports handsfree profile, VOSSOR is connected automatically to the handset when the power is on.







Last number/Voice dialing

You can have a conversation with VOSSOR and use it as a handsfree unit.

Press SEND button.

- You can re-dial the latest number by pressing this button.
 (In the case of some handsets, voice dialing initiates)
- You can activate the voice dialing by holding this button.
 (If the handset supports this function)

Ending a call

• You can activate the voice dialing by holding this button.





Answering a call

VOSSOR plays a melody and the blue LED flashes when a handset rings.

Press SEND button to answer a call.

•You can have a conversation through VOSSOR.



Rejecting a call

Press END button to reject a call.



Transferring audio

Handset ⇒ VOSSOR : Press Audio Transfer button of VOSSOR while you are talking.

• It can be transferred to VOSSOR without ending a call.

 $\mbox{VOSSOR} \Rightarrow \mbox{Handset}: \mbox{Press Audio Transfer} \\ \mbox{button of VOSSOR while you are talking}.$

• It can be transferred to the handset without ending a call.



Call Waiting

To receive a second call while answering the first call, press Send Button of the Vossor.

•To get back to the first call, just press Send Button again.



VOSSOR does not turn on.

Check Whether the battery of VOSSOR is fully charged.	Charge the battery.
Check Whether the Power cable is inserted properly.	> Insert cable again.
Check Whether the Power switch is turned on.	→ Turn on Power switch.

Can not have a conversation through VOSSOR.

Check	Whether the handset supports handsfree profile.	In order to have a conversation through VOSSOR, a Bluetooth handset that supports handsfree profile is required.
Check	Whether the battery of VOSSOR is low.	Charge the battery.

Can not pair VOSSOR with the Bluetooth device.


Check Whether the power of VOSSOR is turned on.	Turn on the Power switch or insert the Power cable.
Check Whether the Bluetooth device is paired with VOSSOR.	∀ Turn on the Power switch.

No sound from the speaker.

Check Whether the volume status is at lower level.	Press the Volume up button.

Do not drop the unit from high places.




Do not modify, repair nor take apart at discretion.



Notes -
