

1. How to Use

a. Charging

- Open the Power Connector Outlet cover.
- Connect the supplied charger to the Power Connector Outlet.
 - When the Charger is plugged in, the LED light of the SFK509 will be Red.
 - When fully charged, which may take up to 3 hours, the Red LED light will be turned off.

Tip)

- Low battery status will be indicated with a beep every 10 seconds.
It is recommended that the device should be charged immediately.

b. Power On

- Press and hold the Call/Power Button for 2 ~ 3 seconds.
 - An ascending tone indicates the device is switched on.

c. Power Off

- Press and hold the Call/Power button for 3 ~ 4 seconds.
 - A descending tone indicates the device is switched off.

d. Bluetooth Pairing

- After turning the SFK509 on, press and hold the Volume Up & Down button for more than 3 seconds.
 - You will hear a melody and the blue LED light will blink every second.
- To search and register the SFK509 to your Bluetooth enabled handset.
 - Please refer to the user manual of the handset.
 - When asked for the Pass/PIN code during the pairing procedure, please enter "0000" (4 Zeros).
 - Once pairing has completed successfully, you will hear a beep and the blue LED light will blink every 4 ~ 5 seconds.
 - If the LED light still blinks every second, please repeat the pairing procedure from the beginning.

e. Adding Multiple Handsets

- The SFK509 can store up to 3 different handsets in its memory. However it can only connect up to one Bluetooth device at a time.
- In the case of adding a 4th handset, the first unused registered handset will automatically be removed.
- If you want to permanently keep the first registered handset onto your SFK509, manually connect the handset to the SFK509 before adding a 4th device.

Tip)

- Once the handset is registered to SFK509, it will stay in a paired mode until it is deleted.

f. Answering a call

- When the handset receives an incoming call, the SFK509 will ring and the blue LED light will blink rapidly 4 times.
- Press the Call/Power Button while the handset is ringing.
- To answer an incoming call while listening a song, press the Call/Power Button and get back to the current song automatically after ending a call

g. Last Number Redial / Voice Dialing

- For last number redial, press the Call/Power Button once until a short beep is heard.
 - ➔ With certain types of Bluetooth handsets, the user may need to press the Call/Power Button twice.
- To activate Voice dialing, press and hold the Call/Power Button until it beeps twice.
 - ➔ Please note that some handsets don't support this function

h. Ending a call

- To end the call, press the Call/Power Button.

i. Call Waiting

- To answer an incoming call while on the phone, press and hold the Call/Power Button for more than 2 seconds.
- To get back to the first call, press and hold the Call/Power Button again.

j. Speaker Volume Control

- Press the Volume (+) Button to increase the speaker sound, and the Volume (-) Button to lower the sound.
- The volume level can be adjusted from 1 to 8.

k. Transferring Audio

a) Handset to SFK509

- To switch from the handset to the SFK509 while on a call, press the Call/Power Button.
- The call will be transferred to the SFK509.

b) SFK509 to Handset

- Switching from the SFK509 to the handset can be operated from the handset menu options. This functionality may vary based on the type of handset.
- Refer to the user manual of your handset to use this function.

l. Listening Music

- After pairing the SFK509 with Handset, play the memorized song on your handset.
- Press and hold Volume(+) Button to play next song
- Press and hold Volume(-) Button to play the previous song
- To stop playback the current song, press the Call/Power Button on the SFK509 or stop playback on your handset

m. Using the Earphone

- Flip over the earphone outlet cover.
 - Do Not use sharp materials or nail to flip over the cover as this could cause damage to the SFK509 as well as to yourself.
- Plug in the supplied earphone into the earphone outlet of the SFK509.
 - No additional key presses are needed to initiate or continue a conversation when the earphone is plugged in.
 - When using the earphone, the speaker will automatically be muted.

3. Summary of Button functions

Function	Startrec	How to use button
Power On	Off	Press and hold the Call/Power Button for more than 2 seconds.
Power off	On	Press and hold the Call/Power Button for more than 3 seconds.
Speaker Volume +	-	Press the Volume (+) Button.
Speaker Volume -	-	Press the Volume (-) Button.
Transferring Audio (Handset → SFK509)	-	Press the Call/Power Button.
Paring Mode	On	Press and hold the Volume (+) and (-) Button simultaneously for more than 3 seconds.
Answering a Call	Ringing	Press the Call/Power Button.
Ending a call	Talking	Press the Call/Power Button.
Last Number Redial	Ready	Press the Call/Power Button once (a short beep is heard).
Voice Dialing (This feature is available only in certain handsets)	Ready	Press and hold the Call/Power Button until you hear two consecutive beeps.
Reset	-	Press the Reset Button
