Installing the Batteries

Slide open the battery cover on the bottom of the camera and insert 2 AA alkaline batteries with the correct polarity as appears on the inside of the battery compartment. Close the battery cover.



Installing the SD Memory Card

Insert SD Memory Card (up to 16GB) in the direction as shown *before* you begin using the camera.

Note: SD Memory Card not included.



You are now ready to capture images

- 1. Turn the camera on by pressing the "POWER" button.
- 2. Using the LCD display, aim the camera in the $\,$ direction of the object you wish to capture.
- 3. Hold the camera steady and press the "Shutter" button to start and stop capturing your video or to take a photo.
- 4. The video and photo images are automatically saved to the SD memory card.
- 5. When you would like to include yourself in the photo or video, simply flip the LCD display out and hold the camera steady facing towards you at arm's length (30~45 cm).
 - Make sure you can see yourself on the LCD screen and look at the camera lens.
 - Click the "Shutter" button to capture your image.
- 6. For instructions on how to use the other camera features including the Video and Photo settings, select the 'Get Camera Manual' option on the Main Menu screen or in the Help menu of the Hello Kitty
