## 1.2 Buttons

### Power button

Hold down the power button for 2-3 seconds to turn on the tablet  
When tablet is on, short press this button to turn off the screen and  
another short press to turn the screen back on

### Volume

Press Volume+/- to adjust the volume

## 1.3 Power on / off

### Power on

Hold down the power button (see 1.1) for 2-3 seconds, your tablet  
will boot up

### Power off

Hold down the power button, a prompt with the words **would you  
like to shut down** will display, press **ok** to shut down

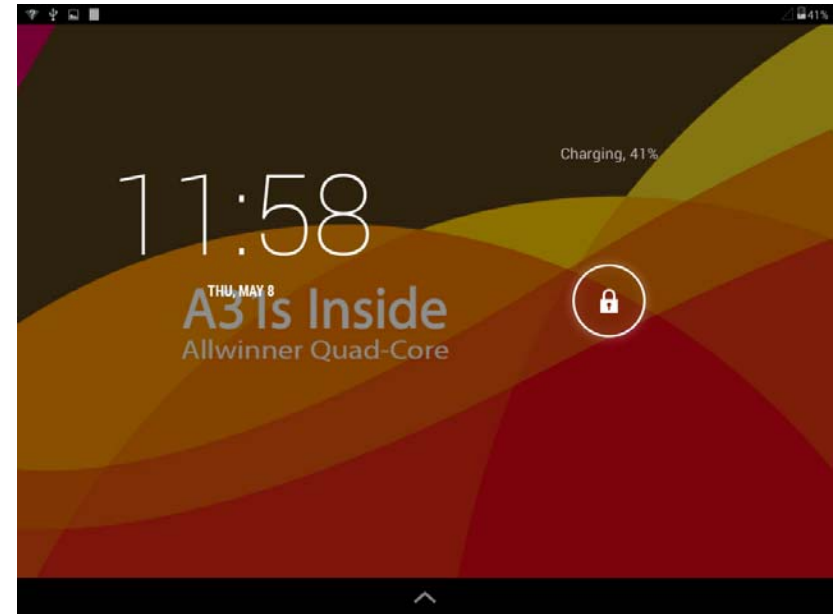
While charging, a short press of the power button will show the  
tablet is current **charging**; if you hold the power button, the tablet  
will turn on.

## 1.4 Lock and unlock screen


### Lock


You can set a lock timer under the **display** option.

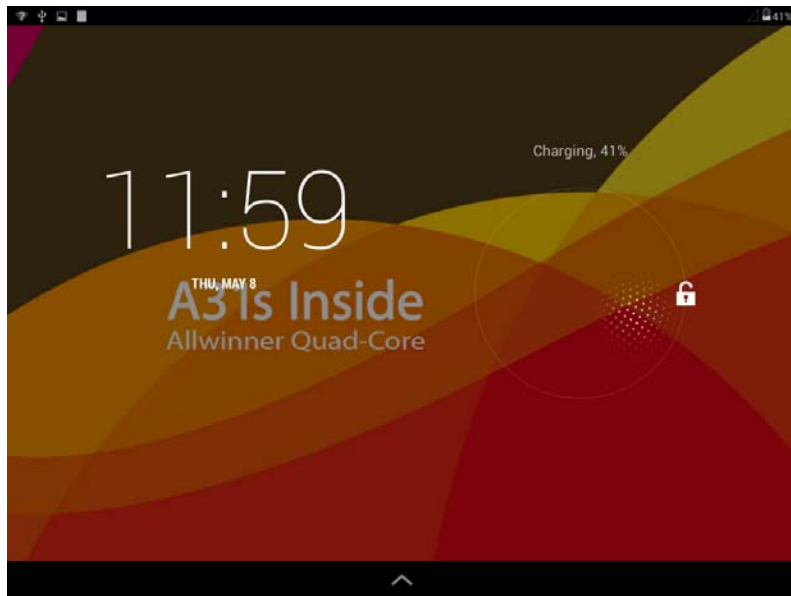
After a period of inactivity as dictated by the time out option, the  
system will automatically lock the screen and go into standby mode.



### Unlock

Move the sign  to unlock, show as below

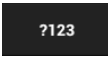


## 1.6 Text input

## 1.7 Reset

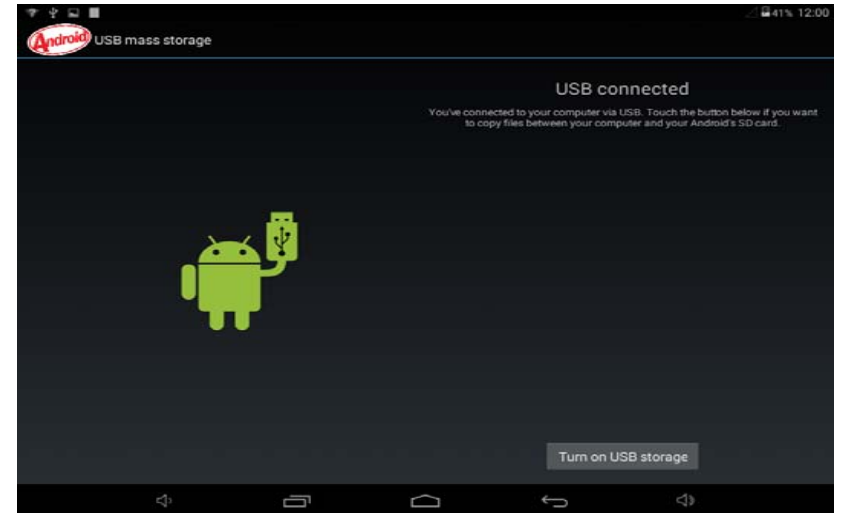
Press and hold the **power button** on the right side of the device for 1 minute, then you device will reset and restart.

## 1.8 USB connection

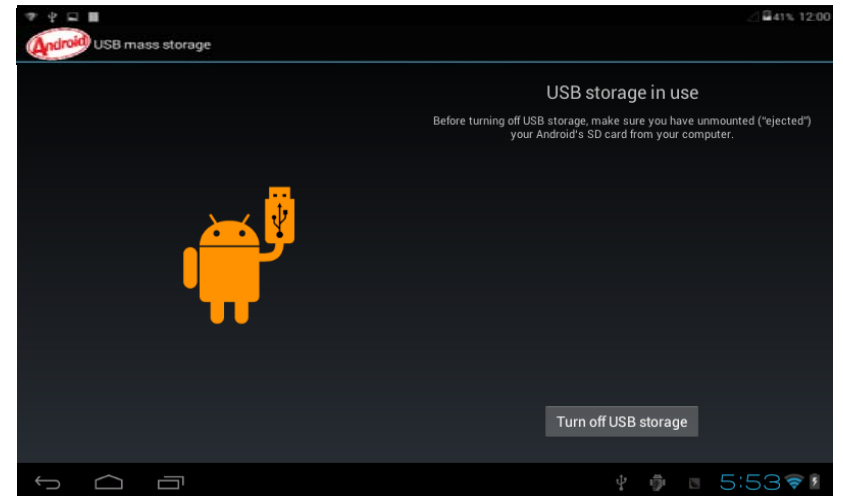
Connect your tablet to your PC with the provided Micro USB to USB

Choose **Turn off USB storage** to disconnect your device with PC




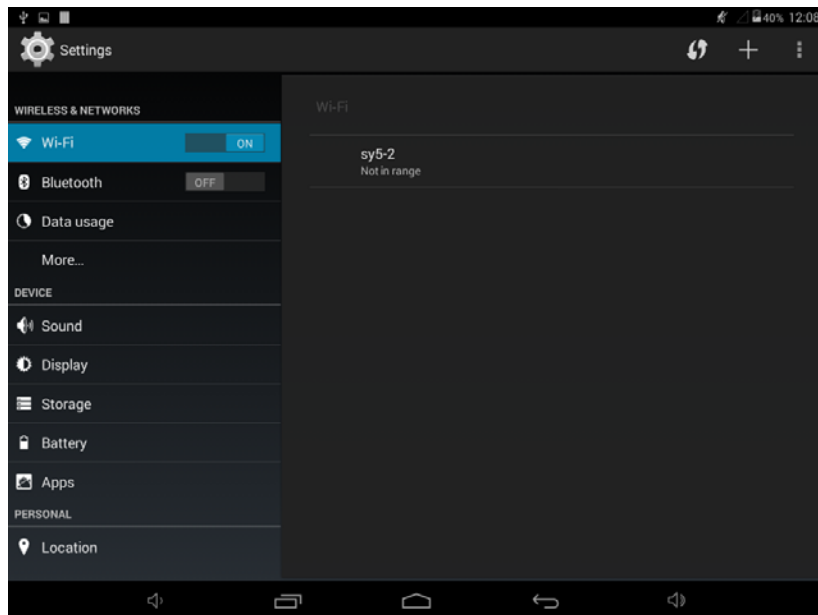
## 1.9 Accessories

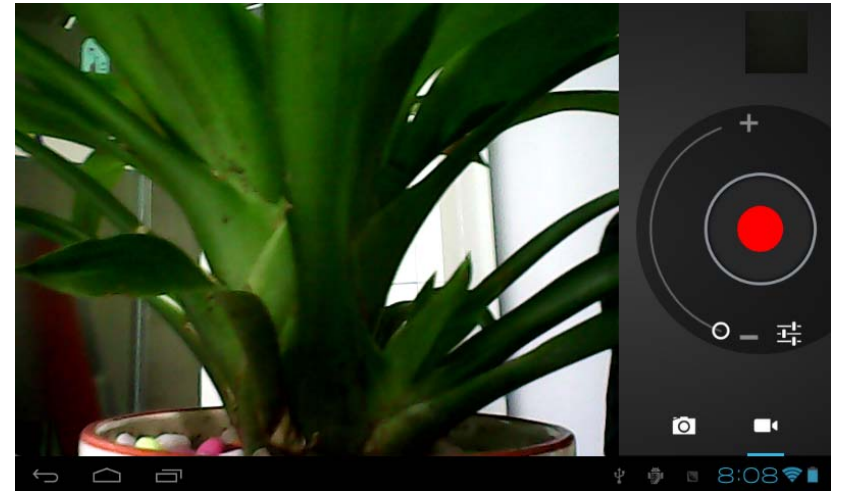
Touch the  to get take a photo



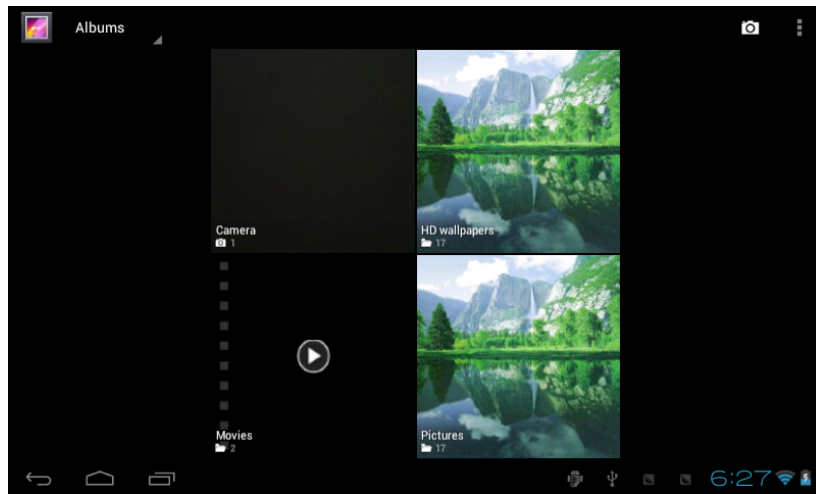
Choose  to take videos.

### 3.3 Video

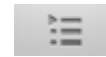
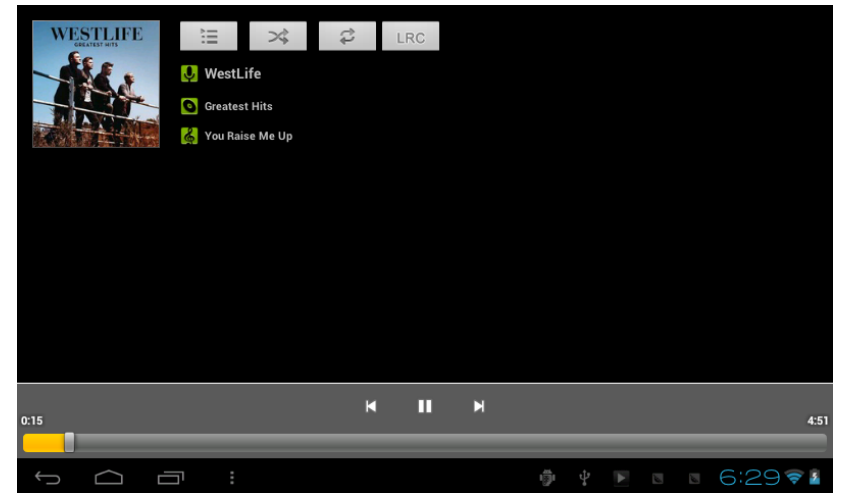
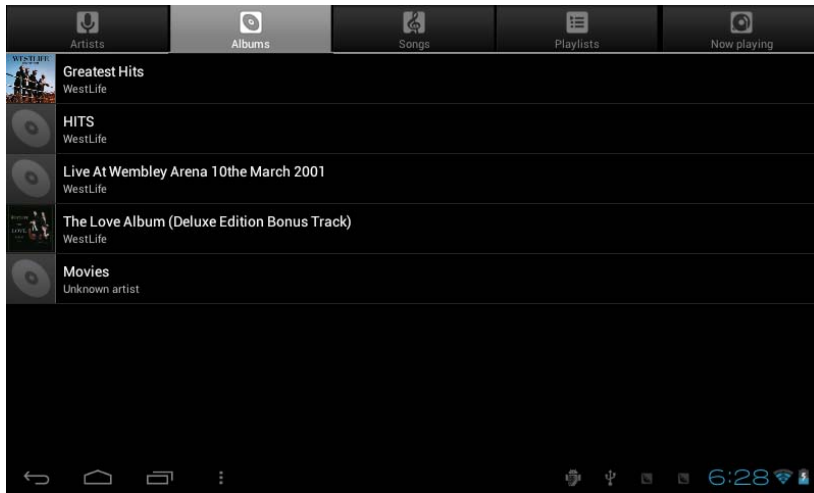
Use the  app to Play videos

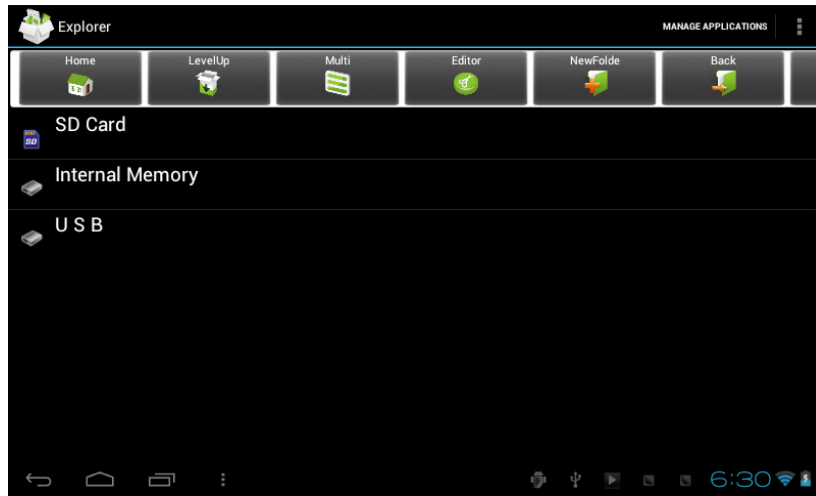

Choose  in the app drawer; this app is used to organize the various files inside your tablet.

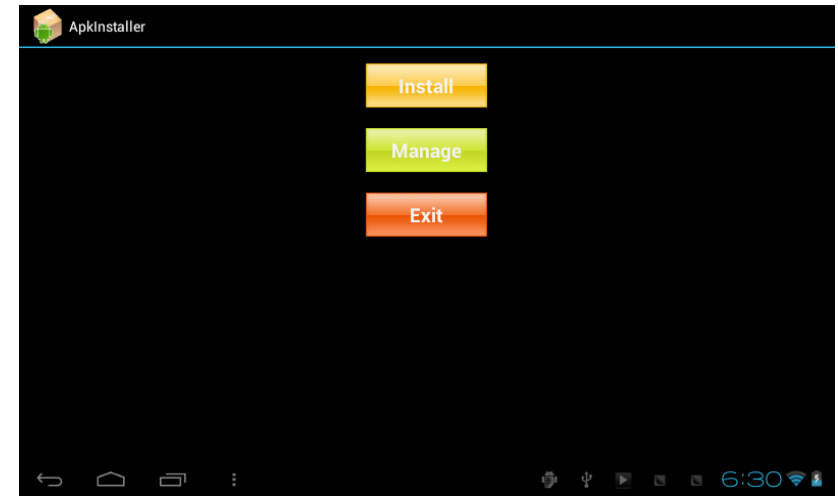


Touch the button  to do multi operations and edit files

#### Install

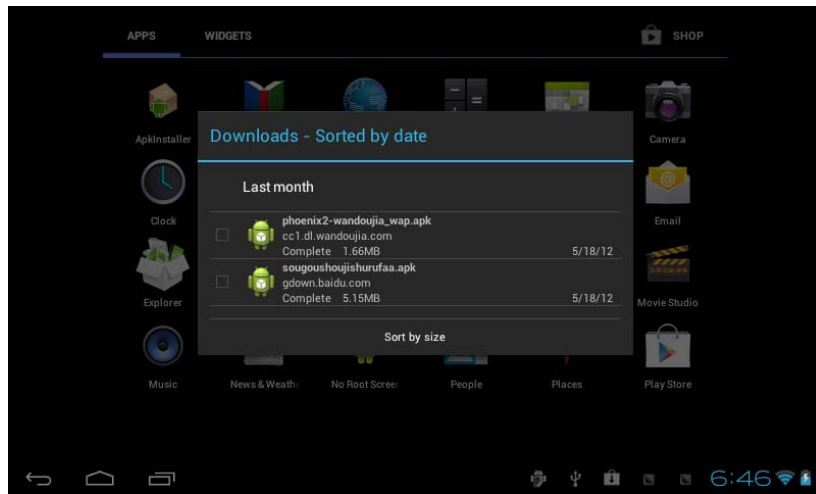
Click **Install** to install application.

### 3.7 Downloads

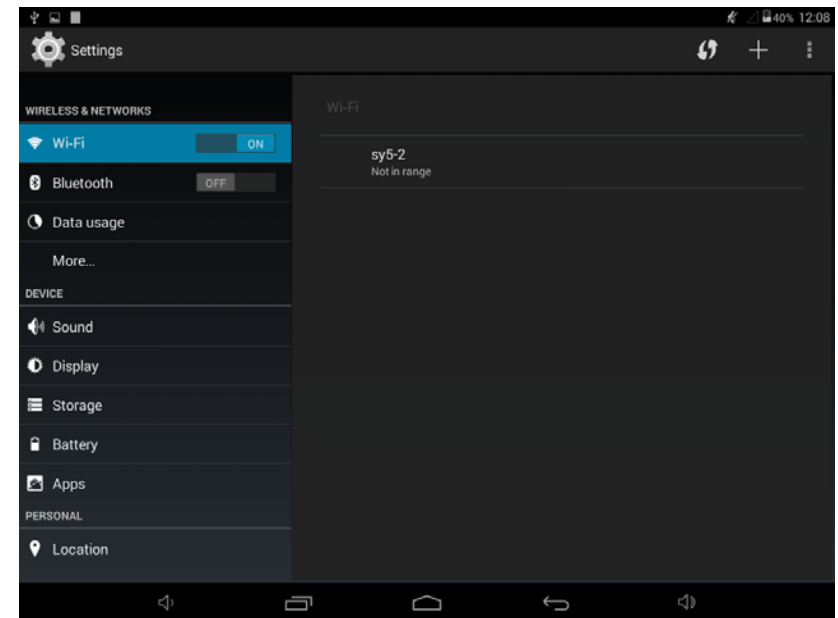
Choose  in the app drawer; you can check the status of current downloads as well as your download history.

Click here  to enter the system setting interface



### 4.1 Wireless networks setting

To connect your tablet to the internet, please follow the following instructions

1. Please turn on your WiFi which can be accessed via the Wireless and Network under settings
2. Please find the wireless network you are trying to connect to and choose that network
3. Enter your password when prompted – if you do not have the password that is a closed network and you cannot access it.

## 4.2 Bluetooth setting

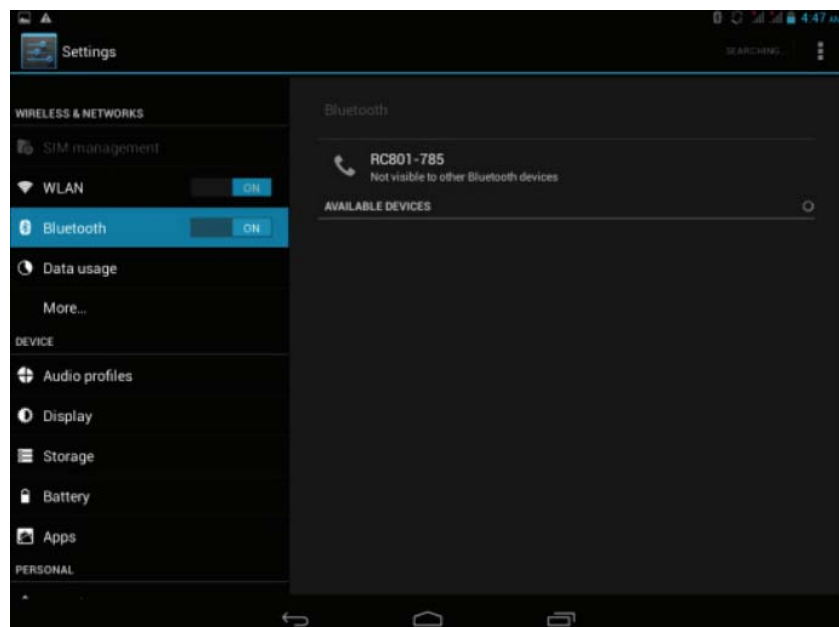
1. Turn on the bluetooth if it is not already on.

To turn on the bluetooth:

1. Go to the Home screen: Touch the Settings icon.
2. Open the launcher screen: Touch the launcher Tab, then touch Settings.
3. Open the notification bar menu:



Touch bluetooth icon



When bluetooth is on, the tablet will look for and display a list of available bluetooth devices.

Select an available bluetooth device in the list to connect to. If the bluetooth device is secured (as indicated by a Lock icon), the tablet will prompt you to enter a password or other credentials. Touch the bluetooth password box to show the on-screen keyboard and then use it to enter the password. Touch OK to confirm.

When you have successfully connected to a bluetooth device the notification bar at the bottom of the screen will show a signal



indicator.

## 4.3 Display setting

Display settings contains: **Brightness, Wallpapers Settings, Automatic rotating Settings, Dormancy time and Font size**

### **Brightness**

The user can manually adjust the brightness of the tablet.

### **Wallpaper Settings**

The wallpaper on the tablet can be changed via the Wallpaper settings.

## **Screen Timeout**

Choose how long before the screen shuts off to conserve battery.

## **Font size**

You can set up the font size according to preference.

## **4.4 Date & Time setting**

In this setting interface, you can set up your system time and series options.

### **Time setting**

To use automatic time from the network, choose the time zone; to time and date can also be manually set.

## **4.5 Language and input setting**

### **Input method**

In here the input methods can be set by users, words can also be added and removed from your personal dictionary.

## **Chapter Five: WARNINGS**

5.1 Please do not put your device in high temperature, moist or dusty places; the tablet is not waterproof

5.2 Avoid drops and collisions as it could lead to damage.

5.3 Do not disassemble or use alcohol, paint thinner or benzene class cleaners to clean the product.

5.4 Please do not use the tablet when driving.

5.5 Excessive volume via headphones can cause hearing damage. Please avoid high volume for long periods of time.

5.6 Memory capacity for your tablet is 8GB. Please note that system files and default applications will take up some of this storage.

5.9 Prolonged use especially during video playback and 3D gaming can result in excessive heat. Please avoid extreme temperature.
