


- 1. This product can only use the battery provided by the manufacturer.

- A. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screws of the side brush and the base decoration plate:




- B. Remove the base decoration board:


### **Product Use**

#### 1 Product Installation


A Before use, remove the foam strip beside the collision bumper.




B Connect the adapter to the charging dock, and put the excess cable in the slot, as shown in the figure.



C Place the charging dock on a level surface, keep the surrounding area open, and place it against the wall.



D Remove objects within 0.5 meters on the left and right sides of he charging dock and within 1.5 meters in the front. If the objects cannot be removed, check whether the main machine can return to the charging dock normally, otherwise please contact the customer service center for help.




E Connect the adapter to a wall outlet.



#### 2 Charge the Main Machine

- \* The main machine is pre-installed with rechargeable batteries, which must be fully charged before use.
- \* The main machine will return to the charging dock after sweeping or when the battery is low.

Method 1: Align the charging electrodes of the main machine with the charging pins of the charging dock and connect to the charging dock.





#### 3 Mobile Application

Scan the QR code and download and install the mobile application.

Note: When the mobile phone cannot be connected to the robot, please refer to "Product Use" – "Reset Wi-Fi".

#### 4 Use the Main Machine

#### Power On/Off

- \* Press and hold  $\bigcap$  for 3s to turn on the machine, then the ring light will be normally on in white, the voice prompt of "Power-on" is broadcast, and the main machine enters the standby state.
- \* When the main machine is stationary, press and hold \( \hat{\infty} \) to turn off the machine.
- \* The indicator goes out after power-off, and the current cleaning task ends.



Note: The machine cannot be turned off in the charging state. If the main machine cannot be turned on because the battery is too low, please carry the main machine directly to the charging dock for charging.

#### Sweeping/Pause

- \* After power-on, press () to start cleaning.
- \* In the sweeping state, press () to pause.



Note: The main machine cannot be used for cleaning up liquids. If the battery is too low, the sweeping cannot be started. Please charge the battery before starting sweeping. When the battery is low during sweeping, the main machine will automatically return to the charging dock to charge. Before sweeping, please arrange all kinds of wires on the floor (including the power cord of the charging dock) to prevent the main machine from dragging the wires, causing power failure and damage to objects or equipment during sweeping.

#### Recharge/Suspended Recharging

After entering the recharging state, the ring light flashes in white (in the low battery recharging state, it flashes in orange). In the charging state, the ring light breathes in white (when the battery is low, the ring light breathes in orange). When charging is completed, the ring light is always on in white.



Note: If there is a recharging failure, please check the surrounding environment of the charging dock, and manually put the sweeper back into the charging dock for recharging.

#### Sweeping Modes

- \* Start sweeping, and the machine will start the random sweeping mode.
- A Sweeping along the wall: The user uses the mobile phone APP to turn on the switch of Sweeping Along the Wall, and clicks to start sweeping. Then the machine will carry out sweeping along the wall. After half an hour, the sweeping along the wall will end, and the machine will enter the recharge mode.
- B Partial sweeping: The user uses the mobile APP to remotely control and make the machine move to the point to be swept, and clicks the sweeping switch on the remote control interface. Then the sweeper will carry out spiral sweeping in a circular area with a radius of 1m centered on this point.
- C Quick sweeping: The user can use the mobile APP to set quick sweeping, and the machine will carry out sweeping according to the bow-shaped path.
- (Note: Please do not use the quick sweeping mode on the carpet)

D Timed sweeping: The user can use the mobile APP to set timed sweeping, and the machine will start sweeping at the preset time and automatically return for charging after the sweeping is completed.

#### Reset Wi-Fi

#### Suction Adjustment

\* The user can use the mobile APP to switch between four suction modes: Quiet, Standard, Medium and Powerful. The default is the Standard mode

#### Online Upgrade

\* The firmware system supports online upgrades. For actual operations, please follow the internal guidelines of the APP.

#### 5 Restart the System

If you press any button on the main machine and there is no response, you can restart the system. Use a paperclip to press the restart button, and the main machine will automatically restart.



## Cleaning and Maintenance


Please turn off the machine and unplug the adapter before cleaning and maintenance. To ensure the best performance of this equipment, please follow the instructions below to clean and maintain the main machine regularly. The frequency of cleaning/replacement depends on the use conditions of the main machine.



#### 1 Clean the Dustbin

- A Open the cover of the main machine, then press the release button, and remove the dustbin.
- B Take out the filter assembly.



- C ake out the pre-filter, foam filter and high-performance filter.
- D Use a cleaning tool (which can be purchased separately) to brush the filters. The user can also rinse the filters thoroughly.




E Press the button on the side of the dustbin, and the dustbin filter will automatically open.



F Empty the dustbin. Tap the dustbin gently to knock off excess dirt.




G Rinse the dustbin and filter assembly thoroughly with water.



- Do not use hot water or any detergent to clean the filter assembly.


H Air dry the dustbin and filter assembly completely for further use.



- I Put back the pre-filter, foam filter and high-performance filter.
- J Put the filter assembly back into the dustbin.




K Put the components back into the main machine.



#### 2 Clean the Rolling Brush

- A As shown in the figure, press down the clasp to take out the protective cover.
- B Remove the rolling brush upwards.
- C Use a cleaning tool (which can be purchased separately) to clean the rolling brush.
- D Put one end of the rolling brush into the corresponding hole first, and then press it down into place.
- E Press the brush cover and fix the clasp.



#### 3 Clean the Side Brush

Foreign objects including hair are easy to entangle in the side brush, and dirt may affix to it. Be sure to clean it regularly. A Unscrew the screws with a Phillips screwdriver.



- B Carefully rotate and pull out the hair or thread entangled between the main machine and the side brush.
- C Use a cloth dampened with warm water to remove dust on the brush or straighten it gently.








 Please make sure the side brush is completely dry before use.

#### 4 Replace the Side Brush

After a period of use, the side brush may be bent or damaged.


Follow the instructions below to replace it.

- A Use a Phillips screwdriver to unscrew the screws on the side brush.
- B Remove the old side brush and put in the new side brush.
- C Tighten the screws to fix the side brush.




#### 5 Clean the Universal Wheel

Hair or dust particles tend to affix to the universal wheel. The universal wheel must be cleaned regularly or as needed.



A Pull out the universal wheel upwards.



- B Clean away the hair or debris entangled around the wheel or in the wheel cavity.
- C Reinstall the wheel and push it in till it clicks into place.



- Please do not rinse the universal wheel with water.

## Troubleshooting

When the main machine is running abnormally, the orange light flashes and a voice prompt is broadcast. Please refer to the table below to solve the error.

Error name	Error performance and solution
Left wheel error	The left wheel does not rotate, as the wheel is overloaded. Please check whether the left wheel gets entangled.
Right wheel error	The right wheel does not rotate, as the wheel is overloaded. Please check whether the right wheel gets entangled.
Off-the-floor error	The wheels are off the floor. Please place the sweeper on a level floor and restart it.
Seizure error	The sweeper is stuck and cannot move forward. Please clear the obstacles around the sweeper and restart it.
Floor inspection error	Please check whether the cliff sensor is dirty or blocked. Wipe the cliff sensor and move the main machine to another position to start.
Low battery error	The battery charge level is low. Please put the sweeper back into the charging dock for recharge.
Front collision error	Check whether the left, right and front shell collision switches work well. Check whether the front bumper is stuck.
Middle sweeping error	The middle sweeping wheel is overloaded or does not rotate. Please check whether the main brush gets entangled, and clean the middle sweeping brush.

Error name	Error performance and solution
Side sweeping error	The side sweeping wheel is overloaded or does not rotate. Please check whether the side brush gets entangled, and clean the side brush.
Wall inspection error	Please check whether the wall sensor is dirty or blocked. Wipe the wall sensor and move it to another position to start.
Fan error	The fan does not rotate, and the current is large. Please check whether there are foreign objects in the fan and remove them.
Dustbin error	The dustbin is not detected. Please check whether the dustbin is installed properly.
Charging error	The charging area is polluted. Please clean the charging pole pieces. Charging with liquid is prohibited.
Virtual wall error	A virtual wall is detected. Please move the sweeper to another position to start.
System error	Please reset the sweeper.
