

### Installing the Player

1. Remove the USB cover, and connect this product to your PC, as shown in the following figure:



2. Insert the CD supplied into your CD-ROM drive. Navigate to the CD directly, and then locate and double-click the wireless\_setup.exe file:



3. Click Next → Next → Install button in turn according to the system prompts:

4. After successful installation, a player icon appears on your desktop.



 Caution:

- The software must be installed even if you use another player; otherwise, images may be displayed abnormally.
- This product must be connected to your PC when the software is installed; otherwise, the software installation may fail.

### Playing Videos in Real Time

1. Switch on a camera at the same frequency as that of this product (you can adjust the frequency of your camera to the one same as that of the product only if permitted).
2. Double-click the player icon on your desktop. Real-time videos from the camera will appear on the software window, the operating indicator of the product will turn green.
