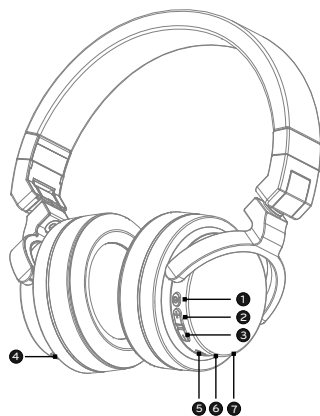

Operational guide:

1. Charging

Make sure the headset is powered off and connect the USB interface to the headset. Connect the other end to your PC or other USB power outlet. The LED will be red during the charging process and turn off when the battery is fully charged.
 When the battery level is low the LED will flash red twice every 5 seconds, and you will hear a beeping sound every 60 seconds.

2. Power on

Press the power button for 3 seconds until the LED is flashing blue and red. You will hear a voice saying «Power on».

3. Pairing

a) Press the Power button for 2-3 seconds until the LED flashes blue/red and you can hear the voice «Pairing».

b) On your Smartphone (or other bluetooth enabled device) do a search for new bluetooth device and connect to «Jensen Stadium BT». When you hear «Paired» the headphones are successfully paired and ready for use.

4. Power off

Press the power button for about 3 seconds. You will hear «Power off»

Button instructions

	Function	Operation
1	Power on	Press the power button for 3 seconds until you hear «Power on»
	Power off	Press the power button for about 5 seconds until you hear «Power off»
	Pairing	Press the Power button for 2-3 seconds until LED flashes blue/red and you can hear «Pairing». Search for new bluetooth devices and connect to «Jensen Stadium BT». When you hear «Paired» the headphones are successfully paired.
	Answer/End calls	Press once shortly for answering the call or end a phone call.
	Reject calls / re-dialing last outgoing call	Press and hold power button for 3 seconds to reject an incoming call. Press twice quickly to re-dial last outgoing call.
	Play / pause	Short press to Play / Pause
2	Volume up	Short press to increase volume
	Next track	Press and hold button for 1 sec. to skip to the next track.
2 + 3	Voice assistant	Press both buttons for 1 second to open the voice assistant on your smartphone (Google Assistant / Siri)
3	Volume down	Short press on to decrease volume
	Previous track	Press and hold button for 1 sec. to skip to the previous track.
4	Line in (AUX)	Audio input from your smartphone, PC, Laptop or music player.
5	USB charging part	Connect to your USB interface of your computer or any other USB power outlets.
6	LED indicator status	
	Pairing	Blue/Red light flashing
	Paired	Blue light flashing quickly once every 5 seconds
	Calling	Blue light flashing slowly once every 5 seconds
	Charging	Red light
	Low battery	Red light flashing quickly twice every 5 second
7	Microphone	Microphone for talking

Security instructions:

- To avoid hearing damage, do not use the headphones at high volume for an extended period.
- Do not use the headphones while driving.
- Keep the headphone far away from a fire source, freezing source, water or chemicals.
- Do not place the headphone in direct sunlight for long periods.
- Do not disassemble the headphone.
- Make sure to power off the headphone before putting them into a bag, pocket etc.
- Please charge the headphones at least once a each month.
