Heat



Outdoor Antenna Grounding

Be sure the antenna is properly grounded to provide some protection against voltage surges and built-up static charges.

Note to CATV System Installer

This reminder is provided to call the CATV system installer's attention to Article 820-40 of the NEC that provides guidelines for proper grounding and, in particular, specifies that the cable ground shall be connected to the grounding system of the building, as close to the point of cable entry as paractical.

Note: NEC 810-21(i)

A bonding jumper not smaller than No. 6 AWG copper or equivalent shall be connected between radio and television equipment grounding electrode and the power grounding electrode system at the building or structure served where separate electrodes are used.

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
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E) Front of DSR2800 C/I



- ① POWER: Press this button to switch the Receiver ON or OFF, or to switch it from the switchedon state to standby mode. When the Receiver is switched on from standby mode, the channel which appears is either the last channel which was viewed or any other channel which you saved in the POWER UP CHANNEL menu.
- ② CLEAR: Press the CLEAR button to remove the menu display from the screen. At the same time, everything you have entered is saved, so that you can immediately return to normal TV operation.
- ③ Channel Up(♠)& Down(♥)
- ④ Volume UP(▶) & Down(◀)
- (5) SEL: By pressing this button, you can activate any previously marked function or program.
- 6 MENU: If this button is pressed, the main menu appears, giving you access to all subsequent menus.
- To be able to receive scrambled programs, open the transparent flap at the front of the receiver downwards and insert the required card. These can be purchased from your local dealer. The receiver will then automatically recognise C/I card.

NOTE: When validating your C/I please ensure that it corresponds to the correct encrypted programs.

- (8) Display LED: It shows the Channel number when system is active.

 In OFF mode, It shows time.
- 9 IR Receiver: It Receives the signal of remote control.
