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Connecting via Bluetooth

You can record a video or take a photo remotely by connecting the remote control and the Samsung Gear 360.

1. **Samsung Gear 360** Press and hold Menu key.
2. **Samsung Gear 360** Press and hold Menu key until **Remote Control** is selected, and press the OK key.
3. **Remote control** Slide the Power switch to turn on.
The remote control and Samsung Gear 360 will be connected.



- When the remote control is not able to connect to the Samsung Gear 360, Press and hold the Shutter key for 10 seconds to reset it.
- Turn off the remote control when not in use.
