You can record a video or take a photo remotely by connecting the remote control and the Samsung Gear 360.

- Samsung Gear 360 Press and hold Menu kev.
- Samsung Gear 360 Press and hold Menu key until Remote Control is selected, and press the OK key.
- 3. Remote control Slide the Power switch to turn on.

The remote control and Samsung Gear 360 will be connected.

• When the remote control is not able



- to connect to the Samsung Gear <mark>360,</mark> Press and hold the Shutter key for 10 seconds to reset it.
- Turn off the remote control when not in use.
