SAFETY INFORMATION

Before using your new Samsung Side-by-side door Refrigerator, please read this manual thoroughly to ensure that you know how to operate the features and functions that your new appliance offers safely and efficiently.

This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities, or those who lack experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning the use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.

Because the following instructions cover various models, the characteristics of your refrigerator may differ slightly from the refrigerator described in this manual. If you have any question, contact us at 1-800-SAMSUNG or find help and information online at www.samsung.com.

SEVERE WARNING SIGNS FOR INSTALLATION

-  Do not install the refrigerator in a damp place or place where it may come in contact with water.
 - Deteriorated insulation of electrical parts may cause an electric shock or fire.
 - Do not place this refrigerator in direct sunlight or expose to the heat from stoves, room heaters or other appliance.
 - Do not plug several appliances into the same multiple power strip. The refrigerator should always be plugged into its own individual electrical outlet which has a voltage rating that matches the voltage listed on the refrigerator's rating plate.
 - This provides the best performance and also prevents overloading house wiring circuits, which could cause a fire hazard from overheated wires.
 - If the wall socket is loose, do not insert the power plug.
 - There is a risk of electric shock of fire.
 - Do not use a cord that shows cracks or abrasion damage along its length or at either end.
 - Do not bend the power cord excessively or place heavy articles on it.
 - Never unplug your refrigerator by pulling on the power cord. Always grip plug firmly and pull straight out from the outlet.
 - Damage to the cord may cause a short-circuit, fire and/or electric shock.
 - Do not use aerosols near the refrigerator.
 - Aerosols used near the refrigerator may cause an explosion or fire.
-
-  This refrigerator must be properly installed and located in accordance with the manual before it is used.
 - Connect the power plug in proper position with the cord hanging down.
 - If you connect the power plug upside down, the wire can get cut off and cause a fire or electric shock.
 - When moving the refrigerator, be careful not to roll over or damage the power cord.
 - This constitutes a fire hazard.

- Make sure that the power plug is not squashed or damaged by the back of the refrigerator.
- Keep the packing materials out of reach of children.
- There is a risk of death from suffocation if a child puts the packing materials on his or her head.
- The appliance must be positioned so that the plug is accessible after installation.
- You need to remove all the protective plastic film before you initially plug the product in.



- The refrigerator must be safely grounded. Always make sure that you have grounded the refrigerator before attempting to investigate or repair any part of the appliance. Power leakages can cause severe electric shock.
- Never use gas pipes, telephone lines or other potential lightning attractors as an electrical ground.
- Improper use of the grounding plug can result in a risk of electric shock. If it is necessary to use an extension cord, use only a 3-wire extension cord that has a 3-blade grounding plug and a 3-slot receptacle that will accept the plug on the appliance. The marked rating of the extension cord should be AC115-120 V, 10 A, or more. If a grounding adapter is used, make sure the receptacle box is fully grounded.



- If the power cord is damaged, have it replaced immediately by the manufacturer or its service agent.

CAUTION **CAUTION SIGNS FOR INSTALLATION**



- Allow sufficient space to install the refrigerator on a flat surface.
- If your refrigerator is not level, the internal cooling system may not work correctly.
- Keep the ventilation space in the appliance enclosure or mounting structure clear of obstruction.
- Allow the appliance to stand for 2 hours after installation.

WARNING **SEVERE WARNING SIGNS FOR USING**



- Do not insert the power plug with wet hands.
- Do not store articles on the top of the appliance.

- When you open or close the door, the articles may fall and cause personal injury and/or material damage.
- Do not put a container filled with water on the refrigerator.
- If spilled, there is a risk of fire or electric shock.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- Do not let children hang on the door. A serious injury may occur.
- Do not let children enter inside of the refrigerator. There is a risk of children entrapment.
- Do not insert your hands into the bottom area under the appliance.
- Any sharp edges may cause personal injury.
- Do not let children step on a drawer's cover.
- The drawer may break and cause them to slip.
- Do not overfill the refrigerator with food.
- When you open the door, an item may fall out and cause personal injury or material damage.
- Do not touch the inside walls of the freezer or products stored in the freezer with wet hands.
- This may cause frostbite.
- Never put fingers or other objects into the water dispenser hole, ice chute, or ice maker bucket.
- It may cause personal injury or material damage.
- Do not spray flammable gas near the refrigerator.
- There is a risk of explosion or fire.
- Do not store volatile or flammable substances in the refrigerator.
- The storage of benzene, thinner, alcohol, ether, LP gas and other such products may cause explosions.
- Do not store pharmaceuticals products, scientific materials, or temperature sensitive products in the refrigerator.
- Products that require strict temperature controls must not be stored in the refrigerator.
- Do not place or use an electrical appliance inside the refrigerator, unless it is of a type recommended by the manufacturer.
- Do not use mechanical devices or any other means to accelerate the defrosting process, other than those recommended by the manufacturer.
- Do not damage the refrigerant circuit.



- Do not disassemble or repair the refrigerator by yourself.
- You run risk of causing a fire, malfunction and/or personal injury.
- When the interior or exterior LED lamp has gone out, please contact your service agents.

- ★ Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- Bottles should be stored tightly together so that they do not fall out.
- This product is intended only for the storage of food in a domestic environment.
- If a gas leak is detected, avoid any naked flames or potential sources of ignition and air the room in which the appliance is standing for several minutes.
- Use only the LED Lamps provided by manufacturer or service agents.

- ✎ If there are burning smells or smoke, pull out power plug immediately and contact your Samsung Electronics service center.
- If you experience difficulty when changing the light, contact a service agent.
- If the product is equipped with LED Lamps, do not disassemble the Lamp Cover and LED Lamp by yourself.
- Please contact your service agents.
- If any dust or water is in refrigerator, pull out the power plug and contact your Samsung Electronics service center.
- Otherwise there is a risk of fire.

CAUTION **CAUTION SIGNS FOR USING**

- ✎ Do not re-freeze frozen foods that have thawed completely. Do not place carbonated or fizzy drinks in the freezer compartment. Do not put bottles or glass containers in the freezer.
- When the contents freeze, the glass may break and cause personal injury.
- ★ Service warranty and Modification.
- Any changes or modifications performed by a 3rd party on this finished appliance are not covered under Samsung warranty service, nor can Samsung be responsible for safety issues that result from 3rd party modifications.
- Do not block air holes.
- If the air holes are blocked, especially with a plastic bag, the refrigerator can be over cooled. If this cooling period lasts too long, the water filter may break and cause water leakage.
- If the refrigerator is disconnected from the power supply, you should wait for at least five minutes before plugging it back.

- If you have a long vacation planned or the refrigerator is not to be used for a long period of time, you must empty the refrigerator and pull out the power plug.
- Letting the refrigerator run for a long time without using it can cause the insulation to deriorate and may cause a fire.
- Wipe excess moisture from the inside and leave the doors open. Otherwise, odor and mold may develop.
- To get the best performance from the product:
- Do not place foods too close to the vents at the rear of the appliance as it can obstruct free air circulation in the refrigerator compartment.
- Wrap food up properly or place it in airtight containers before putting it into the refrigerator.
- Fill the water tank, ice tray, and water cubes only with potable water.

- ✎ If the product is flooded, make sure to contact your nearest service center.
- There is a risk of electric shock or fire.

CAUTION **CAUTION SIGNS FOR CLEANING**

- ✎ Do not directly spray water on the inside or outside the refrigerator.
- There is a risk of fire or electric shock.

- ★ Remove any foreign matter or dust from the power plug pins. Do not use a wet or damp cloth when cleaning the plug.
- Otherwise, there is a risk of fire or electric shock.

- ✎ Unplug the refrigerator before cleaning or making repairs.

WARNING **SEVERE WARNING SIGNS FOR DISPOSAL**

- ★ Risk of child entrapment. Before you throw away your old refrigerator or freezer:
- Take off the doors.
- Leave the shelves in place so that children can not easily climb inside.
- Please dispose of the packaging material from this product in an environmentally friendly manner.
- Leave the shelves in place so that children can not easily climb inside. Ensure that none of the pipes on the back of the appliance are damaged prior to

- disposal.
- When disposing of this refrigerator, remove the door/door seals and door latch so that small children or animals cannot become trapped inside. Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
 - Cyclopentane is used as in the insulation. The gases in the insulation material require a special disposal procedure. Please contact your local authorities in regard to the environmentally safe disposal of this product. Ensure that none of the pipes on the back of the refrigerator are damaged prior to disposal.

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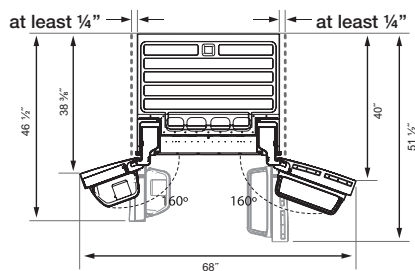
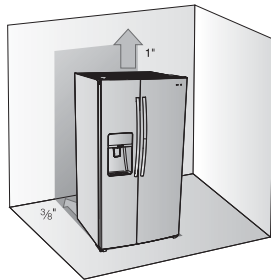

GETTING READY TO INSTALL THE REFRIGERATOR

Congratulations on the purchase of your Samsung Side-By-Side Refrigerator. We hope you will enjoy the many state-of-the-art features and efficiencies that this new appliance has to offer.

Selecting the best location for the refrigerator

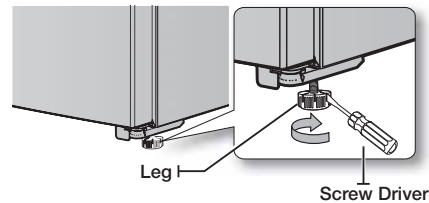
- Select a location with easy access to the water supply.
- Select a location without direct exposure to sunlight.
- Select a location with level (or nearly level) flooring.
- Select a location with enough space for the refrigerator doors to open easily.
- Refer to drawing and dimensions below for overall space required for use.
- Please ensure that appliance can be moved freely in the event of maintenance & service.



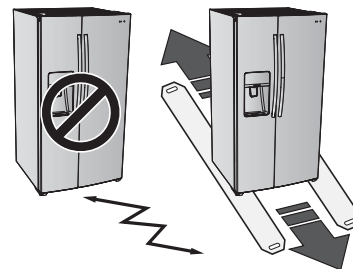
When moving your refrigerator

To prevent floor damage, be sure the front levelling legs are in the up position (above the floor). Refer to 'Levelling the refrigerator' in the manual (page 12).

To protect the finish of the flooring, place a protection sheet, such as packing carton under the refrigerator.




When installing, servicing or cleaning behind the refrigerator, be sure to pull the unit straight out and push back in straight after finishing.

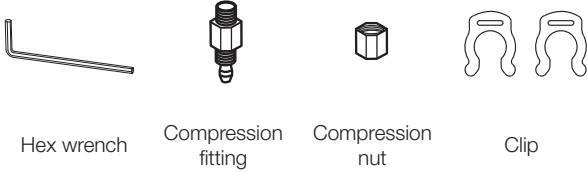


SETTING UP THE REFRIGERATOR

Now that you have your new Refrigerator installed in place, you are ready to set up and enjoy the features and functions of the appliance. By completing the following steps, your Refrigerator should be fully operational. If not, first check the power supply and electricity source or try the troubleshooting section at the back of this user's guide. If you have any further questions, contact your Samsung Electronics service center.

1. Place the Refrigerator in an appropriate location with reasonable clearance between the wall and the Refrigerator. Refer to installation instructions in this manual.
2. Once the Refrigerator is plugged in, make sure the interior light comes on when you open the doors.
3. Set the Temperature control to the coldest temperature and wait for an hour. The Freezer will get slightly chilled and the motor will run smoothly.
4. After powering the Refrigerator, it will take a few hours to reach the appropriate temperature. You can store food and drinks in the Refrigerator after the temperature is sufficiently cool.

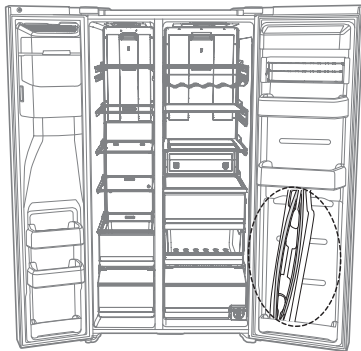

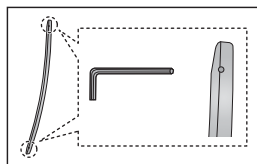
Hex wrench Compression fitting Compression nut Clip

Installing the handles

1. Take the handles out from the right side door. The handles are included in the package.



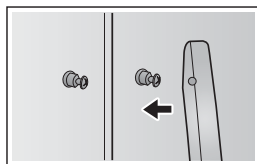
2. Check the handle and prepare the contained hex wrench.



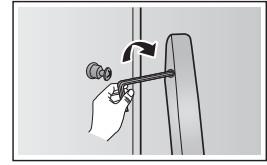
3. Attached the Handle to a Bracket Handle.



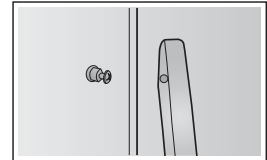
When assembling the handle, Check the serew-Hole direction.



4. Attached the Set Screw to a Wrench-Spanner.



5. Using a wrench, screw by turning a screw clockwise. And assemble the Handle.

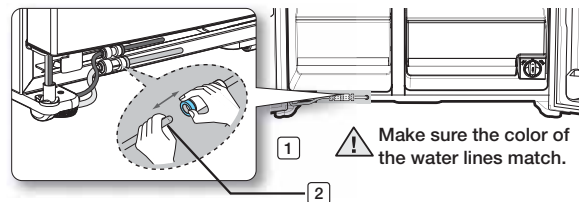


SETTING UP THE REFRIGERATOR DOORS

if your entrance won't allow the refrigerator to pass easily through it, you can remove the doors.

Separating the Water Supply Line from the Refrigerator

1. Remove two water lines (red one is for ice and the other one is for water) by pressing the coupler **1** and pulling the water line **2** away.

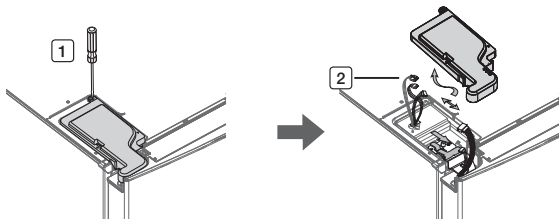


Removing the freezer door

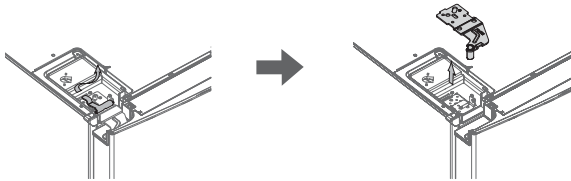
A few things to mention first.


- Make sure that you lift the door straight up so the hinges are not bent or broken.
- Be careful not to pinch the water tubing and wire harness on the door.
- Place doors on a protected surface to prevent scratching or damage.

1. With the Freezer door closed, remove the upper hinge cover **1** using a screwdriver, and then disconnect the wires by gently pulling them apart **2**.

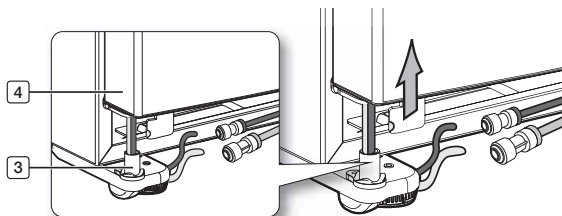



2. Removing the FIXER HINGE, and next take off the upper hinge. Be careful that the door does not fall on you as you are removing it.



 Be sure to keep track of all parts you are removing.

3. Next, remove the door from the lower hinge **3** by carefully lifting the door straight up **4**.



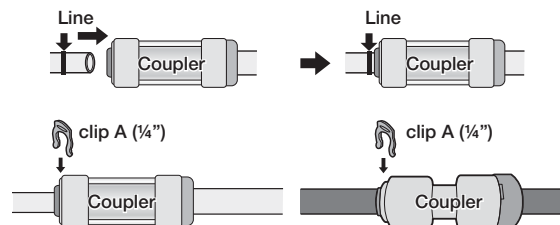
 Be careful not to pinch the water tubing and wire harness on the door.

Reattaching the Water Supply Line

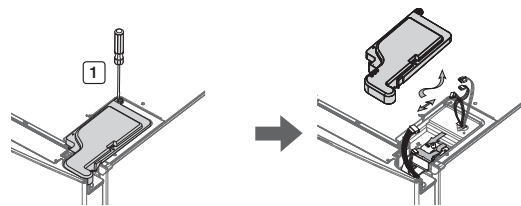
1. The Water Line must be fully inserted to the marked line to prevent water leakage from the dispenser.
2. Insert the 2 clips in the install pack and check that each clip holds the line firmly.



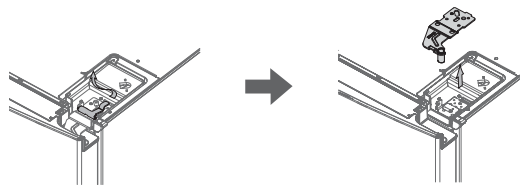
 Do not cut the water line. Gently separate it from the coupler.


Removing the Fridge Door



1. With the door closed, remove the upper hinge cover **1** using a screwdriver.

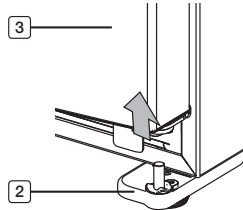


2. Removing the FIXER HINGE, and next take off the upper hinge. Be careful that the door does not fall on you as you are removing it.

LEVELLING THE REFRIGERATOR

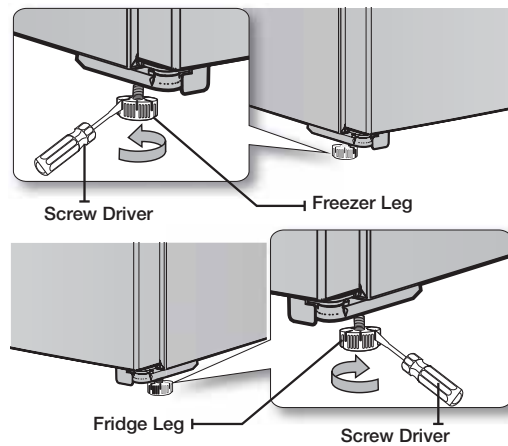
now that the doors are back on the refrigerator, you want to make sure the refrigerator is level so that you can make final adjustments. If the refrigerator is not level, it will not be possible to get the doors perfectly even.


When the Freezer part is lower than the Fridge part.

Insert a flat-blade screwdriver into a slot on the Freezer Leg, then turn it clockwise.

When the Fridge part is lower than the Freezer part.

Insert a flat-blade screwdriver into a slot on the Fridge Leg, then turn it clockwise.



 Refer to the next section for the best way to make very minor adjustments to the doors.


CHECKING THE WATER DISPENSER LINE

a water dispenser is one of the helpful features on your new Samsung Refrigerator. To help promote better health, the Samsung water filter removes unwanted particles from your water. However, it does not sterilize or destroy microorganisms. You may need to purchase a water purifying system to do that.

In order for the ice maker to operate properly, a water pressure of 20~125 psi (pound per square inch) is required. Under normal conditions, a 170 cc (5.75 oz.) paper cup can be filled in 10 seconds.

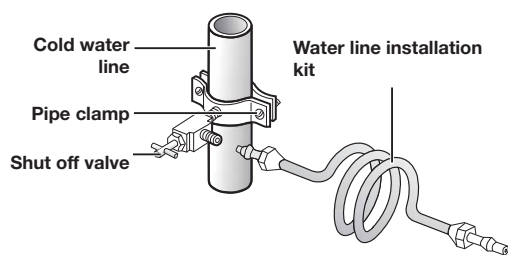
If the Refrigerator is installed in an area with low water pressure (below 20psi), you can install a booster pump to compensate for the low pressure.

Make sure the water storage tank inside the Refrigerator is properly filled. To do this, press the water dispenser lever until the water runs from the water outlet.

 Water line installation kits are available at extra cost from your dealer. We recommend using a water supply kit that contains copper tubing.

Connecting to the water supply line

1. First, shut off the main water supply line and turn the ice-maker off.
2. Locate the nearest cold, drinking water line.
3. After connecting the water supply with water filter, turn on water supply and Flush 3 gallons through filter before use (flush approximately 6 minutes).



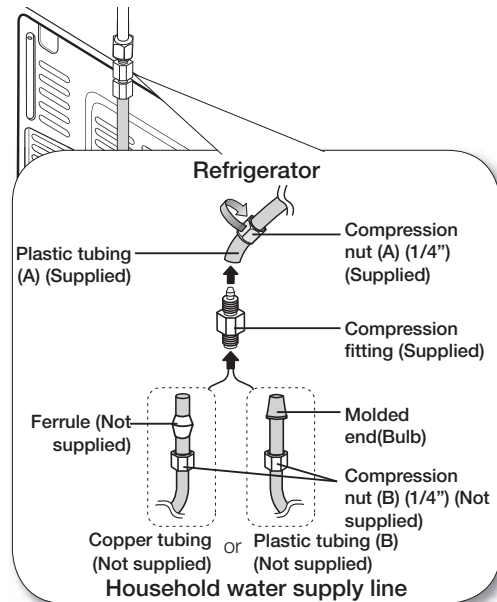
INSTALLING THE WATER LINE

Connecting the water line to the Refrigerator.


There are several items that you need to purchase to complete this connection. You may find these items

sold as a kit at your local hardware store.


• 1/4" compression nut	• plastic tubing
• copper tubing	• ferrule



1. Slip the compression nut **(A)** through the supplied plastic tubing **(A)**.
2. Tighten the compression nut **(A)** onto the 1/4" compression fitting.
 - If you are using copper tubing, slip the compression nut **(B)** (not included) and ferrule (not included) on copper tubing (not included) as shown.
 - If you are using plastic tubing **(B)**, insert the molded end(Bulb) of the plastic tubing **(B)** into the compression fitting.

 **CAUTION** Do not use without the molded end(Bulb) of the plastic tubing **(B)**.

3. Tighten the compression nut **(B)** onto the compression fitting. Do not over-tighten the compression nut **(B)**.
4. Turn water on and check for any leakage.

 Only connect the water line to a drinkable water source.

If you have to repair or disassemble the water line, cut off 1/4" of the plastic tubing to make sure you get a snug, leak-free connection.

BEFORE USING ICEMAKER

remove

- Hold the handle as shown in figure 1.
- Slightly pull up the bottom part.
- Take out the ice bucket slowly.

Install

- Assemble it in the reverse order of disassembly.
- Push the bucket in firmly until you hear a clicking sound.
- When the bucket does not fit into its place, turn the gear handle on its back by 90 degrees and reinstall it again as shown in figure 2.

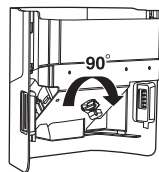
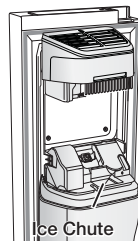

Before calling service

- Any sounds you hear when the ice maker dumps ice into the bucket are part of normal operation.
- Not dispensing ice for long periods may cause ice clumps in the ice bucket. Remove the remaining ice and empty the bucket.
- When ice does not come out, check the ice stuck in the chute and remove it.

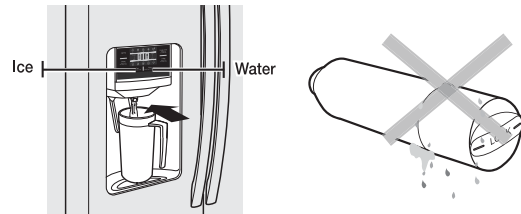


- When Ice Off blinks on the display panel, reinsert the bucket and/or make sure it's installed properly.
- When the door is open, the Ice and water dispenser do not work.
- If you close the door hard, it may cause water spilling over the ice maker.
- To prevent dropping the ice bucket, use both hands when removing it.
- To prevent injury, be sure to clean up any ice or water that may have dropped on the floor.
- Do not let the children hang on the ice dispenser or on the bucket. They may get hurt.
- Be sure not to put your hand or any object into the ice chute. It may cause personal injury or damage mechanical parts.

Removing residual matter inside the water supply line after installing filter.

1. Turn ON the main water supply.

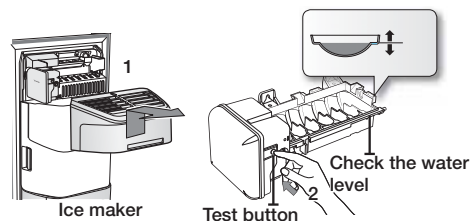
2. Press the Water button and push the Dispenser Lever.
3. Flush 1 gallons of water through the filter before use. (Flush approximately 6 minutes.) This will clean the water supply system and remove air from the lines.
4. Additional flushing may be required in some households.
5. Open the refrigerator door and make sure there are no water leaks coming from the water filter.



A newly installed water filter cartridge may cause water to briefly spurt from the water dispenser. This is due to air getting into the line. It should pose no problem to operation.

Check the amount of water supplied to the ice tray.

1. Lift up the icemaker cover and gently pull it out.
2. When you press the Test button for 3 seconds, the ice cube container is filled with water from the water supply tap. Check to make sure the amount of water is correct (see the illustration below). If the water level is too low, the ice cubes will be small. This is a water pressure problem from within the main water pipes, not the refrigerator.



- It will take a few minutes to reach the amount of water you want.
- Do not press the test button continuously when the tray is filled with ice or water. Water may overflow or ice jamming may occur.
- When the bucket is not installed, the ice maker does not work.
- When "Ice maker will not work when the ice bucket is not installed" message appears on the display panel, reinsert the bucket and/or make sure it's installed properly.

2. For the periodic updates of Weather or News, it may cause network traffics when the Display is not being used.
3. When there are softwares newly updated by Samsung, they will be automatically updated and it will be informed to the User.

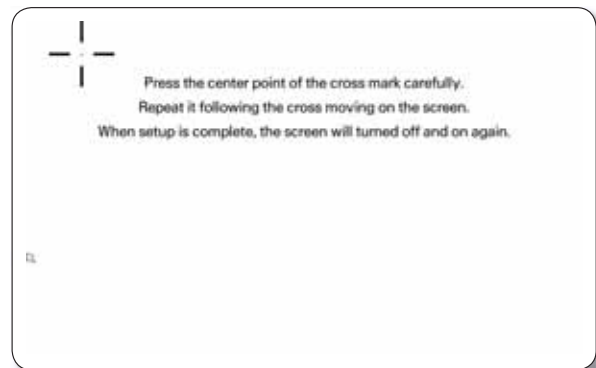

USING FIRST TIME

- When using the product first time after the installation, the following touch panel calibration screen appears on the Display Panel. According to the procedure appeared on the screen, tap on the center of the cross accurately. If the center is not properly pointed, the cross mark appears repeatedly.

After completing the touch screen calibration, its Home Screen will appear on the Display Panel. The touch panel calibration screen may appear again after the software update being completed.

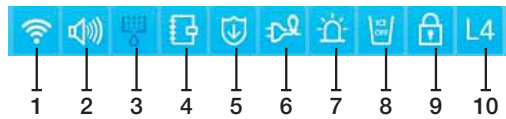


HOME SCREEN

- The Home screen is the starting point of setting all functions. Also, when the  icon is selected at all menus, it moves to the Home screen right away. On the center of the Home screen, the basic refrigerator information such as Time / Weather / Temperature / Dispenser Selection will show. The indicator icons at the left top of the Screen shows various information of the fridge and the bottom menus are the gates to each function.



Indicator Icons (At the left-top of the Screen)



1. Network Signal Strength : 5 Level (off - 1 - 2 - 3 - 4)
2. Volume Level : 5 Level (off - 1 - 2 - 3 - 4)
3. Filter Status : 3 Level (blue - pink - red)

6. Energy Saver
7. Door Alarm
8. Ice Off
9. Dispenser Lock
10. Smart Grid-Level

Date/Time, Freezer/fridge temperature, Dispenser selection, Current weather (At the center of the Screen)



1. Date/Time : Indicates the current date and time.
2. Freezer/Fridge temperature : It shows the current freezer/fridge temperature. When the freezer/fridge temperature is pressed, the temperature setting screen will be displayed.
3. Dispenser : It shows the current status of the dispenser. When the current status of the dispenser is pressed, the ice type selection screen will be displayed.
4. Weather : indicates the current weather. The Home screen background image changes in 8 modes based on the current weather and time. (Clear, Cloudy, Snow, Rain) x (Day, Night)

Menu Description (At the bottom of the Screen)



1. Memo : You can save or check necessary memos.
2. Photos : You can manage the stored photos, and can bring photos from the external devices such as memory cards or mobile phones and from the Internet.
3. Epicurious : It shows the food recipe.
4. Calendar : You can check your schedule stored in the Google Calendar.
5. WeatherBug : It shows the current weather and weather forecast.
6. AP News : It shows the internet news.
7. Pandora : It plays the Internet radio.
8. Twitter : It shows the twitter messages.
9. Settings : You can set the Various settings




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SETTING THE FREEZER/FRIDGE TEMPERATURE

The temperature control allows you to set the freezer and the fridge temperatures. Use the following instructions to change and set these temperatures.


1. Touch the Freezer/Fridge temperature on the Home screen.



- When ice cream is stored at a temperature above 4°F (-16°C) in the freezer, it may melt.
-  : You can set the dispenser type.(Cubed/Crushed/Water)
-  : You can move the home screen.
-  : You can move the preview screen.

2. Choose the desired freezer and/or fridge temperatures using the temperature buttons; then touch the Save button.



- The freezer/fridge temperature can be set as follows based on models.
-  Freezer : Fahrenheit : -10°F ~ 8°F(Default: -4°F), Celsius : -23°C ~ -14°C(Default: -20°C)
Fridge : Fahrenheit : 34°F ~ 46°F(Default: 38°F), Celsius : 1°C ~ 7°C(Default: 3°C)

- The freezer or fridge temperature may change depending on the door opening/closing frequencies, the food quantity, the ambient temperature, etc.
- Temperatures vary at each food storage section in the freezer and refrigerator compartments.
- When the room temperature increases, there can be an “Abnormally High Temperature” pop-up. In this case, when the Freezer and the Fridge temperatures become normal, the pop-up will be automatically cancelled. But, when the pop-up is not cancelled after a long operation time, please contact your nearest repair center.



SETTING THE POWER FREEZE/POWER COOL

The Power Freeze and Power Cool functions can be used to quickly lower the temperature of the freezer and fridge compartments. Use the following instructions to activate these functions.

1. Touch the Freezer/Fridge temperature on the Home screen.



2. Touch the Power Freeze and/or Power Cool button(s); then touch the Save button.



- To cancel the Power Freeze and the Power Cool, press the [Power Freeze] or the [Power Cool] button again or select a Temperature Setting button.
- Energy consumption increases during Power Freeze and/or Power Cool usage.
- When the question icon (?) is selected, its function description screen pops up. And, the [OK] button is selected on the popup screen, it goes back to the Temperature Display Screen.
- When you turn on Power Freeze/Power Cool, the refrigerator's compressor speeds up and is louder than during normal operation.

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SETTING THE DISPENSER


You can select the ice type, water and ice off.

1. Touch the dispenser status on the Home screen.



2. Touch the desired dispenser type; then touch the OK button.



- Touch the Ice Off, if you don't want to make more ice.
- When the Ice Off is set, the Ice Off indicator icon () appears on the left top of the Home screen.
- We recommend you stop ice making if the following occur:
 - There is enough ice in the ice bucket.
 - You want to save water and energy.
 - Water is not being supplied to the refrigerator.
- If the ice maker function is ON, and the water line is not connected, there will be a water valve noise from back of the unit. Touch the Ice Off on the DISPENSER select box.

3. Place glass in dispenser to dispense selected ice or water.(refer to HOW TO USE THE DISPENSER)

DOOR OPEN ALARM

When the freezer / fridge door remains open over 2 minutes, a warning window pops up with alarm sounds. After the first alarming, it repeats every minute. And, it stops when closing both doors. If the Door Alarm OFF is selected on the Settings function, alarming does not occur.



MEMO

This feature can be used to leave a memo for yourself or someone else.

How to leave a new memo.






1. Touch the Memo button on the Home screen.



2. Touch the New button.



3. Select the messaging tools as needed by touching the buttons upper the message screen. Enter the message contents with the selected tools.

-  : Select to input a memo in pen mode.(your finger or a smooth-tip pen such as a style pen.)
-  : Select to input a memo in keyboard mode.

3. Choose the wireless AP you want to connect.
 -  : Locked with Security Code
 -  : Signal Strength
 - You can check the MAC address of the Fridge on the bottom of the Screen.



- Touch the Search button, When there is no AP showing on the screen, select the Search menu at the bottom.
- Based on the wireless AP type, it may not make a connection. (It is recommended to use a wireless AP supporting IEEE 802.11 b/g.)
- For the wireless router, please contact your internet provider or do the installation by yourself.
- When you can't remember the name of the wireless network system (SSID) or its security code, please refer to its user manual.
- All the wireless network systems can be interfered by radio frequency signals and they may affect the product performances.
- The radio frequency signals of the wireless network system can be affected by the radio frequency interference from other devices or any other obstacles. (concrete wall, metallic door or radio frequency signal emitting devices such as microwaves)

HOW TO USE THE DISPENSER

Touch the dispenser status on the Home screen to select the type of ice you want. Place your cup under the ice outlet and push gently against the dispenser lever. Make sure the glass is in line with the dispenser to prevent the ice from bouncing out. When Cubed Ice is selected after using the Crushed Ice feature, a small amount of residual crushed ice might be produced.



CAUTION Please wait 2 seconds before removing the glass under the dispenser to prevent spills. If the Refrigerator door opens, the Dispenser does not work.

- Water Dispenser Installation After installation, press the dispenser arm for at least 2 minutes to remove trapped air from the water line and to fill the water system.
- Do not pull the lever out. You could damage or break the lever's spring.
- To clean the ice bin/bucket, wash with a mild detergent, rinse well, and dry thoroughly it. Do not use harsh or abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- In case ice doesn't come out, pull out the ice bucket and press the test button located on the right side of ice maker.
- Do not press the test button continuously when the tray is filled with ice or water. Water may overflow or ice may jam the bucket.
- Normal Use

To fill the ice bucket to maximum capacity after installation, follow these steps:

1. Allow your refrigerator to operate and cool down for 24 hours (or 1 full day).
 - Waiting 24 hours will allow your ice maker to cool properly.
2. Dispense 4 to 6 ice cubes into the glass.
3. After 8, and then 16 hours, dispense a full glass of ice.
 - When you press the Test button, you will hear the refrigerator chime (ding-dong).

When the chime sounds, release the Test button.

- The chime sounds automatically again to let you know the ice maker is working well.

CAUTION If a power failure occurs, ice cubes may melt then freeze together when the power comes back on, causing the dispenser to be out of order.

To prevent this problem, after a power failure, pull out the ice bucket and discard the residual ice or water.

CAUTION After you dump the ice from the ice bucket, you should press the dispenser lever once with the 'CUBED' or 'CRUSHED' function ON.



The ice maker will make new ice faster after you return the ice bucket in the refrigerator.

- If you use all the ice at once, you must repeat Steps 2 and 3 on the previous page. However, only wait 8 hours before dispensing the first 4 to 6 ice cubes. This will replenish the ice cubes and ensure maximum ice production.

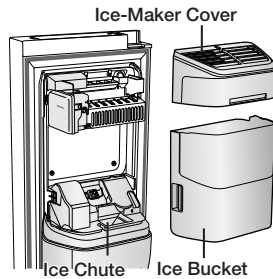
WARNING Do not put your fingers, hands or any other unsuitable objects in the chute or ice-maker bucket.

- It may result in personal injury or material damage.

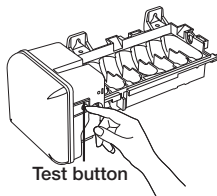
If you have a long vacation or business trip and won't use the water or ice dispensers, close the water valve.

- Otherwise, water leakage may occur.
- When you have not used the Ice maker for a while, or you have opened the Freezer door frequently, the Ice may stick together. If this has occurred, empty the ice bucket or break up the ice with a wood kitchen tool. Do not use sharp items such as knives or forks.
- When the bucket is removed, there may still be some residual ice in the ice maker that will be produced.



In case ice doesn't come out, pull out the icemaker cover and press test button located on the ice maker.

- Do not press the test button continuously when the tray is filled with ice or water as illustration below. Water may overflow or ice jamming may occur.

-  A newly installed water filter cartridge may cause water to briefly spurt from the water dispenser. This is due to air getting into the line. It should pose no problem to operation.

Reverse Osmosis Water Supply

IMPORTANT : The pressure of the water supply coming out of a reverse osmosis system going to the water inlet valve of the refrigerator needs to be between 35 and 120 psi (241 and 827 kPa).

If a reverse osmosis water filtration system is connected to your cold water supply, the water pressure to the reverse osmosis system needs to be a minimum of 40 to 60 psi (276 to 414 kPa.)

If the water pressure to the reverse osmosis system is less than 40 to 60 psi (276 to 414 kPa):

- Check to see whether the sediment filter in the reverse osmosis system is blocked. Replace the filter if necessary.
- Allow the storage tank on the reverse osmosis system to refill after heavy usage.
- If your refrigerator has a water filter, it may further reduce the water pressure when used in conjunction with a reverse osmosis system. Remove the water filter.

If you have questions about your water pressure, call a licensed, qualified plumber.

Ordering replacement filters

To order more water filter cartridges, contact your authorized Samsung dealer.
