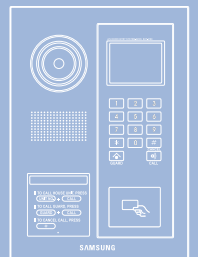


Federal Communication Commission Interference Statement

Warning

Keep the product away from any heat sources: radiators or direct sunlight; they may cause product distortion or fire.



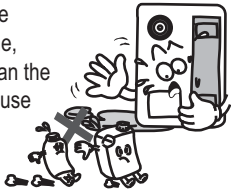

Do not touch the product with wet hands; this may cause electrocution. The product may break if it becomes wet or placed under water.



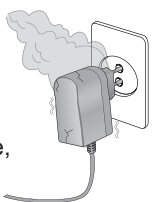

Do not throw the product; this may cause product breakage or injury. Do not hang onto the product or pull it down; this may cause you to fall down with it and suffer injuries.

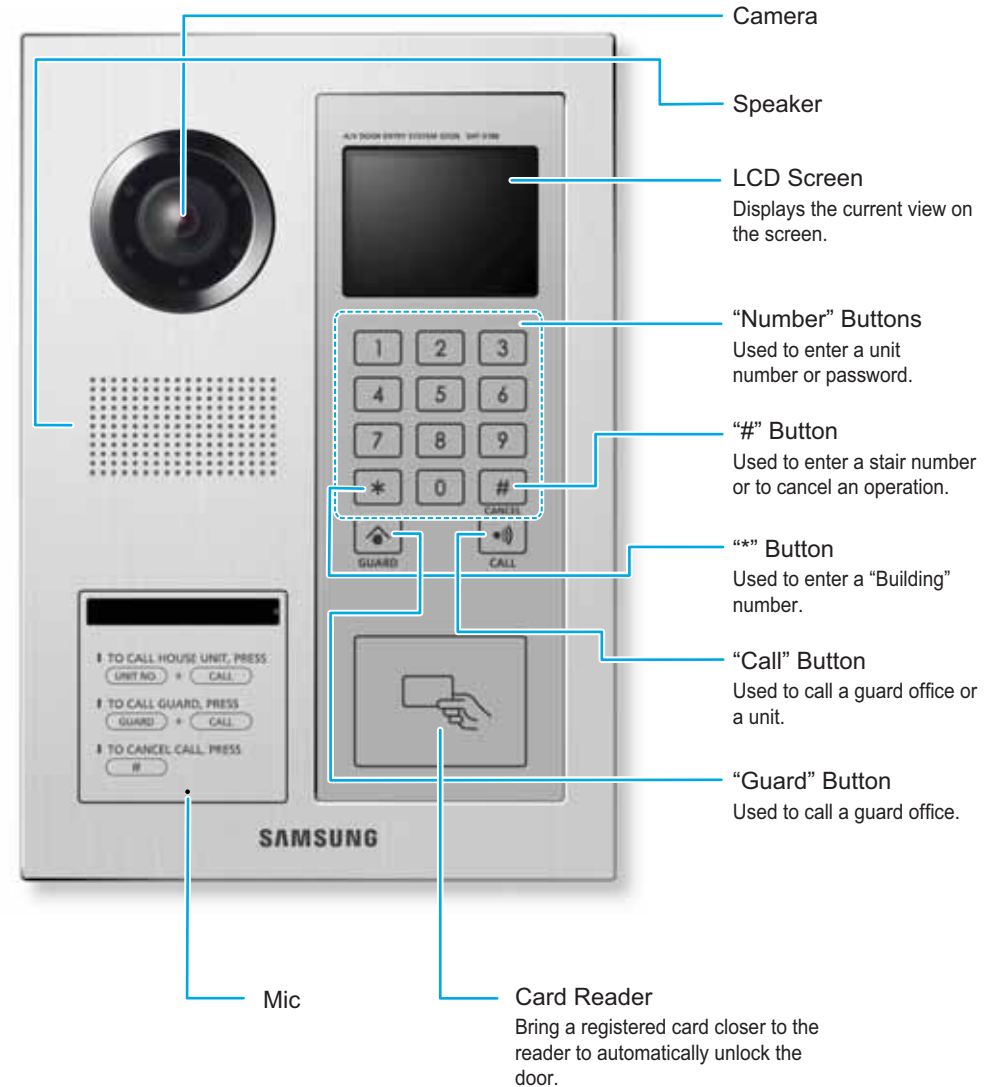

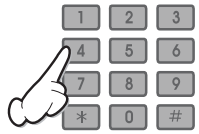
Do not use the product in connection with untested equipment; this may prevent the product's proper operation.

Operation Guidelines

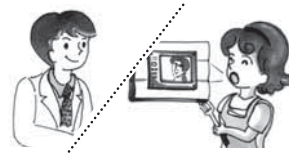
How to Speak to the Unit



Enter the "unit number" of the person you would like to speak to.



Press the "Call" button.



Speak if someone inside the unit responds.



Note

- If no one responds your call within 40 seconds, the call will be hung up.

How to Speak to Guard Office



Press the "Guard" button.



Press the "Call" button.



Speak if someone inside the guard office responds.

- ※ If no one responds to your call within 40 seconds, the call will be hung up.

Fire Alarm (Optional)



If a fire alarm signal is received from a unit or the fire alarm system, the fire alarm message is displayed on a Building's lobby LCD screen.



A voice message alerting, "Building Unit Fire," will repeat continuously.



The automatic lobby door will be open.



Note

- If a fire alarm signal has started from a unit, pressing "#" at the unit or control server ends cancels the alarm.

How to Open a Building Lobby Door

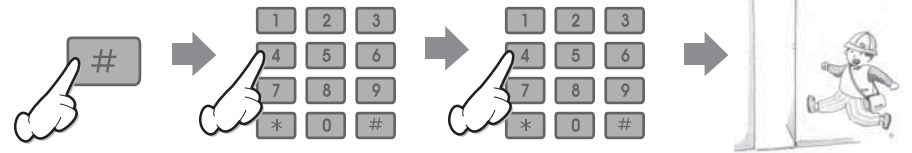
◀ Opening the door while speaking to a unit

Press the "Open Door" button at the unit end to open the automatic lobby door for 7 seconds.

◀ Opening the door while speaking to a guard office

Press the "Open Door" button at the guard office end to open the automatic lobby door for 7 seconds.

◀ Opening the door with personal password



Press the "#"
button.

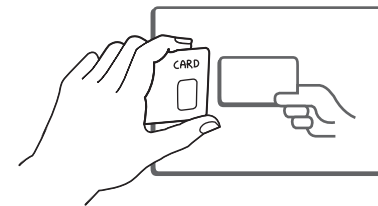
Enter 4-digit "ID."

Enter 4-digit
"password".

If the password
is confirmed, the
automatic lobby
door opens for 7
seconds.

- ※ ID and password must be registered prior to use.

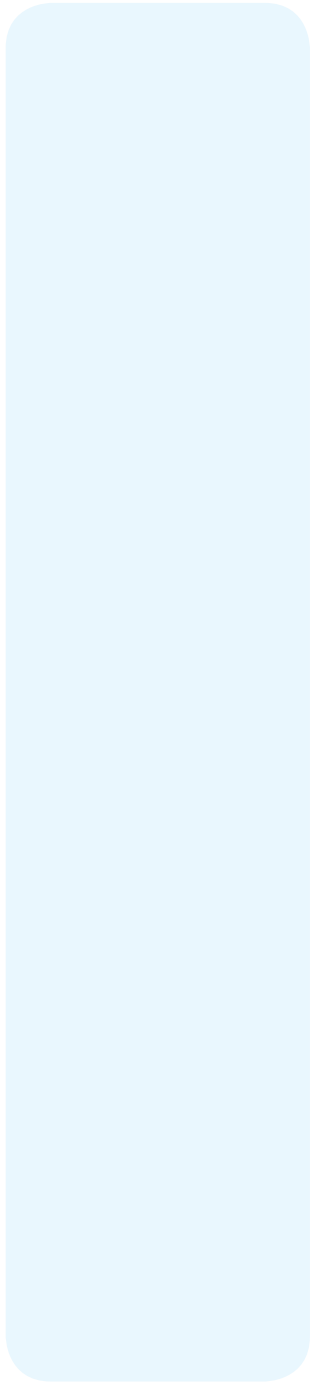
◀ Opening the door with a card



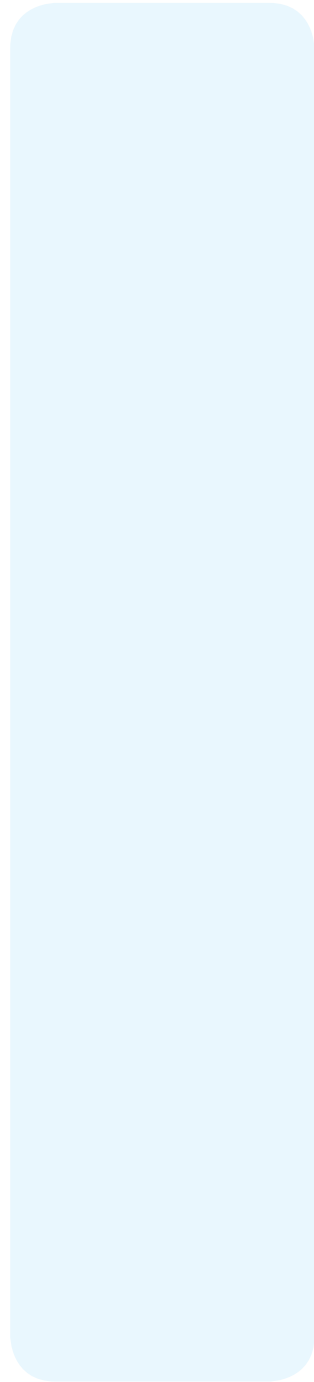
Bring a registered card close to the reader to open the automatic lobby door for 7 seconds.

- ※ Card must be registered prior to use.
