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## How to Wear

## How to Connect

### Pair the Bluetooth headset for the first time:

1. With the headset power off, hold and press the "MFB" until the headset is in pairing mode, red indicator light and blue indicator light flash alternately.
2. Active the Bluetooth function on your phone and search Bluetooth devices
3. Select "Ring" for pairing, input pairing code "0000" if needed

### Connect Automatically

1. With the headset power off, short press the "MFB" to power on
2. The "Ring" will search and connect with the last connected device.

### How to connect with 2 devices

1. After paired the first mobile phone, please turn off the Bluetooth function of the first mobile phone.
2. Pair the headset with the second mobile phone.
3. Active the Bluetooth function of the first mobile phone, manual connection with the first mobile phone.

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## How to use

**Protective film:** Please do not remove the film in order to protect from scratches when the earbuds are attached to each other.

### Function of Call and Music

Call	Power on	Long press the "MFB" for about 1 second, and the blue indicator light flashes once
	Power off	Long press the "MFB" for about 3 seconds, the indicator light goes off
	Standby Mode	The blue indicator light flashes once every 5 seconds
	Answering a Call	Press the answer key on your phone or short press any button on your headset or detach the left and right earbud
	Ending a Call	Press the end key on your phone or short press the "MFB" on your headset or adhere the left and right earbud
Rejecting a Call	Press the end key on your phone or long press the "V-" for about 1 second	

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Three-way calling	Redialing the Last Called Number	Double press the "MFB" when headset is in standby mode.(Your phone must support this function)
	Muting Switching	Long press the "V-" for about 1 second during a call
	Voice dialing	Long press the "MFB" for about 1 second when headset is in standby mode. (Your phone must support this function)
Music	Ending/ Answering	Short press the "MFB" to end the current call and answer the waiting call
	Call Switching	Double press the "MFB" to switch phone calls
	Ending	Short press the "MFB" to end the call one by one
	Play/ Pause	Short press the "MFB" when music playing Or Adhere the left and right earbud to pause
Previous Track	Long press the "V-" for about 1 second to previous track	
	Next Track	Long press the "V+" for about 1 second to next track
Volume Control	Short press the "V+" or "V-" to control the volume	

Tip: When playing music, adhere the left and right earbud will end the call, short press the "MFB" to pause the music.

	Charging time	Fully charge in about 3 hours
Low Power	Charging Status	The red indicator light remains solid while charging. The indicator light will turn blue when charging is complete
	Low Power Alarm	There will be low power alarm when the voltage is lower than 3.3V
Voice Prompt	Power off automatically	The headset will be power off when the voltage is lower than 3V
	Power on Signal	The blue indicator light flashes once and there will be the automatic voice prompt "power on"
	Power off Signal	The red indicator light flashes 1 second and goes off, there will be the automatic voice prompt "power off"
Incoming Number Report	The headset will report the incoming number when call comes in	

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## Service Regulations and Explanation

### After service

#### (A) Service system

1.Consultancies: Please read this user manual carefully before using this product.

2.Exchange service: within exchange time limit, for any indeliberate error during proper use, making sure the product as well as its accessories and package are all not damaged (if the appearance is damaged, it can only be repaired) you can either have it. exchanged for a new one or repaired after the error is tested and examined;

3.Warranty service: within the warranty time limit, for any indelibe-rate error that occurs during proper use, warranty service is free for no charge (the headphone has warranty service for free within one year, for any deliberate damage, the warranty service should be paid).

4.Charged warranty service: within three years counting from one year after the date the product was purchased, any error repair will be charged; and user should pay the repair components, freight and labor cost.

5.Any of the below situation is not in the warranty service, but we provide charged service:

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- ① The warranty date is expired;
- ② The warranty card is altered, or the series number differs from that of the product;
