OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

BATTERY LOADING

(FOR MAXIMUM PERFORMANCE, USE ALKALINE BATTERIES) Remember to take out all batteries from car and transmitter after playing.

- · Do not mix old and new batteries.
- · Do not mix alkaline, standard (Carbon-Zinc), or rechargeable (Nickel-Cadmium) batteries.

VEHICLE

- 1. Slide the ON/OFF switch at the bottom of the vehicle to the "OFF" position. (See Diagram 1)
- 2. Unscrew to open battery case cover and insert 4 X 'AA' size battery as indicated, following the engraved (+) (-) signs. (See Diagram 1)
- 3. Replace the battery case cover.

TRANSMITTER

- 1. Slide open the battery case cover from the back of the transmitter and put 1 x 9volt battery inside following the engraved (+) (-) signs. (See Diagram 2)
- 2. Replace the battery case cover.

NOTE: REMOVE ALL BATTERIES AFTER YOU HAVE FINISHED USING YOUR VEHICLE.


HOW TO PLAY


- A. Slide the ON/OFF switch at bottom of the vehicle to the "ON" position. (See Diagram 1)
- B. Push the control stick of the transmitter (control unit) forward, the vehicle will run straight forward. (See Diagram 3)
- C. Pull the control stick of the transmitter (control unit) backward, the vehicle will run backward in a circular path. (See Diagram 4)
- D. Release the control stick of the transmitter, the vehicle will stop. (See Diagram 5)

PERFORMANCE TIPS:


- Don't drive in grass, sand or carpet.

- Be sure to rest your vehicle for at least 30 minutes after every 15 minutes of operation.
- Make sure ON/OFF switch on your vehicle is OFF when not in use.

- Don't leave the vehicle or transmitter near sources of heat or under direct sunlight for
