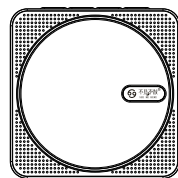
**Notes**

- Long time high volume may cause hearing impairment, please adjust the volume appropriately when listening, especially for long time listening.

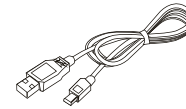

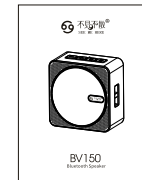

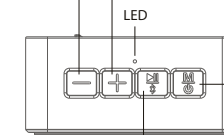

**Buttons & Slots**

**Buttons Instruction**

**Previous/Vol-** : Short press to previous song, press and hold to decrease the volume.

**Next/Vol+** : Press to next song, press and hold to increase the volume.



**Power key:**  
Press and hold 2 seconds to power on /off  
Short press to switch the mode when the speaker is powered on.

**Pause /Play:**

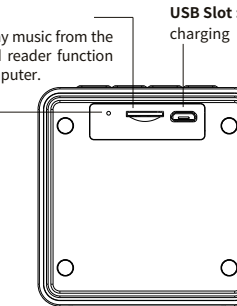
**Short press** : Pause/play. Press and hold to disconnect the Bluetooth device when the Bluetooth paired , short press to reconnect the Bluetooth device when the Bluetooth disconnected.

**Micro SD slot :**

Insert micro SD to play music from the card or start up card reader function when connect to computer.

**Reset hole :**

If the speaker halted, press this hole with steel sticker to restart the speaker.

**Power on /off**

**1 Press and hold 2 seconds to power on /off**

Press and hold 2 seconds to power on voice prompt ring, blue LED light up and flashing, the speaker is on, press and hold 2 seconds to power off voice prompt ring, the blue LED light goes out, the speaker is off.

**Pair to other Bluetooth devices**

**1 Bluetooth connect**

Turn on the Bluetooth function of other Bluetooth devices, and start to scan the speaker, when "BV150" appears in the list, press to connect.

**2 Bluetooth connected and playback**

After connecting successfully, the beeps up, LED light continuous blue, you can select music from the Bluetooth devices and play, the LED light continuous blue when the speaker playback.

1.If necessary, please input "0000" and press to pair.

2.The speaker can reconnect the last paired device(if this device's Bluetooth is on) when power on, no need to scan and pair again.

**3 Disconnct Bluetooth device**

If the speaker connected the device, press and hold to disconnect the Bluetooth, and then the speaker is discoverable for Bluetooth scanning, the blue LED light flashing fast, disconnecting beeps up.

**4 Bluetooth device reconnect**

If the Bluetooth device disconnected, and need to reconnect, you just need to short press to reconnect the last connected playback device, and play the recent files, the LED light continuous blue, the LED light slowly flash when pause.

**Micro SD music playback**

**1 Insert micro SD card and power on**

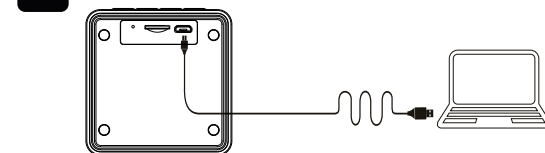
Insert micro SD card stored music files into the micro SD slot, press and hold power button to power on the speaker, voice prompt up.

**2 Switch to micro SD card music play mode**

Press to exchange to micro SD card music playback, the speaker will play the audio files stored in micro SD card, the LED light continuous blue, the LED light slowly flash when pause.

**Kind reminder :** The default mode is Bluetooth mode, so if want to play music stored in micro SD, need to exchange to micro SD mode, if the speaker is on, insert micro SD card, then the speaker play the music stored in micro SD directly.

**Card reader/Charging mode**



**1 Copy files**

First, when the speaker is off, insert micro SD card, connect the speaker to computer by using the USB data transfer cable which includes in the accessory, then power on the speaker, and enter card reader mode, and then can copy the files and store in micro SD card. Press to exit card reader mode and enter Bluetooth mode.

**2 Speaker charging**

Charging the speaker by using the data cable which includes in accessory to connect computer. Also can use USB adapter (over DC 5V=1A) to charge the speaker. The LED light continuous red when charging, the red LED light goes out when charging completed.

**Kind reminder :**

If no use the speaker for a long time, please charge it first.

The speaker will power off in 10 minutes automatically, if no Bluetooth connection, no micro SD card inserted or micro SD card playback pause.
