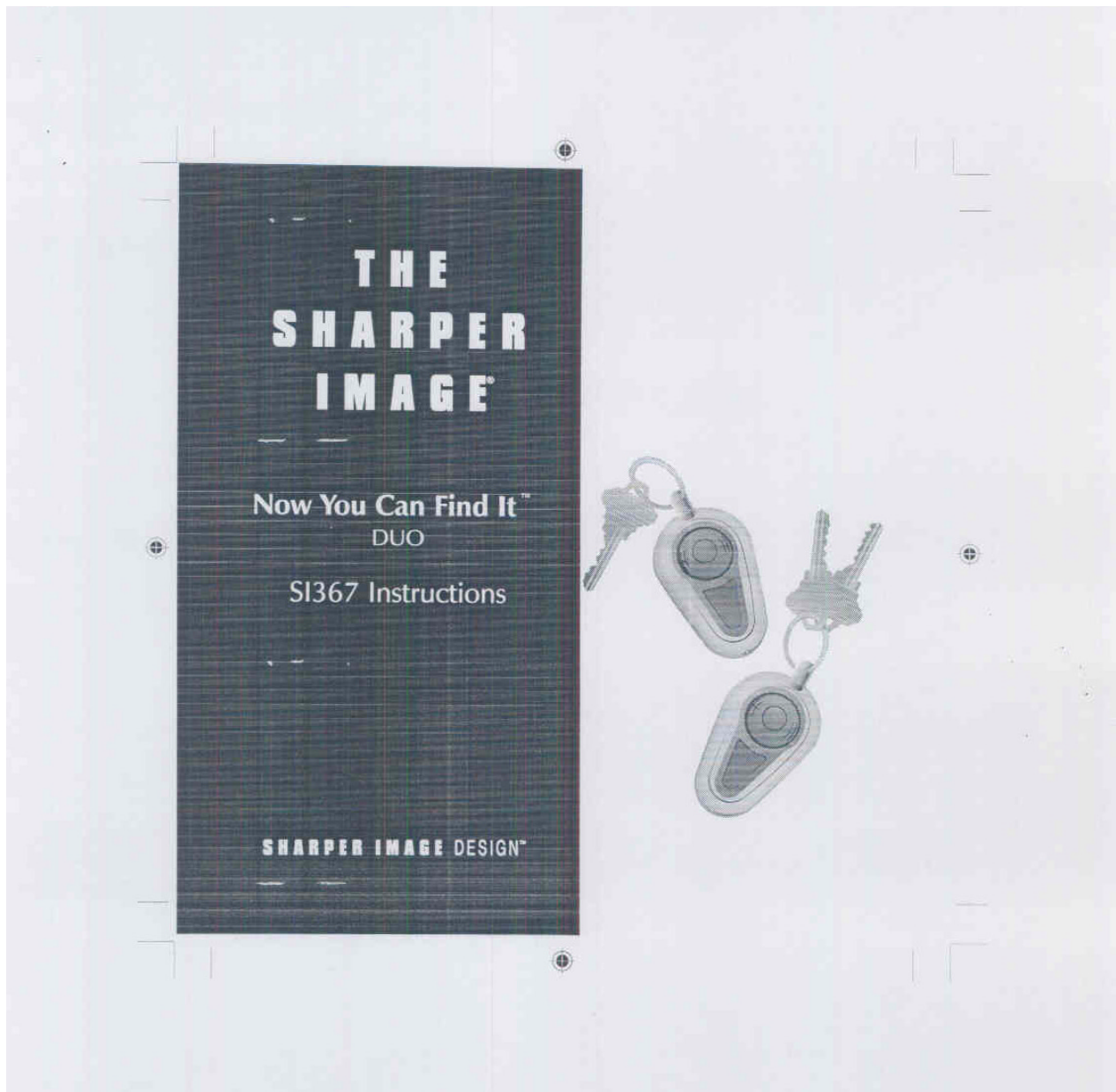

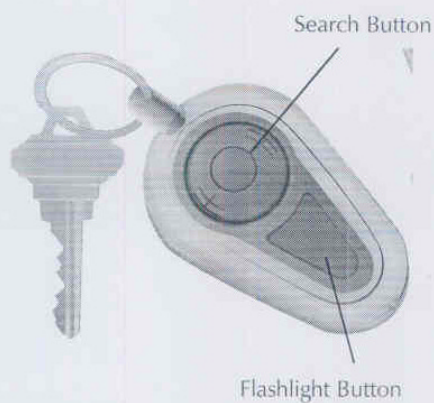

Description

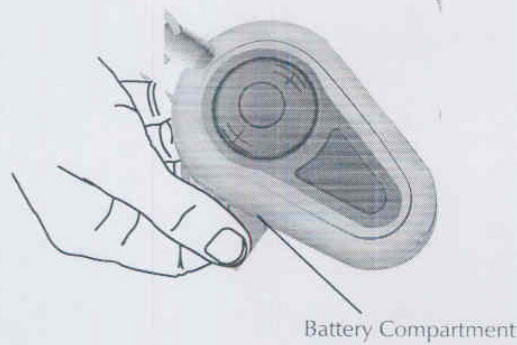

Batteries

The battery compartment slides from the side of the main housing. Use a fingernail or the tip of a small flat tool to lift and pry the edge of the compartment out.

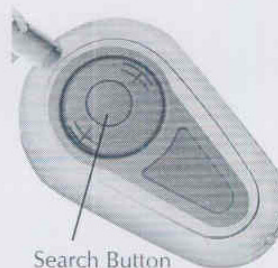
Replace batteries anytime the locating function begins to weaken. One CR2032 lithium battery is required for each unit.

Search and Alert Feature

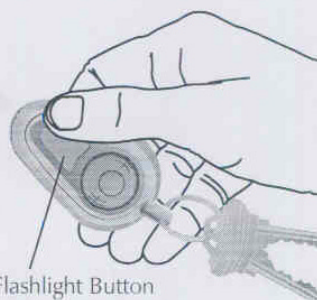
Press the round SEARCH button to send out the search signal. If the other device is within 30-40 feet, its alarm will trigger and it will begin to beep and flash.



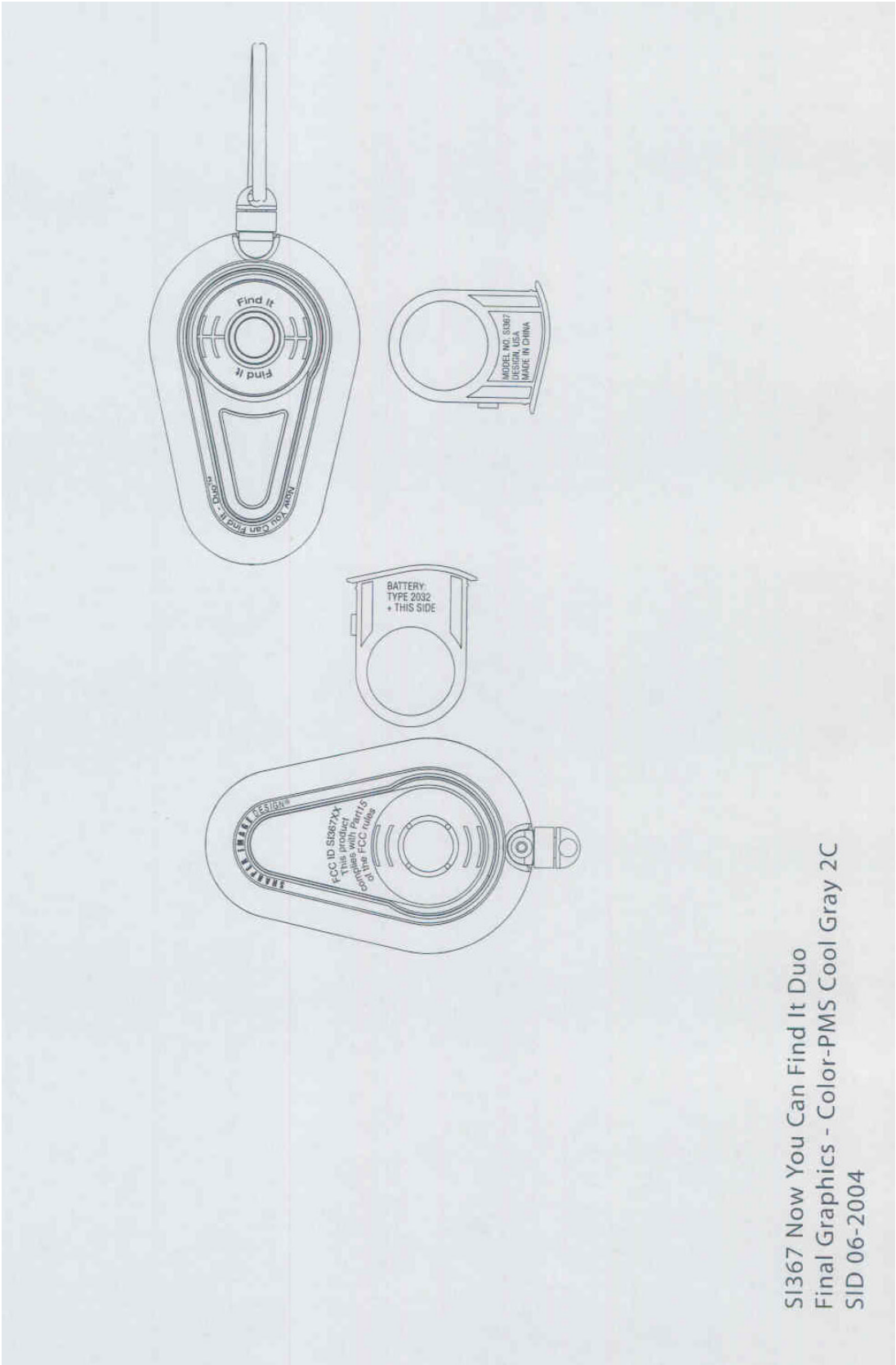
Search Button
