USING PORTICO

Before using PORTICO solar sound, fully charge the device using the provided DC adapter. The indicator light will turn red when charging and off when finished.

POWER

To turn the device on, hold the power button on the remote for 3 seconds.

LIGHTS

Press the Light On/Off button to turn the lights on or off.

AUX

To use the speaker with any music device, use a 1/4 inch audio cable to connect the AUX-IN port with the headphone or music out jack.

RECHARGING

When placed in direct sunlight, PORTICO solar sound will recharge automatically. A full recharge takes 12 hours of direct sunlight. If faster charging is required, used the provided 10W DC power adapter.

VOLUME

Press and hold the volume buttons to increase or decrease the sound level. Volume can also be control directly from the Bluetooth paired device.

PAIRING PORTICO

1 - Turn on the PORTICO solar sound. The blue & red LED will blink rapidly, indicating the unit is ready for pairing. If the LED light is not blinking, press the Bluetooth (Pause/Play) button.

2 - Turn on the Bluetooth function on your smartphone or tablet and search for Bluetooth devices.

3 - Select PORTICO SOLAR from the list.

4 - After pairing successfully, the LED light will turn blue.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Your smartphone and PORTICO solar sound should automatically re-pair when PORTICO is turned on, but if this is not the case, go into Bluetooth settings, select PORTICO, press the “Forget Device” button, and re-pair using the steps above.

If you want to use your phone or tablet with another Bluetooth device, you should first turn off PORTICO solar sound before attempting to pair.

If PORTICO solar sound ceases working, take the product inside and fully recharge using the provided DC adapter.
