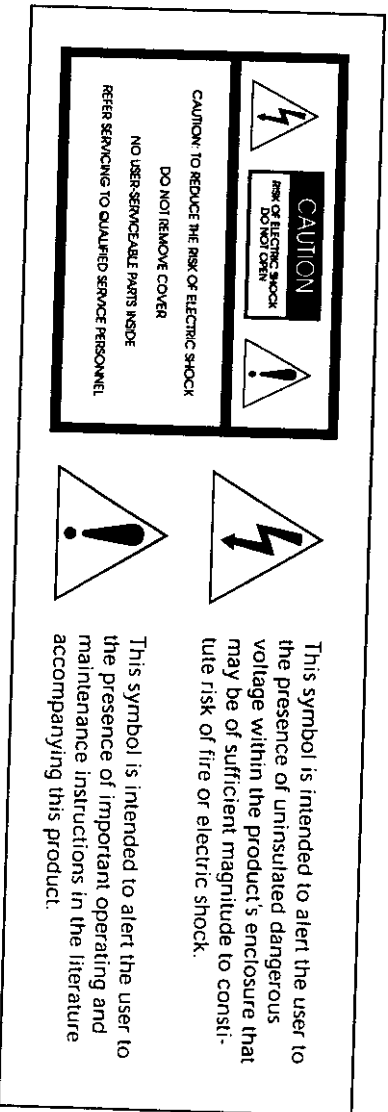

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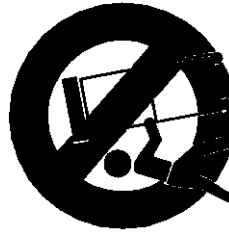
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# Safety

## Important Safety Instructions

1. **READ INSTRUCTIONS** - All the safety and operating instructions should be read before the unit is operated.
2. **RETAIN INSTRUCTIONS** - The safety and operating instructions should be retained for future reference.
3. **HEED WARNINGS** - All warnings on the unit and in the operating instructions should be adhered to.
4. **FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS** - All operating and maintenance instructions should be followed.
5. **CLEANING** - Unplug this video unit from the wall outlet before cleaning. Do not use liquid or aerosol cleaners. Use a dry cloth for dusting cabinet.
6. **ATTACHMENTS** - Do not use attachments not recommended by the video product manufacturer, as they may be hazardous.
7. **WATER & MOISTURE** - Do not use this video unit near water—for example, near a bathtub, wash bowl, kitchen sink, laundry tub, in a wet basement, near a swimming pool or the like.
8. **ACCESSORIES** - Do not place this video unit on an unstable cart, stand, tripod, bracket or table. The video unit may fall, causing serious injury to a child or adult, and serious damage to the unit. Use only with a cart, stand, tripod, bracket or table recommended by the manufacturer or sold with the video unit. **10. POWER SOURCES** - This video unit should be operated only from the type of power source indicated on the marking label. If you are not sure of the type of power supply to your home consult your appliance dealer or local power company. For video units intended to be operated from battery power, or other sources, refer to the operating instructions.

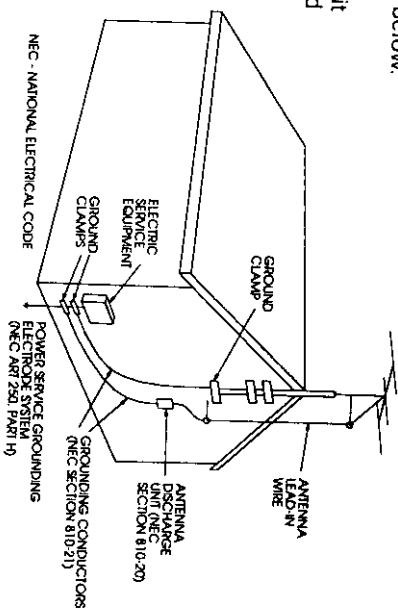
**11. GROUNDING OR POLARIZATION** - This video unit may be equipped with either a polarized 2-wire AC line plug (a plug having one blade wider than the other) or a 3-wire grounding plug having a third (grounding) pin.

The 2-wire polarized plug will fit into the power outlet only one way. This is a safety feature. If you are unable to insert the plug fully into the outlet try reversing the plug. If the plug still fails to fit, contact your electrician to replace your obsolete outlet. Do not defeat the safety purpose of the polarized plug.

**12. POWER-CORD PROTECTION** - Power-supply cords should be routed so that they are not likely to be walked on or pinched by items placed upon or against them, paying particular attention to cords of plugs, convenience receptacles, and the point where they exit from the unit.

**13. OUTDOOR ANTENNA GROUNDING** - If an outside antenna or cable system is connected to the video unit, be sure the antenna or cable system is grounded to provide some protection against voltage surges and built-up static charges. Section 810 of the National Electrical Code, ANSIN/FPA No. 70-1984, provides information with respect to proper grounding of the mast and supporting structure, grounding of the lead-in wire to an antenna-discharge unit, size of grounding conductors, location of antenna-discharge unit, connection to grounding electrodes, and requirements for the grounding electrode. See figure below.

**14. LIGHTNING** - For added protection of this video unit during a lightning storm, or when it is left unattended and unused for long periods of time, unplug it from the wall outlet and disconnect the antenna or cable system. This will prevent damage to the video unit due to lightning and power line surges.

- 15. POWER LINES** - An outside antenna system should not be located in the vicinity of overhead power lines or other electric light or power circuits, where it can fall into such power lines or circuits. When installing an outside antenna system extreme care should be taken to keep from touching such power lines or circuits as contact with them might be fatal.
- 16. OVERLOADING** - Do not overload wall outlets and extension cords as this can result in the risk of fire or electric shock.
- 17. OBJECTS AND LIQUIDS** - Never push objects of any kind into this video unit through openings as they may touch dangerous voltage points or short out parts that could result in a fire or electric shock. Never spill liquids of any kind onto the unit. Should spillage occur, unplug unit and have it checked by a technician before use.
- 18. SERVICING** - Do not attempt to service this video unit yourself as opening or removing covers may expose you to a dangerous voltage or other hazards. Refer all servicing to qualified service personnel.
- 19. DAMAGE REQUIRING SERVICE** - Unplug this video unit from the wall outlet and refer servicing to qualified service personnel under the following conditions:
- a. When the power supply cord or plug is damaged.
  - b. If any liquid has been spilled onto or objects have fallen into the video unit.
  - c. If the video unit has been exposed to rain or water.
  - d. If the video unit does not operate normally by following the operating instructions. Adjust only those controls that are covered by the operating instructions. Improper adjustment of other controls may result in damage and will often require extensive work by a qualified technician to restore the video unit to its normal operation.
  - e. If the video unit has been dropped or the cabinet has been damaged.
  - f. When the video unit exhibits a distinct change in performance—this indicates a need for service.

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**20. REPLACEMENT PARTS** - When replacement parts are required, be sure the service technician has used replacement parts specified by the manufacturer or those having the same characteristics as the original part. Unauthorized substitutions may result in fire, electric shock or other hazards.

**21. SAFETY CHECK** - Upon completion of any service or repairs to this video unit ask the service technician to perform safety checks to determine that the video unit is in safe operating order.

**22. HEAT** - This video unit should be situated away from heat sources such as radiators, stoves, or other products (including amplifiers) that produce heat.

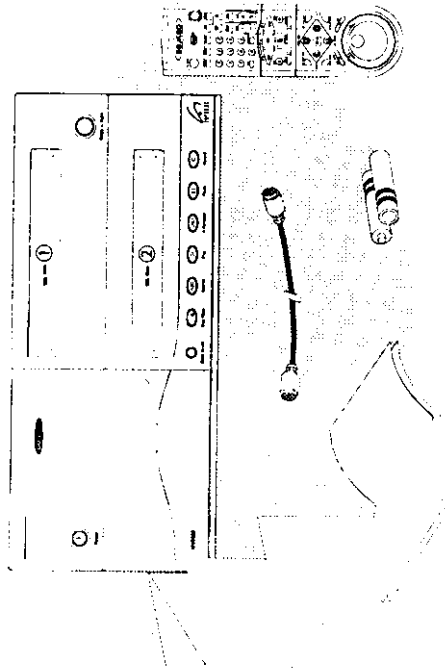

## First Things First

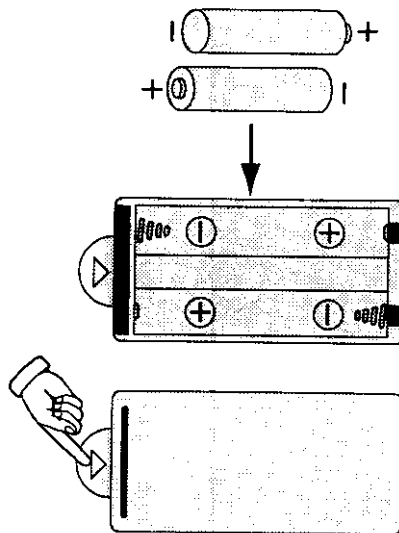

- 2 "AA" Batteries
- 1 RF (Radio Frequency) Antenna Cable



### 2 Insert Remote Control Batteries

Remove the battery cover in the direction of the arrow as shown. Insert 2 AAA batteries, paying attention to the correct polarities (+/-). Replace the cover.



# Connect Antenna/Basic Cable

Follow these steps only if you are using an indoor/outdoor antenna or basic cable. If you have a:

- cable box
  - stereo receiver
  - TV monitor
  - third VCR
  - laserdisc player
  - DVD player
  - camcorder
  - satellite receiver
  - video game
- ...or other advanced connection, please refer to Chapter 11.

## 1 Connect Antenna to VCR

Connect the RF antenna cable from your indoor/outdoor antenna or cable wall outlet to the IN FROM ANT. Jack on the back panel of the VCR.

## 2 Connect VCR to TV

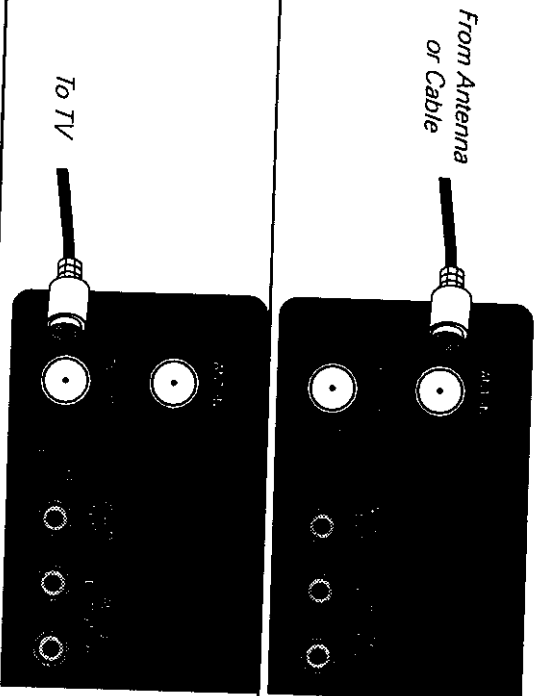
Connect the supplied RF cable from the OUT TO TV Jack on the back panel of the VCR to your television's ANTENNA IN Jack.

## 3 Set VCR Output Channel

Set the channel switch on the back panel of the VCR to 3 or 4, whichever is not an active channel in your area.

## 4 Plug In VCR

Connect the VCR power cord to a standard 120V/60Hz wall outlet.

## 5 Turn On VCR

Press the power button on the remote control or on the VCR's front panel.



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## 6 Turn On TV

Press the power button on the TV.

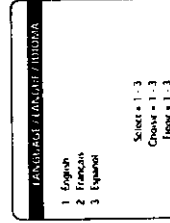

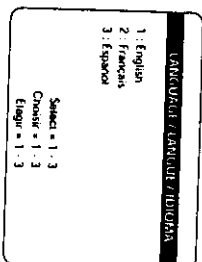
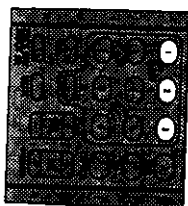
## 2 - Initial Settings

# Auto Setup

*The first time you hook up and turn on your Dual-Deck VCR, it will run Auto Setup. First, you will be prompted to select the on-screen language, then the Dual-Deck VCR will automatically search for channels and set the VCR's internal clock.*

### 1 Set Language

Press 1, 2, or 3 to select English, French, or Spanish. To change the language at any other time, see page 6.

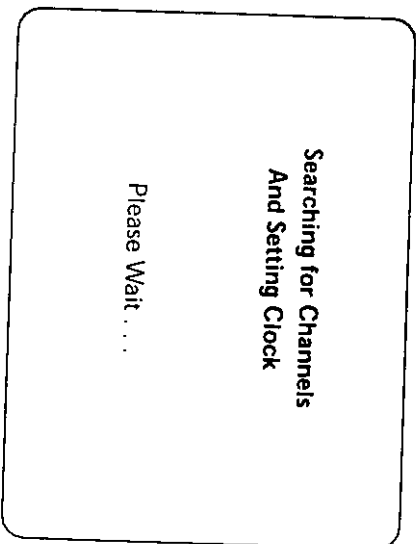


### 2 Run Auto Setup

As soon as you set the language, the VCR will automatically perform the following steps:

- **Auto Channel Search** — Automatically detects whether you have an antenna or cable, then searches for all channels in your area. If Auto Setup is unable to search for channels in your area, you may do so at any time; see page 30.
- **Auto Time Set** — Sets the VCR's internal clock. If Auto Setup is unable to find a clock set channel in your area, you can set the clock manually; see page 7.

This procedure may take a few minutes to complete, at which point it will tune the VCR to the lowest channel found.

## 4 Set the Time

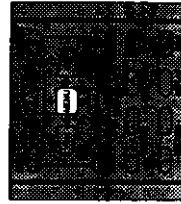
Use the number keys or the up/down arrow keys to adjust the following items. To skip an item, press the right arrow key:

- **Set Month** — Enter the month as 2-digit number; i.e. August = "08"
- **Set Year** — Enter the year as 2-digit number; i.e. 1999 = "99"
- **Set Day** — Enter the day as 2-digit number; i.e. the ninth = "09"
- **Set Hour** — Enter the hour as 2-digit number; i.e. 12:xx = "12"
- **Set Minute** — Enter the minute as 2-digit number; i.e. xx:25 = "25"
- **Set AM/PM** — Press "1" for AM, "2" for PM

The Clock is set! Press the Menu button at any time to save and quit.

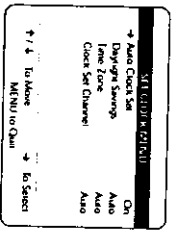
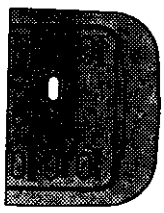


# Set Daylight Savings

## 3 Set "Daylight Savings"

Press the right arrow key to select among:

- **Auto** — Uses local channel info to determine Daylight Savings Time status.
- **Off** — Turns off Daylight Savings permanently, i.e. the time never changes.
- **On** — Enables Daylight Savings at 2:00 AM on the first Sunday of April and disables it at 2:00 AM on the last Sunday in October.

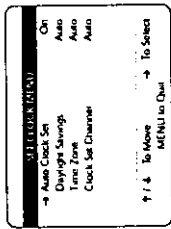
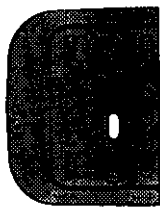


# Set Time Zone

You can set your Time Zone manually to one of the six preset choices. Use this feature if Auto Clock Set has set the time incorrectly by detecting a nearby time zone. Note: If you are an Arizona resident, choose Mountain Standard Time and turn Daylight Savings Time off.

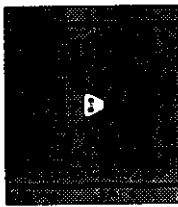
## 1 Open "Set Clock Menu"

## 2 Move to "Time Zone"

Press the down arrow key until "Time Zone" is selected.



## 3 Set "Time Zone"

Press the right arrow key to select among:

- **Mountain** — Mountain Standard Time

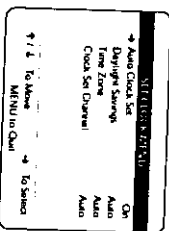
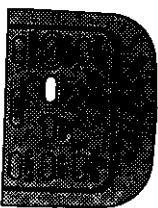


# Set Auto Clock Set Channel

*If you know a station in your local area that broadcasts time information, you can set it manually. For example, your local PBS station usually will transmit the time and date. Use this feature only if Auto Clock Set has set the time incorrectly.*

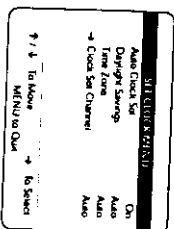
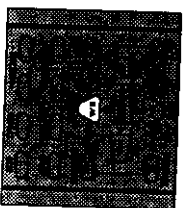

## 3 Set "Clock Set Channel"

Press the right arrow key repeatedly to select among:

- **Auto** — Automatically searches for channels broadcasting the time via XDS (Extended Data Services)
- **Ch #** — Allow you to manually set a channel which you know to receive XDS information
- **Aux** — allows the clock to be set from another AV (Audio/Video) device attached to your VCR's front line inputs





## 3 - The Dual-Deck System

### Remote Control Overview

**Set Clock** — Allows you to bypass the menu system and jump directly to the VCR's Set Clock Menu.

**\*Power** — Turns the VCR on and off. Note: Power will come on automatically when you insert a videotape.

**Display** — Turns the On-Screen Display (tuner, audio, and deck status) on and off.

**Search/Idx** — From Stop, Play, Fwd, or Rewind, opens the Search/Index Menu. While recording, places an index mark on the tape.

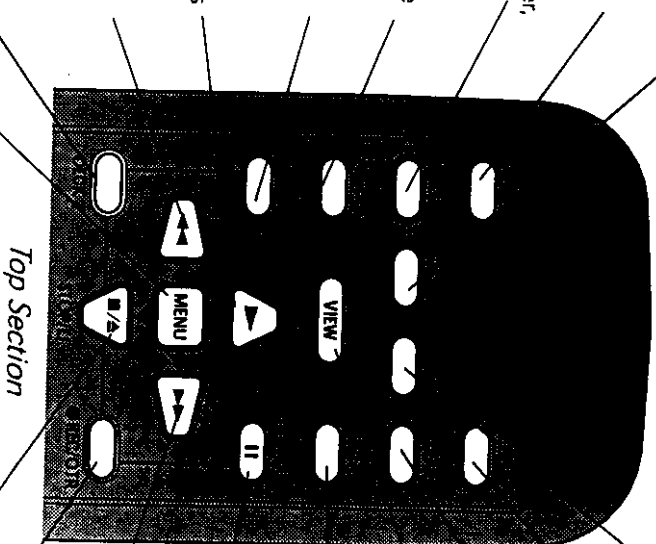
**Deck 1** — Sets Deck 1 as the active deck. All deck control buttons (Play, Rewind, etc.) will only affect Deck 1.

**Play** — Plays the tape in the active deck. Press twice for double-speed playback.

**Rew** — From Stop mode, rewinds the tape. From Play mode, visually searches the tape in reverse (Review).

**Deck 2** — Sets Deck 2 as the active deck. All deck control buttons (Play, Rewind, etc.) will only affect Deck 2.

**Menu** — Opens the Main Menu. Press and hold for three seconds to open the Setup Menu.



**Set Timer** — Allows you to bypass the menu system and jump directly to the Timer Recording Menu.

**Copy Tape** — Copies the tape in Deck 1 to the tape in Deck 2.

**Clear** — Resets the tape counter to 0:00:00. In the menu system, clears entries.

**View** — Switches the TV display among the Tuner, Deck1, Deck2, and Aux.

**Clk/Ctr** — Switches the front panel display among the clock, tape counter, and time remaining.

**Still/Frame** — In Play or Record mode, pauses the tape in the active deck. In Play Still mode advances the tape on frame at a time.

**FF** — From Stop mode, fast-forwards the tape. From Play mode, visually searches the tape forward (Cue).

**Rec/OTR** — Starts recording in the active deck. Press twice to activate One-Touch Recording.

**Stop/Ej.** — Stops the tape in the active deck. Press twice to eject the tape.

**Shuttle +/-** — In Play mode, Shuttle + gradually increases the cue speed from double-speed playback to picture search to jet search. Shuttle - gradually slows down the tape, pauses, then goes into reverse picture search and reverse jet search.

**Tracking +/-** — Allows you to manually adjust tracking. For Auto Tracking, see page 45.

**Slow +/-** — In Play mode, plays the tape at varying speeds of slow motion.

**\*0-9** — Selects channels directly. In the menu system, selects menu items.

**100+** — Selects cable channels 100 and above.

**\*Prev. Ch/Input Sel** — (Previous Channel/Input Select) Displays the last channel you were watching. In TV mode, switches among all inputs connected to your television.

**\*Mute** — Turns audio on and off.

**\*Vol +/-** — Turns the sound up and down.

**SP/EP** — Sets the record speed to SP (Standard Play) or EP (Extended Play). EP is three times longer than SP.

**Edit/Title** — Marks the beginning and ending edit points of scenes in the 8-Scene Editor (see page 63). Also press to record On-Screen Titles (see page 70).

**Skip** — In Play mode, jumps ahead 1 minute for every press (up to 5 minutes). In Copy mode, skip edits 1 minute for every press (up to 5 minutes).

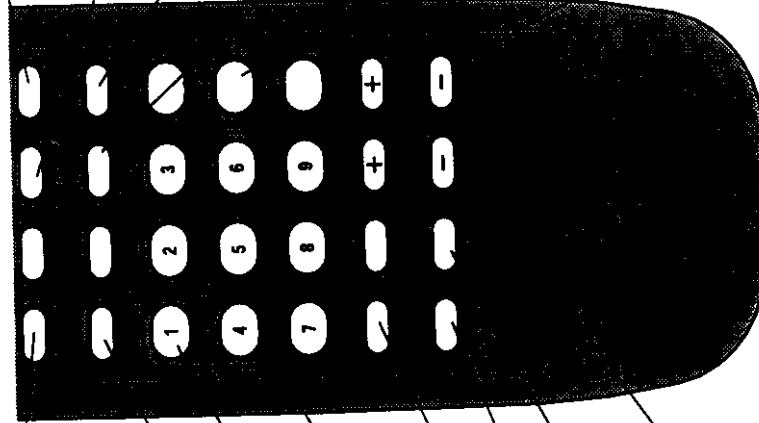
**Repeat** — Instantly replays the last 30 seconds of tape.

**VCR** — Sets the remote to operate your VCR.

**TV** — Sets the remote control to operate your television. To program the remote, see Appendix A.

**TV/VCR** — Switches between the TV's tuner and the VCR's tuner.

**\*Ch +/-** — Changes channels up and down.

\*These keys can be used to operate both your TV and VCR; see Appendix A to program your remote control.

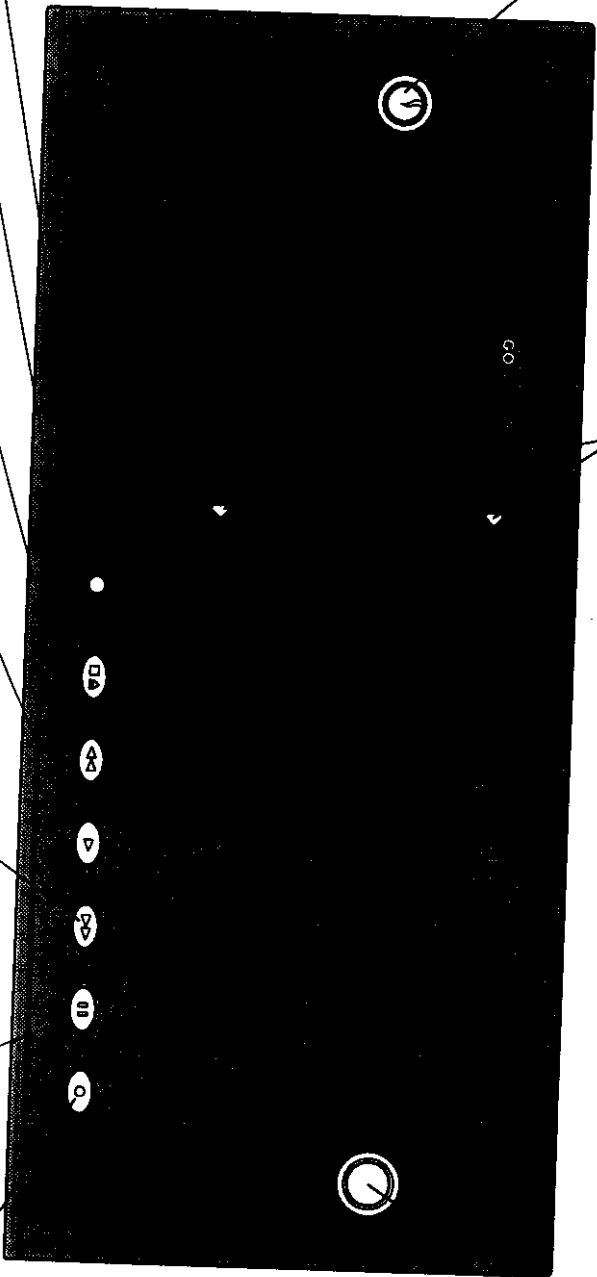


# Front Panel - Door Closed

**Power** — Turns the VCR on and off.  
**Note:** Power will come on automatically when you insert a videotape.

**Deck Select Indicators** — Shows which deck is currently active.

**Copy Tape** — Copies the tape in Deck 1 to Deck 2.



**Deck Select** — Switches control between Deck 1 and Deck 2.

**Stop/Eject** — Stops the tape in the active deck. Press twice to eject the tape. In menus, moves selection arrow down.

**Rewind** — In Stop mode, rewinds the tape. In Play mode, visually searches the tape in reverse (Review). In menus, backs up one menu.

**Play** — Plays the tape in the active deck. Press twice for double-speed playback. In menus, moves selection arrow up.

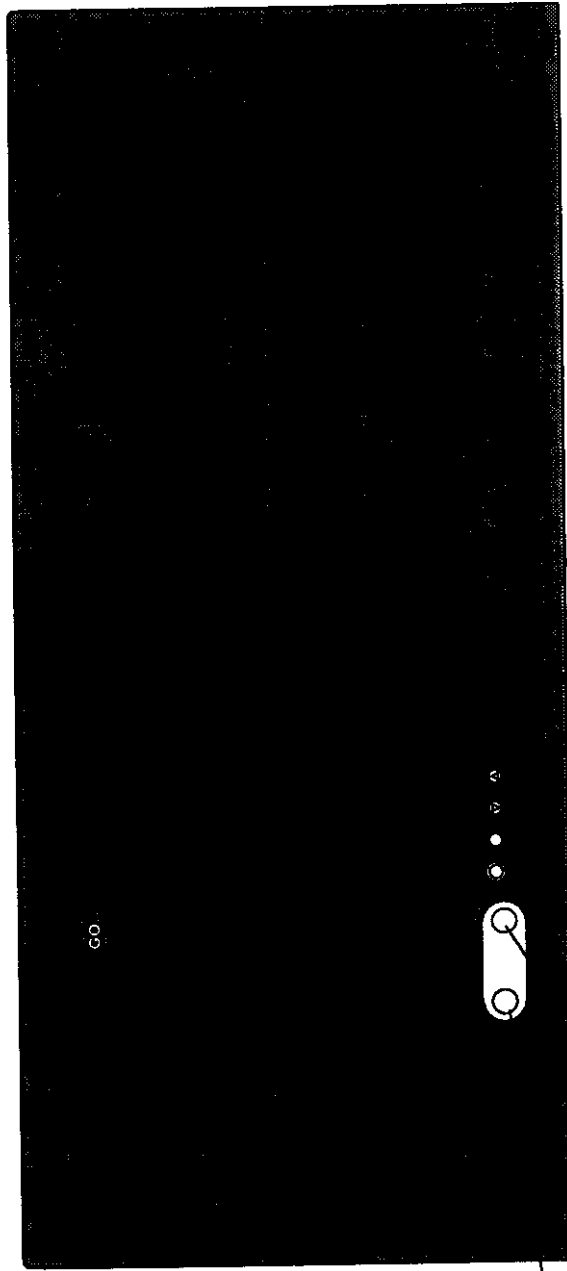
**F.Fast Forward** — In Stop mode, fast-forwards the tape. In Play mode, visually searches the tape forward (Cue). In menus, selects and cycles through menu items.

**Pause** — Pauses the tape in the

**Record** — Starts recording in the active deck. Press repeatedly to activate One-Touch Recording.

# Front Panel - Door Open

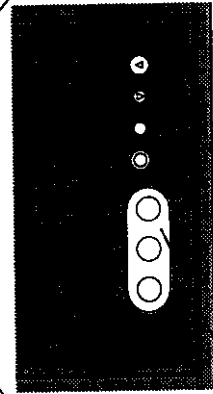
Use the Front Panel Inputs for easy connection to a camcorder or video game. The front panel input is labeled Aux in the menu system and can be accessed with the Channel +/- buttons.



**Video Input — (Yellow)** Use to connect the video signal from your external device with an RCA cable.

**Audio Mono Input — (White)** Use to connect the mono audio signal from your external device with an RCA cable.

**Audio Stereo Inputs — (Red & White)** Use to connect the left and right stereo signals from your external device with RCA cables. (GV6650 only).

**Menu** — Opens the Main Menu. Press and hold for 3 seconds to open the Setup Menu.

**TV/VCR** — Switches between the TV's tuner and the VCR's tuner.

**Channel Up/Down** — Changes channels up and down.

# Front Panel Display

**Digital Tracking**— Blinks when Auto Digital Tracking is in progress. Lights to show Tracking is optimized. Turns off when Tracking is set manually.

**Timer** — Lights to show you that a Timer Recording or a One Touch Recording is stored or in progress. Blinks if there is a Timer Recording error.

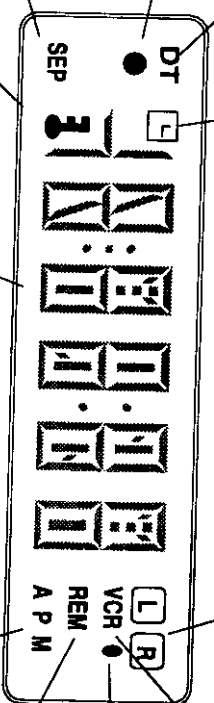
**Hi-Fi/Stereo Indicators** — Light when you play a Hi-Fi videotape or watch a TV show broadcast in stereo.

**VCR** — Lights to show you that the Dual-Deck is in VCR mode; i.e. what you see on screen is coming from the VCR and NOT the television, as set by the TV/VCR button.

**Record Indicator** — Lights when any recording is in progress. Blinks when tape is in Pause mode.

**Tape Speed** — (SP, LP, EP) Shows you the current Playback or Record Speed for the active deck.

**Child Lock** — Lights to indicate that the Child Lock is activated, i.e. the front panel buttons are disabled (see page 19).



**00:00:00** — Shows you the current time, tape counter, or time remaining until the end of the tape in the active deck, as set by the CLK/CTR button. Also briefly displays the active deck function (Stop, Play, Rewind, etc.).

**Power On** — Displays when the VCR's power is turned on.

**REM** — Lights when Time Remaining is displayed.

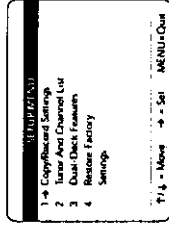
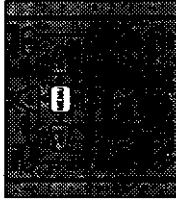
**AM/PM** — Indicates AM or PM when the Time is displayed.

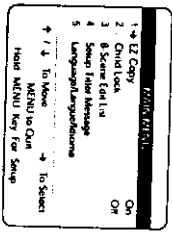


# Child Lock

To prevent children from using the VCR when you are away, you can activate the Child Lock. This feature disables Auto Power On, Auto Play, and all front panel buttons. You will need the remote control to operate the VCR.

## 1 Open "Main Menu"

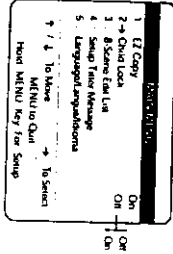
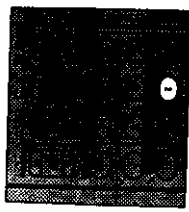
Press the menu button on the remote control.



## 2 Set "Child Lock"

Press 2 repeatedly to turn Child Lock on or off. With Child Lock set to "On":

- The VCR will not power on automatically when a tape is inserted.
- Tapes will not play automatically when you insert them, regardless of the Auto Play setting (see page 47).
- All front panel buttons are disabled.
- You will still be able to use the remote control to operate all VCR functions.
- To disable the Child Lock, set it to Off using the remote control.

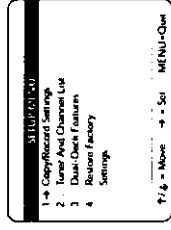
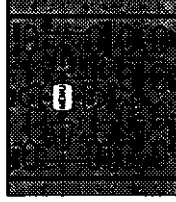

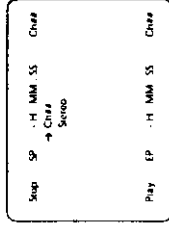
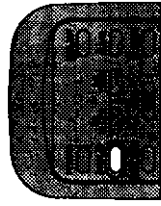


# On-Screen Display Overview

The On-Screen Display (OSD) keeps you posted on the status of the Tuner, Decks, and Line inputs. It also communicates important Copy, Timer Record, and Error messages.

## Bring up On-Screen Display

Press Display. The OSD will also appear whenever you activate a Deck function, i.e. Play a tape, change channels, etc. The OSD will turn off automatically after 5 seconds.



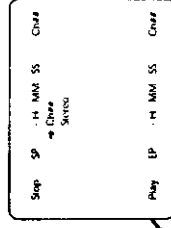

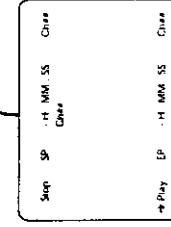

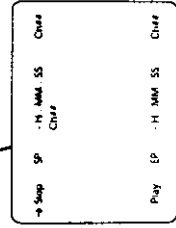

# On-Screen Display Elements

**Deck Status** — Shows current tape status in each deck: Stop, Play, Rew, Fwrd, Eject, Cue, Review, Slow, Still, Pause, Rec, OTR, ATR, Index, or ERROR.

**Deck Record Source** — Shows the current record source for each deck: Ch#, Aux, Deck 1, or Deck 2.

**View** — Shows the source you are currently watching (Tuner/Aux, Deck 1, Deck 2). The arrow will point to the active source.

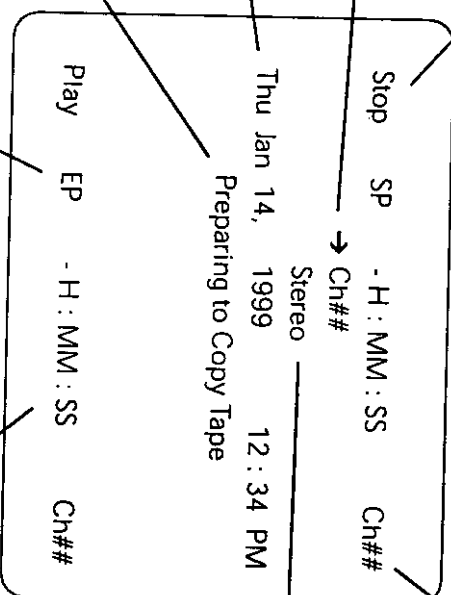
**Date and Time** — Press the Display key twice to view the Date and Time in the middle of the screen.

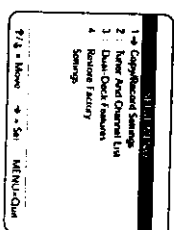
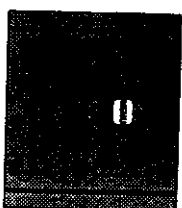


# Show Weak Channels

When you run Auto Channel Search, it will skip channels with weak signals, i.e. poor picture quality. - **SAP** — Second Audio Program. Optional audio signal, often used to transmit a second language, news, or weather broadcasts. SAP will appear on the front panel display if it is available.
  - **TV+SAP** — Broadcasts Mono sound out of the left channel and SAP out of the right channel. This is useful if you want to listen to a second language with headphones while the primary language is played through the speakers.
  - **Simulcast** — Sometimes a broadcaster will transmit a television program and an FM radio broadcast of the same program simultaneously. When Turner Audio is set to Simulcast, the audio signal will come from the rear line inputs, usually connected to a stereo system. Simulcasts are usually reserved for live musical performances; however, they are becoming less frequent because most televisions have built-in stereo sound.

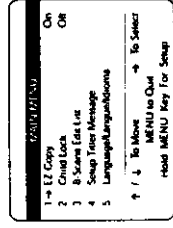
# EZ Copy

*EZ-Copy automates the entire copy process so you can copy an entire tape at the touch of a button. Just press the Copy Tape button, and the VCR will rewind both decks completely, copy the source tape to the target tape, rewind both decks again and eject the tapes.*

**Complete Program Record**  
*When EZ Copy is selected, the source tape begins to copy in SP, the VCR then calculates how much time is remaining on the target tape and adjusts the copy speed to EP if necessary to copy the entire tape. If there is not enough room to copy the entire source tape, the VCR will copy in EP until the end of the target tape is reached.*

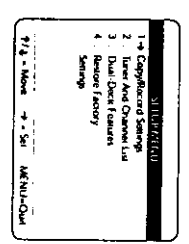
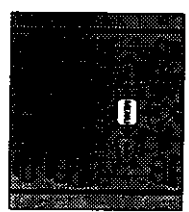


# Copy Mode

There are two methods of copying a tape from Deck 1 to Deck 2. HQ1 (High Quality 1) and HQ2 (High Quality 2). HQ1 is best if your source tape is recorded in SP. HQ2 is best if your source tape is recorded in LP or EP. The Auto setting will make this choice for you.

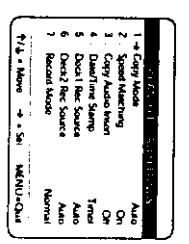
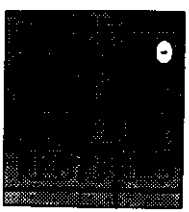

## Shuttle

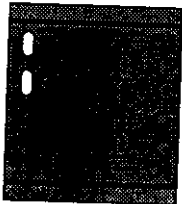


# Tracking

*Adjusting the Tracking removes the lines that sometimes appear during playback because of slight differences in recording decks. Your Dual-Deck VCR will automatically align the recorded tracks with the playback heads to solve this problem. You may also set tracking manually.*

Use the number keys to set the date and time of the event. The default setting is the current date and time. To leave an entry unchanged, press the right arrow key. If you enter an invalid number, you will be prompted to reenter a valid one.

- **Set Month** — Enter the month as a 2-digit number; i.e. for August, press "08".
- **Set Day** — Enter the day as a 2-digit number; i.e. for the ninth, press "09".

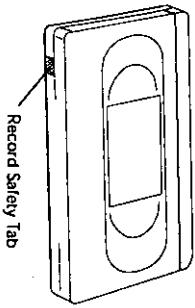
## 9 Confirm Settings

When all settings are complete, press Menu to confirm the Timer event and view a summary of all programmed events.

## Overlapping Events

- When you program a new event, the VCR checks all timer events for conflicts. If two events overlap, you will be prompted to either delete one of the events, or allow them to overlap.
  - If events overlap, the first event will be completely recorded, then the next event starts and the remainder of that event is recorded.





# 9 - Editing Features

## 8-Scene Editor

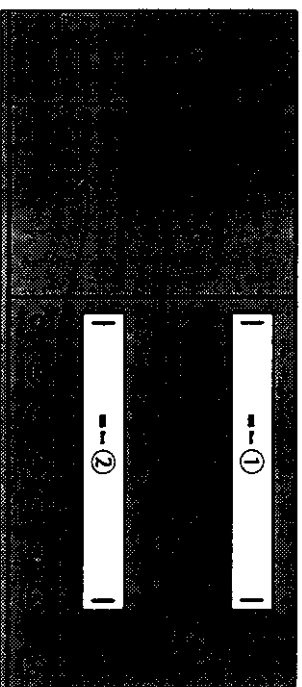
There are two ways to edit your movies with the Dual-Deck VCR. You can use the 8-Scene Editor, which automatically assembles up to 8 scenes when you mark their beginning and ending points. Or you can use the Sync Edit feature, which allows you to manually cut unwanted scenes while copying a tape.

### 1 Insert Source Tape

Put the tape with your source material in Deck 1.

### 2 Insert Target Tape

Put your blank tape in Deck 2. To ensure quality edits, it is best to record on blank or pre-formatted tapes. You can format your tapes by recording the line input over the entire tape with no signal.

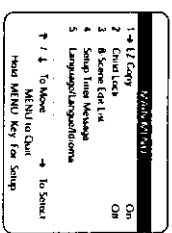
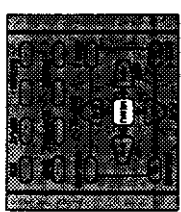

Make a list of the scenes you wish to use in your final movie with their beginning and ending tape counter positions. Reorder the scenes if desired.

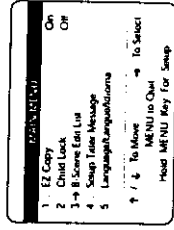
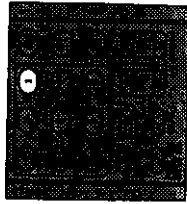

## 9 Make a Tape

When you are satisfied with the order and length of each scene, press Copy Tape to begin assembling the tape.

Notes:

- The Dual-Deck VCR will automatically copy each scene in order from the source tape to the target tape.
- When the process is finished, return to Step 6 to add more scenes, or press Menu to quit.



# Sync Editing

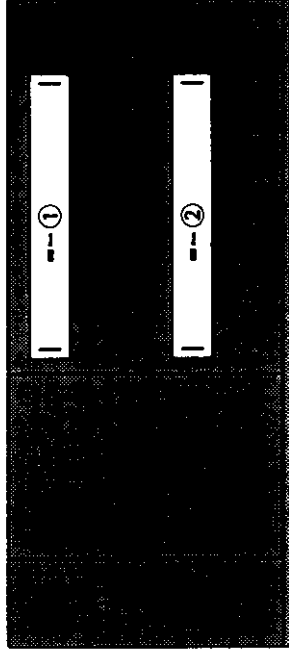
*The second way to edit movies is to use Sync (short for Synchronized) Editing. This method is useful if you want to copy part of a tape, or if you want to cut commercials while copying a TV show. The Copy Tape button is the key to synchronizing the playback deck with the recording deck.*

## 1 Before You Begin —

- Turn off EZ Copy; see page 38.

## 2 Insert Source Tape

# How to Cut Commercials with Skip Edit

---

*The Skip Edit feature allows you to remove commercials during a Sync Edit at the touch of a button. Commercials typically run from 1 to 5 minutes in length. Each time you press Skip Edit, you will automatically cut 1 to 5 minutes of source tape from your target tape.*

## **1** Set Up a Sync Edit

## **2** Preview Commercials

As you position your source tape, note how many minutes the commercials are that you wish to cut.

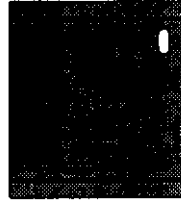

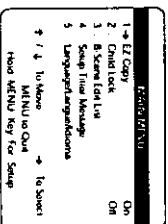
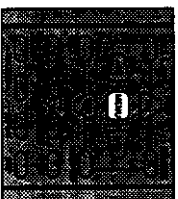


# On-Screen Titler

---

*The Dual-Deck VCR Search/Index features allow you to scan and search for Index Marks, quickly find blank tape, search for exact tape counter positions, and return to 0:00:00. The real-time tape counter gives you real-time feedback on the precise position of your tapes.*

### CLK/Ctr Button

Press the CLK/Ctr button repeatedly to change the view on the front panel display among the following:



### Clock

Shows you the time as set in the Set Clock Menu.



### Real-Time Tape Counter

Shows you the tape position in the active deck in hours, minutes, and seconds.



### Time Remaining

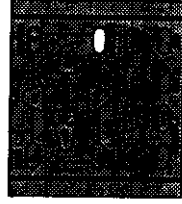
Shows you the amount of time left on the tape in the active deck, computed by subtracting the current tape position from the total tape length in hours and minutes.



Note: The Clock/Counter/Time Remaining display will not appear if there is a deck status message on the front panel display, such as Copy, Play, Stop, etc.

# Placing Index Marks

*Index Marks are like book-marks on your videotapes. They are inserted automatically at the start of every recording, or you can place them manually anywhere on a tape.*

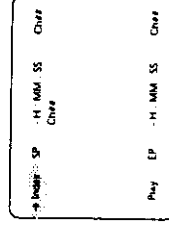
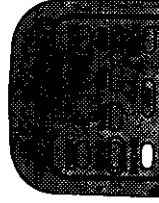


## Automatic Index Marks

Index Marks are placed automatically whenever you start recording. This includes normal recording, OTR (One Touch Recording), timer recording, copying, or sync editing.

## Manual Index Marks

You can place an Index Mark manually any time a tape is recording by pressing Search/Index on the remote control. "Index" will flash briefly on the On-Screen Display while the mark is recorded.

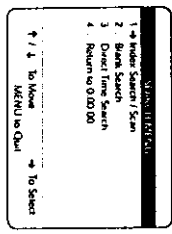
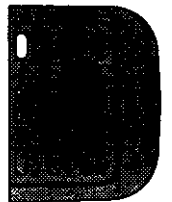

## **Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)**

---

*The following are some of the most frequently asked questions about our Dual-Deck VCRs. If you don't find the answers you need here, you can contact our Customer Service Department by phone at (602) 922-0896. Office hours are Monday-Friday, 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. MST on Saturday. You can also contact us anytime at our e-mail address: "custsvc@sensoryscience.com." Or refer to a listing of authorized Go-Video service centers on our Web site at "www.govideo.com."*

### **Why am I not getting a picture?**

- Make sure the TV/VCR button is set to VCR (the VCR icon on the front panel display should be on).
- Make sure your TV is set to the same channel (3 or 4) as the switch on the back of your VCR.

---

### **Why is the picture quality poor?**

- Change the channel switch on the back of the VCR, i.e. if it's set to 3 change it to 4. Make sure your TV is set to the same channel.
- If the picture is bad while playing a tape, try adjusting the tracking control. Press the Tracking +/- keys on the remote control.
- The video heads may be dirty; try cleaning the heads with a nonabrasive head cleaning tape.

---

### **Why can't I record from my cable box?**

Make sure the VCR is tuned to the cable box output channel (2, 3, or 4). Confirm this channel with your local cable provider.

---

### **Why can't I Timer Record?**

- Make sure the clock is set to the correct time, and the AM/PM adjustment is set correctly.
- If you have a cable box, make sure the Record Source is set to the cable box output channel (2, 3, or 4), and that the cable box is set to the channel you wish to record.

---

### **Why isn't my remote control working?**

- Make sure you are pointing the remote control directly at the VCR and that there are no obstacles between the remote control and VCR. Sunlight on the VCR front panel can sometimes interfere with the remote signal.
- Make sure the batteries in your remote are fresh and installed properly.
- The "TV" button may have been pressed by accident. This makes the remote control only operate the television. Press the VCR key on the remote and try again.

---

### **Why do my tapes record at different speeds when I use Copy Tape?**

Because Speed Matching is off in the Copy & Record Settings menu. Turn Speed Matching on to guarantee that the recording speed of the copy will match the playback speed of the source tape.

---

### **Why does the tape eject when I use Copy Tape or put a tape in to record?**

Make sure the record safety tab has not been removed from your tape. If the tab is missing, you can place a small piece of tape over the opening.

---

### **Why does the tape sometimes play or rewind when I don't want it to?**

- Turn Auto Play/Rewind off in the xx menu. When this feature is turned on, the VCR will automatically play tapes whenever you load them and/or rewind tapes when they reach the end.
- Turn EZ-Copy off in the xx menu. When EZ-Copy is turned on, both decks will automatically rewind before recording when you press Copy Tape.

---

### **Why does my on-screen display show "Error"?**

This indicates a problem with the VCR tape mechanism. Turn the power off and on again to reset. If this does not clear the error, unplug the VCR from the power outlet and inspect both tape slots for foreign objects, or for jammed or crooked tapes.

---

### **Why can't I eject a tape using my remote?**

- Make sure Remote Eject is turned on in the xx menu.
- If you have programmed scenes for editing in the 8-Scene Edit List, you cannot eject the tape in Deck 1 with the remote control. This protects you from losing your scene programming. You can either clear the scenes from the Edit List or press Stop/Eject on the front panel, which erases the scenes automatically.

---

### **Why can't I reset the Deck 1 tape counter?**

If you have programmed scenes for editing in the 8-Scene Edit List, you cannot reset the Deck 1 tape counter. This protects you from losing your scene programming. You can either clear the scenes from the Edit List or press Stop/Eject on the front panel, which erases the scenes automatically.

---

### **Why doesn't my VCR work?**

- A strong static electricity shock or other unforeseen circumstances may cause the control system of your Dual-Deck VCR to lock up. To reset the control system, first unplug the power cord from the wall outlet for 10 seconds and plug it in again.
- If this doesn't restore all operations to normal, unplug the VCR again for 15 minutes. You will then need to reset the clock (if the clock is still set, you haven't unplugged it long enough).
- If these steps do not correct the problem, the Dual-Deck VCR must be serviced by an authorized service center.

---

### **Why can't I bring up the 8-Scene Edit List?**

- Insert a tape in Deck 1. The VCR must have a tape in Deck 1 for the Edit List to appear.
- Edit List is not available during Copy Tape.

---

### **Why aren't the tape counters moving?**

If the VCR is playing a blank section of tape (only video noise, or "snow" appears on-screen), the tape counter cannot operate. The VCR requires a control track, which is only present on recorded tape, to provide counter information.

---

### **Why can't I get a menu or an on-screen display?**

- If the VCR is playing a blank section of tape (only video noise, or "snow" appears on-screen), the VCR cannot produce on-screen menus or displays. Stop the tape or record on it to enable the displays.
- The remote may be set to control the TV instead of the VCR. Press the VCR button on your remote to reactivate it.
- If the Date/Time Stamp is set to Cont (Continuous) and a recording is in progress, the on-screen menus and displays are disabled. Press Stop on the recording deck to restore normal on-screen functions.

---

### **Why do I get a blue screen?**

- If a channel is too weak to deliver a clear picture, the VCR will display a blue screen in its place. To see channels with poor reception, turn on the Show Weak Channels feature in the xx menu.
- Double-check your antenna connections or tuner settings.

---

### **Why is my Power button blinking?**

The VCR is in Auto Power Off mode. If you press the Power button while rewinding, copying, Timer Recording, One-Touch Recording or using EZ-Copy, the VCR will automatically turn off when the function is completed. Pressing the Power button toggles Auto Power On and Off.

---

### **Why is my Copy Tape button blinking?**

The Copy Tape procedure is in Pause mode. See Sync Editing on page 66.

---

### **Why do I lose stereo sound when I turn on my VCR? (GV6650 only)**

If your TV and VCR are connected with an RF coaxial cable, you will only hear stereo sound if the VCR is turned off. To hear stereo sound with the VCR turned on, you must connect the TV and VCR with RCA line cables; see page 81.

---

### **Why won't my remote operate all my TV functions?**

The remote control does not have a command for every function of your television. Some brands of television will only respond to a limited number of functions. See the table on page 86 for a list of common brands and functions.
