





## **Battery Installation and Charging**

# Procedure for PAIR / SYNC the Aeroplane and Transmitting










If the plane turns left involuntarily, turn the trim dial to the right until the Aeroplane flies straight. Likewise, if the plane turns right involuntarily turn the trim dial to the left.





4. Push the direction stick toward left to turn the plane anticlockwise, and push the direction stick toward right to turns depending on the speed difference between the left propellers and the right propellers. 5. Push the throttle stick up to increase the flying speed and push the throttle stick down to decrease the speed.




Pull the throttle stick down slowly to stop the propellers and land the plane.
 If the plane has been spoiled a little, you can fix it with adhesive tape.

#### Flying tips

Playing environment and weather:
Outdoors: or a sunny day with calm air or slight breeze. Never fly the plane on a windy day day
It is recommended to fly the plane over a soft surface, e.g. grass field.
Do not fly the plane when it is raining, snowing or near high power cables.
