



Battery Installation: Transmitter

Make sure the power switch is on "OFF" position.


- 1. Open the battery compartment by loosening the screw (fig. 1)
- 2. Insert 1 x 9V batteries in the battery compartment with correct polarity. (fig. 2)
- 3. Close the battery compartment cover.(fig. 3)



Make sure the power switch is on "OFF" position.


- 1. Open the battery compartment by loosening the screw (fig. 4)
- 2. Insert 3 x AAA batteries in the battery compartment with correct polarity. (fig. 5)
- 3. Close the battery compartment cover.(fig. 6)







How to play

- 1. Set vehicle ON/OFF switch to "ON". Drive the vehicle forward pressing the "Forward button". (fig. 7)
- 2. Transform a vehicle to a robot for a few second and then transform back to vehicle with turning by pressing the "Transform button" (fig 8)
- 3. To activate the siren sound and flashing light effects by pressing the "Sound







- 1. Operate only on flat, smooth (but not slippery), dry surfaces and low pile carpet, as hair, carpet or dirt can affect the operation of the vehicle.
- 2. Don't drive your vehicle in sand or through water or snow, if your vehicle get wet, wipe with a towel and allow to dry completely.

Hints: This vehicle will automatically enter sleep mode after being inactive for 10 minutes. To activate it, switch it off and then on again.
