
# **Operating Instruction**

### 1. Installing the Receiver



- \* Mount the Receiver upside up as the left figure.
- \* Connect the RED wire to power supply +5V and the BLACK wire to power supply common GND.
- \* The GREEN wire is DATA output for control unit not included.

## 2. Operating the Receiver

- \* Use a standard 318MHz RF transmitter not included to remote control the receiver.
- \* When the receiver receives the signal from transmitter, then the GREEN data wire will output the demodulated data.
