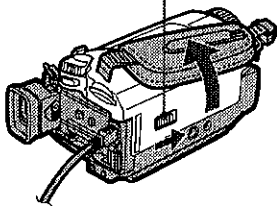
1 Connecting the power cord (p. ●●)

Use the battery pack when using your camcorder outdoors (p. ●●).

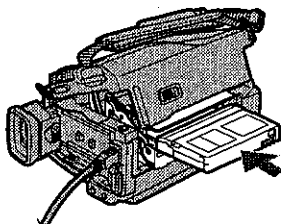


2 Inserting the cassette (p. ●●)

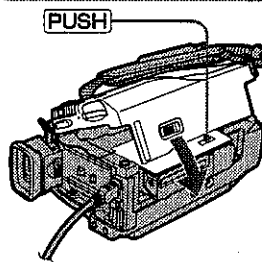
1 Slide **OPEN/EJECT** in the direction of the arrow and open the lid.



2 Push the center of the cassette back to insert the cassette. Insert the cassette straight as far as possible into the cassette compartment with the window facing up.



3 Close the cassette compartment by pressing **PUSH** on the cassette compartment. After the cassette compartment goes down completely, close the lid until it clicks.



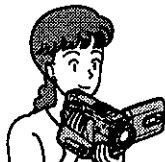
To eject the cassette

Follow the procedures above, and take out the cassette after the cassette compartment opens completely in step 3.

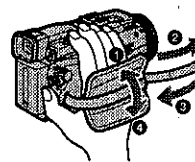
Note

Do not press the cassette compartment down forcibly. Doing so may cause a malfunction.

3 Recording a picture on the tape (p. **)

- 1 Remove the lens cap.
- 2 Set the POWER switch to CAMERA while pressing the small green button.
- 3 Press OPEN to open the LCD panel. The picture appears on the screen.
- 4 Press START/STOP. Your camcorder starts recording. To stop recording, press START/STOP again.

Viewfinder
When the LCD panel is closed, use the viewfinder with your eye against the eyecup. Adjust the viewfinder lens to your eyesight (p. **).

When you purchase your camcorder, the clock setting is set to off. If you want to record the date and time for a picture, set the clock setting before recording (p. **).

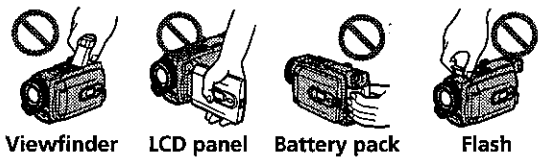
4 Monitoring the playback picture on the LCD screen (p. **)

- 1 Set the POWER switch to VCR while pressing the small green button.
- 2 Press of the touch panel to rewind the tape.
- 3 Press of the touch panel to start playback.

Note
When using the touch panel, press operation buttons lightly with your finger or the supplied stylus (DCR-TRV80 only) supporting the LCD panel from the back side of it. Do not press the LCD screen with sharp objects other than the supplied stylus (DCR-TRV80 only).

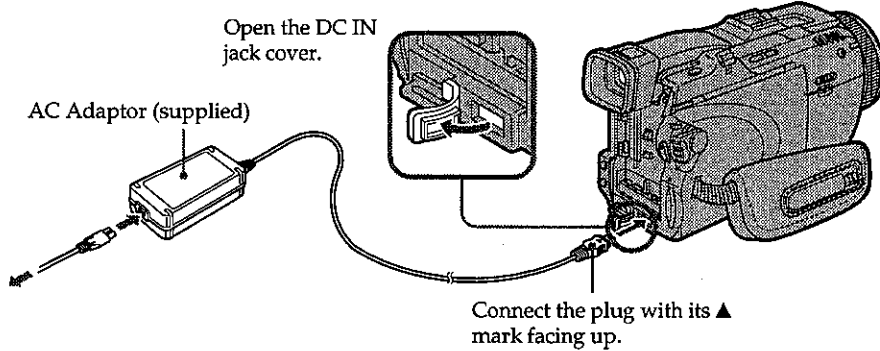

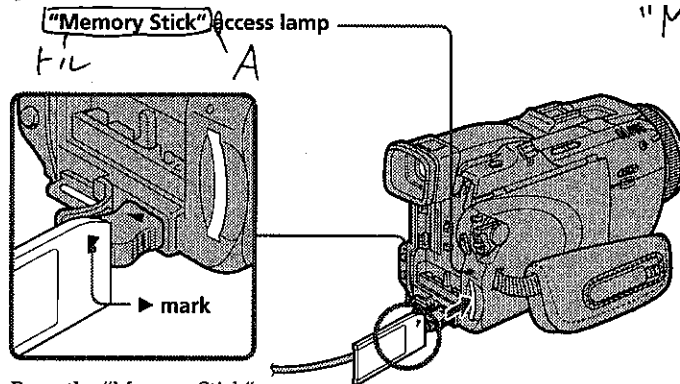
1 Connecting the power cord (p. ●●)

2 Inserting the “Memory Stick” (p. ●●)

Insert the “Memory Stick” in the “Memory Stick” slot as far as it can go with the ► mark facing up as illustrated.

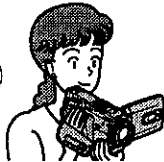


Press the “Memory Stick” once lightly to eject it.

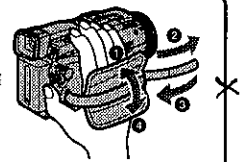
While the access lamp is lit or flashing

Do not shake or strike your camcorder because your camcorder is reading the data from the “Memory Stick” or recording the data on the “Memory Stick.” Do not turn the power off, eject the “Memory Stick” or remove the battery pack. Otherwise, image data breakdown may occur.
