

Troubleshooting

This does n ot prohibit the Arbitrator from giving the winning party their f ees and expenses of the arbitration

Unless You and Son y agree differently, the arbitration will take place in the count y and state where You live, and applicable federal or state la w shall govern the substance of any Dispute during the arbit ration. § 1, et seq., will govern the arbitration itself and not any state I aw on arbitration. The Arbitrator's decision will be binding an d final, except for a limited right of appeal under the Federal Arbitration Act.

Opt-Out Instructions.
