#### LIMITED WARRANTY

Subject to the conditions found at www.sonymobile.com/ warranty, Sony Mobile warrants this device to be free from defects at the time of its original purchase by a consumer and for 1 year thereafter. Sony Mobile will either repair or replace (at its option) the device if it fails to meet this warranty. Printed version of the full set of warranty conditions can be ordered by contacting your local Sony Mobile repair partner.

#### **GUIDELINES FOR SAFE AND EFFICIENT USE**

Changes or modifications to this transmitting device not expressly approved by Sony Mobile may void the user's authority to operate the equipment.

Please check for any exceptions, due to national requirements or limitations, in usage of transmitting equipment before using this device.

#### Taking care of your device

- Do not expose your device to levels of dust, dirt, liquid, moisture or humidity above or outside the intended use.
- Treat the device with care and do not expose it to extreme high or low temperatures.
- Do not use any other accessories than Sony Mobile originals intended for use with this device.
- Do not attempt to disassemble your device.
- Only Sony Mobile repair partners should perform service and/ or remove or replace the battery.

#### Radio frequency exposure

Your transmitting device is a radio transmitter and receiver. When in operation, it communicates with a transmitting equipped mobile device by receiving and transmitting radio frequency (RF) electromagnetic fields (microwaves) in the frequency range 2400 to 2500 MHz. The output power of the radio transmitter is low, less than 0.01 watt.

Your transmitting device is designed to operate in compliance with the RF exposure guidelines and limits set by national authorities and international health agencies when used with any compatible Sony mobile device.

#### Safety and health aspects

- Sony Mobile recommends that the transmitting headset is worn in positions where it will not be subject to pressure since such pressure may result in bodily injury or damage to the device.
- Do not allow children to play with your transmitting device since it contains small parts that could become detached and create a choking hazard.
- Loudness warning adjust the audio volume cautiously when using third-party head phones to avoid volume levels that may be harmful to your hearing. Sony Mobile does not test use of third-party head phones with mobile phones and accessories. Sony Mobile recommends using only Sony Mobile original head phones.
- Check the laws and regulations on the use of mobile phones and transmitting device equipment in the areas where you drive. Always give full attention to driving.

#### Electronic equipment interference

Most modern electronic equipment is shielded from RF energy. However, certain electronic equipment is not, therefore:

- Do not use your device near medical equipment without requesting permission. For use in proximity to personal medical devices, please consult a physician and the medical device manufacturer.
- Check with your vehicle manufacturer's representative to be sure that your transmitting device will not affect the electronic systems in your vehicle.
- Turn your transmitting device OFF before boarding any aircraft or follow the instructions given by the flight crew.

- Turn off all your electronic devices when in a blasting area or in areas posted turn off two-way radio to avoid interfering with blasting operations. Construction crews often use remote control RF devices to set off explosives.
