SYMPTOM	SOLUTION
Hearing Distortion	Lower Volume on your phone/music player/device. Charge your device.
Not Loud Enough	Turn up Volume on your phone/music player/device. Charge your device.
Unable to Pair with Bluetooth devices	Confirm that your phone/music player is Bluetooth compatible. Repeat CONNECTING YOUR DEVICE procedure. Make sure the input password is correct if required. Clear the pairing list of mobile phone or PC and try again.

BLUETOOTH (WIRELESS)

Slide the On/Off Switch to On. The blue LED will flash. (A beeping sound means the device is paired.)

Prepare your phone or device

Go to phone/device settings and turn on Bluetooth.
 Once the device is discovered, make the connection by selecting "SM1 SW1".
 Enter "0000" if a passcode is asked. Once paired, the blue LED ring will light up.

STEREO CABLE (WIRED)

Connect the 3.5mm to 3.5mm plug to the device and a phone or music player. The device will automatically switch to Aux in mode. Then you can playback the music from the phone and music player. Unplug the 3.5mm plug from the device will switch back to Bluetooth mode.

LISTEN TO MUSIC

- 1 Pair and connect the speaker to a Bluetooth device such as a mobile phone and music player. The music player must support the A2DP Bluetooth profile. The music functions available depend on your mobile phone or music player.
- 2 To adjust volume, **Press and Hold** the volume up or down button to adjust volume during a call or while listening to music.
- 3 To control Forward track, backward track, **Single press** the volume up or down button to have "Forward or backward track" function.
- 4 To listen to music from wired audio source, connect 3.5mm stereo cable from AUX jack to music player such as MP3, PC, CD player, etc. You will be able to adjust the track on player only.

Note: Audio content via 3.5mm stereo cable will override wireless audio via Bluetooth.

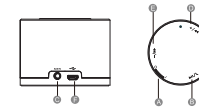
CALL HANDLING

- 1 To make a call, while connected to the speaker, use your mobile phone and dial as you normally do. And double press the "Play/Pause" button of speaker can redial last call directly.
- 2 To answer a call, press the "Play/Pause" button or use the keys on the phone.
- 3 To reject the call, press and hold the "Play/Pause" button for about **1 second**.
- 4 To end a call, press the "Play/Pause" button or use the keys on the phone.

Note: If you receive or make a call while listening to music, the music will stop automatically until the call is ending. To pause or resume playing, press the "Play/Pause" button. To stop playing music, press the "Play/Pause" button again.

BASIC OPERATIONS

CHARGING

Plug your device into computer or laptop via USB cable.

WHEN CHARGING

A red indicator will be on. (Full charge takes approx. 4 hours.)

WHEN FULLY CHARGED

The red indicator will be turned off.

WHEN BATTERY IS LOW

A warning beep will sound periodically.
