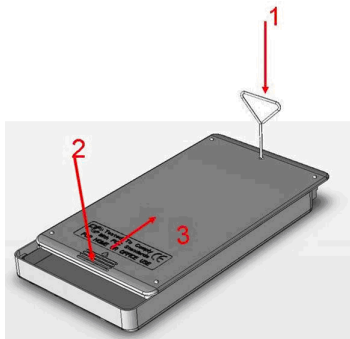

Hardware Installation

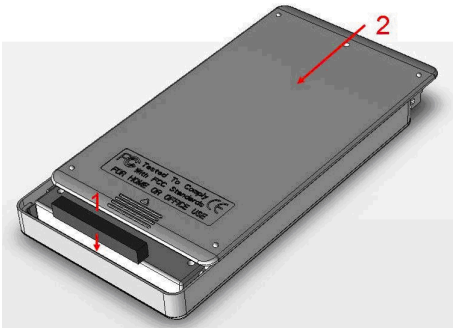
1. Open the case by pinching the ejection pinhole with a small tipped object and sliding off the back cover of the case.



- Place the HDD into the case and slide it into the SATA connector.



- Place the foam to fill up the gap between the HDD and enclosure. Assemble the case by sliding on the back cover. No screw is needed.

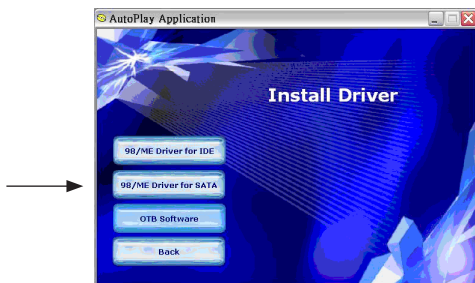


Driver Installation

Microsoft Windows® 2000 or later, and Mac OS® 10.x do not require driver installation, as this enclosure is natively supported.

Installation for Windows® 98SE/ME

1. Insert the software CD into the CD-ROM drive.
2. If Autorun does not play automatically, double-click “autorun.exe” from the CD.
3. Follow the instructions in the pop-up window for installing the 98/ME driver.

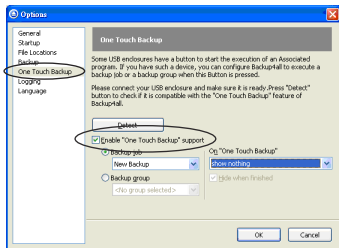


4. Make sure to install the correct driver for your HDD.

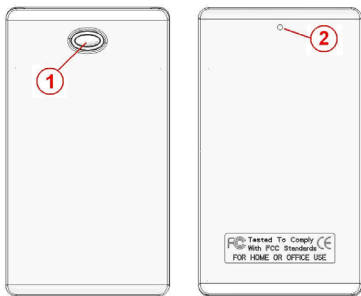
Backup Software Installation

1. Insert the software CD into the CD-ROM drive.
2. If Autorun does not play automatically, double-click “autorun.exe” from the CD.
3. Follow the instructions in the pop-up window for installing the OTB Software.
4. Once the Setup Wizard is complete, the Registration window should open. Enter the Registration Key on the CD and click “Register”.
5. Double-click “Backup4all” icon on the desk-top. Click “Tools” on the

pop-up windows then select “Options”. Check the Enable “One Touch Backup” column.
