### HOW IT WORKS

The Active Download Pod continually monitors the area for signals from Active HandBat readers and then downloads the information to the WebBat system or a terminal program. The device also periodically broadcasts a message telling HandBat devices in the area that it is powered and listening.

### INSTALLING THE UNIT

The Active Download Pod installed in less than 10 minutes on any PC. The steps are as follows:

- 1. Run the installation package for the POD. You must first have Administrative rights.
- 2. Plug the Device into an available USB port. On windows 2000,XP,Vista systems the device will be automatically recognized and installed.
- 3. The device will begin receiving a data in range.
