Operation instruction



- 1. Turn down volume / Previous
- 2. Power on / off,
- 3、Answer / Hung up (Play /Pause)
- 4. Turn up volume / Next
- 5. USB port (Charging or Date transmission)
- 6. Mic for answer the call

Charging for speaker

Please connect it with computer or other charging device via cable line, plug the cable into available USB port on your computer and charging for it. The indicated light is red while charging. It will be turn off after charging finished.

Connect with audio device

- 1. Wireless Bluetooth connection
- ①It will be in Bluetooth status automatically when turning on the speaker.
- ②On the status of searching Bluetooth device, the speaker will say "waiting for connection", and the indicated light will rapidly flash alternately in green and blue.
- ③Turn on the Bluetooth in your mobile phone, then search and find the device named "ARMOR", please click it and wait for connection. The indicated light will turn on blue and slowly flash after connected.
- ①May be asked to enter a password for some lower version of Bluetooth device, please key in "0000" and confirm it.

Thank you for buying ARMOR Smart speaker, and we hope you enjoy it.

Turn on ARMOR smart speaker

Press the Power button for 3 seconds, it will power on.

Play music & Answer phone

1. Wireless Connection (Bluetooth) and play music

When you connected with the speaker via Bluetooth to play music , The music playing on your media device will be automatically transfer to the smart speaker. If you can not hear audio , please check it again and ensure the Bluetooth connection has no problem or turn up the volume.

- ①Press the button of "+" or "—" to turn up or turn down the volume.
- ②Press the call key (refer to view No.3) to pause, and press it again to continue to play.
- ③Press and hold of "+" or "—"to track next/previous

3. Answer telephone

When Armor connected with your mobile via Bluetooth, your all call wouldl be transfer to it, which mean you can answer the phone with hand free.

When you have a call, the voice instruction will broadcast the call number and you can press the phone button to answer the call.

Notice: The music will be automatically paused during a call, then will resume when the call is ended.

Questions	Answe
I can not hear anything on the speaker	Turn up the volume Ensure the speaker is paired or connected with the audio device are playing music.
Can not connect with speaker via wireless	Please ensure your mobile phone has turn on Bluetooth, and the device are connected, please refer to the guidance of "wireless Bluetooth connection"
Can it connect two Bluetooth device at the same time	No, it can not
I hear crackling	Bluetooth is a wireless radio technology, which means it is sensitive to objects between the smart speaker and the connected device. The smart speaker is designed to be used within 33feet (10 meters) of a connected device, with no major objects in between (walls, etc.).

2. How to care for your ARMOR smart speaker

Always store the ARMOR smart speaker with the power off, and far away dusty.

Avoid storage at extreme temperatures as it will may shorten battery life and affect its function.. Moreover, high temperatures may also degrade performance.

Please try to place it in ventilated place, and place it in the place children can not touch.
