# Wireless Keyboard User's Guide

The Wireless keyboard is designed for PC system . With enhanced 88/89 key layout , and built-in Infra-Red technology , the wireless keyboard will be the best companion for your computing world .

System Requirements :

The Wireless keyboard requires a PC-compatible computer with one of these operating systems : windows 95/98/NT

Installing the wireless keyboard on a Desktop computer . Before install the wireless keyboard into your computer , please make sure the back of your computer has two PS/2 ports in your computer . The icons of two PS/2 ports , one for keyboard and another one for mouse . if your computer does not have PS/2 ports of the keyboard's two PS/2 connectors , then you need additional adapters for the connectors to plug into your computer . Please contact your dealer for help to install onto your computer , follow the instructions below .

1 Turn the power to your computer off .

- 2 Your wireless keyboard requires two computer ports , one for the keyboard and one for the point device .
- 3 Turn the computer on and start windows.
- 4 Install 4 pcs AA battery into the battery slot .

### K8225 & K3225 Channel & ID Adjustment

(1)For K8225--under the battery of keyboard, for K3225-at the bottom of receiver, there are switches(please see as Figure 1) for you to set up 16 channels and 16 IDs. If you need to change the Channel or ID, please adjust the switches. (2)Channel Set Up: Please reference to TABLE 1

Set Up: Please reference to TABLE 2. (3)ID

(4)When using environment have interference, the function can't work normally. Please change Channels to make it work normally.

(5) Neighbor users should avoid to use the same Channels to avoid interference.

NOTE:

Keyboard Channel & ID Set up should be as same as Receiver Channel ID Set up, then it can work normally.
