2. Plug the large end of the Micro USB charging cable into a USB port on your computer or other USB charging

3. The LED Indicator light is RED when charging and turns BLUE when the headphones are fully charged.







Using The Headphones

Powering ON/OFF

- Long press the [the button to turn ON and OFF. . Check that your Bluetooth features are turned ON. If you have already paired the headphones with a Bluetooth-enabled device, it will automatically connect.
- If you are using the headphones for the first time, go to the "PAIRING THE HEADPHONES" section of this User Manual, and pair the headphones to your desired Bluetooth device.

Answering/ending a call

- To answer a call, guick press the [ф] button.
- To end a call, quick press the [(b)] button.

Adjusting the volume

• Quick press the [+] button to increase the volume.

Quick press the [-] button to decrease the volume.

- Press the [-] button for 2 seconds to mute a call.
- Press the [-] button for 2 seconds to un-mute.

Playing Music

To enjoy listening to music wirelessly on your Wireless Headphones, make sure you are connected to a Bluetooth-enabled device (see "PAIRING THE HEADPHONES"). Once connected, press PLAY on your Bluetooth device. When playback starts, control the music and volume with your connected device or the buttors on the headphones.

Using As Wired Headphones

- 1. Connect one end of the 3.5mm auxiliary cable to the aux in lack on the headphones and the other end to an external device's heaphone jack (smartphone, tablet, or MP3
- 2. Open a media player on your device and click on PLAY to start playing your music.
- 3. Use the controls on your connected device to centrol music playback and volume.

Troubleshooting Tips (cont'd)

- 1. Make sure your Bluetooth device supports A2DP
- 2. Turn up the volume on your Bluetooth device. 3. You may have to unpair the headphones, then re-pair to your device.
- 1. Press and hold the [6] button for approximately 7 seconds. A tone and the voice prompt "Pairing" will be heard, and the LED indicator light will flash RED and BLUE
- 2. Keep your Wireless Headphones and Bluetoothenabled device within three feet of each other during the pairing process.
- 3. Check that YOUR device's Bluetooth feature is turned ON.
- . Try repeating the pairing process. See "PAIRING THE HEADPHONES."
- Make sure the headphones are fully charged.

- 1. Press and hold the [也] button for approximately 7 seconds. A tone and the voice prompt "Pairing" will be heard, and the LED indicator light will flash RED and BLUE. 2. The headphones are now in pairing mode.
