INSTALLATION:

APT-1320 own easy-to-use and simple installation feature. 1.Plug adaptor into the power outlet (Fig.1).

- 2. Plug appliance into the socket of receiver (Fig. 2).
- 3. Remove the insulating tab on the back of transmitter(Fig. 3).
- 4. Make sure your appliance is turned on, when power is connected, you can turn on /off your appliance by pressing the buttons on the transmitter.

 5.If the indicator light doesn't work, it is possible that the fuse has been burned, to replace a new fuse is required.
- 6. The appliance attached to each outlet of receiver can be controlled individually. .

SAFE CAUTIONS:

- 1. The receiver is forbidden to use in damp area (cellar, swimming pool, etc.) or outdoors(court, corridor etc.)
- 2. The receiver is forbidden to use in the explosive and inflammable place (garage, boiler room, painting room and storage room etc.)
- 3. The power of appliance attached to the receiver can not exceed 1000W, otherwise the fuse in the receiver will be burned, the fuse can be replaced.
