

RADIO CONTROL DRIVING


1- Follow the battery instructions to properly insert batteries.

2- Move robot power switch located on the bottom of robot to the on" position. The lights will flash, electronic sounds will be heard and the wheels will move in reverse spin motion.

3- Place the robot on a clean level surface and it will automatically spin in reverse.


4- To drive forward simply press and hold controller button.

5- To spin in reverse again simply release button.




Use a Phillips head screw driver to remove the battery compartment located on the back of the robot. Insert batteries in the correct position as marked in compartment. Replace compartment cover. Move power switch to the "on" position to operate robot. Move switch to the "off" position when not in use.


