
INSTALLING BATTERIES

WARNING: Dispose of old batteries promptly and properly. Do not burn or bury them.
CAUTIONS:

- Use only fresh batteries of the required size and recommended type.
- If you do not plan to use the Amphibi Car for a week or more, remove the batteries from both the transmitter and the Amphibi Car. Batteries can leak chemicals that can damage electronic parts.
- Never leave dead or weak batteries in the Amphibi Car or transmitter.
- Use only the recommended battery pack and charger.
- Do not charge or recharge the battery pack while it is in the Amphibi Car.
- After you charge or recharge the battery (4 to 5 hours), disconnect it from the charger.
 Overcharging the battery pack might damage it.

IN THE TRANSMITTER

- 1. Slide ON/OFF on the transmitter to OFF.
- Use a Phillips screwdriver to loosen the screw on the battery compartment cover, then remove the cover.
- Put the 9V battery in the compartment as indicated by the polarity symbols (+ and-) marked incide
- Replace the cover and secure II with the screw.
 When the transmitter's range decreases, replace its battery.




IN THE AMPHIBI CAR

Before you use the 9.6-volt battery pack, you must charge it using a battery charger.

Follow the charger's directions to charge the battery pack!

- Place the Amphibi Car on the supplied stand to protect the propellers and rudder while you install the battery.
- 2. Slide ON/OFF on the left side of the Amphibi Car's seat to OFF.


3. Turn the latches on the battery compartment

- Attach the pattery pack's connector to the Amphibi Car's matching connector. Do not force them! They fit together only one way.
- Carefully tuck the battery wire into the battery compartment, then replace the battery compartment cover and secure it by turning the latches clockwise until they stop.

When the Amphibi Car moves slowly or not at all, change the 9.6V battery pack or recharge it according to the battery charger's instructions.

OPERATING THE AMPHIBI CAR

- 1. Slide ON/OFF to ON.
- Fully extend the antenna on the transmitter and slide OFF/ON on the transmitter to ON. The Indicator on the transmitter lights.
- 3. Use the transmitter's control levers to move and steer the Amphibi Car.
- 4. When the Amphibi Car goes outside the transmitter's control range, it stops. Hold the transmitter as high as possible with the anienna vertical to try to re-establish contact. If you cannot, you must move closer to the Amphibi Car to control it again, but be careful not to wade into deep water or strong currents.
- 5. When the batteries begin to lose power, the Amphibi Car slows down. So you don't lose your Amphibi Car, guide the Amphibi Car to shore as soon as you notice it slowing down.
- When you finish driving the Amphibi Car, side OFF/ON on the Amphibi Car and the transmitter to OFF.



AMPHIBI CAR FUNCTION CONTROLS

Install fully charged rechargeable batteries into the Amphibi Car battery compartment and transmitter in the correct position as Indicated, Install transmitter antenna as Indicated.

Move power switches located on the top of the Amphibi Car and front of the transmitter to the "en" position. Fully extend transmitter antenna, Place Amphibi Car on the water surface.

- To drive forward, move "Joystick A" + "Joystick B" upward.
- To drive in reverse, move "Joystick A" + "Joystick B" downward.
- To turn left, move "Joystick A" upward.
- To turn right move "Joystick B" upward.
- To turn right in reverse, move "Joystick A" downward.
- To turn left in reverse, move "Joystick B" dewnward.

IMPORTANT OPERATING TIPS!

Keep radio control range in mind while driving on a lake, pond or open water.

Stand 15 to 20 feet away from water's edge to make certain you will be able to drive your Amphibi Car back to shore.

Simply walk a few steps towards the Amphibi Car while maintaining a safe distance from shore.

You will now be able to drive your Amphibi Car back for retrieval.

MAINTENANCE AND PERFORMANCE TIPS

- 1. Check batteries frequently.
- 2. Always replace with fresh alkaline batteries.
- 3. Check battery terminals for contact.
- To save batteries, always turn switch off when not in use.


