

Digitt T2 Operating Instruction

Operating Modes

There are four operating modes in Digitt T2.

- ♦ Capture mode Capture of images
- ♦ Playback mode Playback of images
- ♦ Menu mode Camera options setup
- USB mode Download of images and PC camera

Control Switches

There are one slide switch and nine pushbuttons in Digitt T2 for controlling camera under different operating modes.

- ♦ Slide switch
 - Locate at upper right corner of back of camera
 - Select of Capture (slide to left) and Playback (slide to right) modes
- Pushbuttons
 - · Shutter button
 - > Locate at right hand side of top of camera
 - > Usage depends on operating modes
 - · Power button
 - > Locate at upper right corner of back of camera
 - > Turn on and off power of camera
 - Menu, Enter, Display, Up, Down, Left, Right buttons
 - Locate at lower right corner of back of camera
 - Usage depends on operating modes

Capture Mode

Enter this mode to take photos and movies, while usage of pushbuttons is redefined as per below table.

Pushbutton	Usage	Description	
Shutter	Shutter	Take photos and movies	
Menu	Menu	Switch to Menu mode	
Enter	Capture	Capture mode: Photos, Self-timer, Movies	
Display	Display	TFT LCD control: On with OSD, On without OSD, Off	
Up	Tele	Digital zoom in: Ix ~ 4x	
Down	Wide	Digital zoom out: 1x ~ 4x	
Left	Strobe	Strobe mode: Off, Auto, On, Red eye	
Right	Image	Large (1600x1200), Medium (1280x960), Small (800x600)	

[&]quot;Tele", "Wide", "Strobe" and "Image" are only available in taking photos, they are disabled when taking movies.

Playback Mode

Enter this mode to view saved photos and movies, while usage of pushbuttons is redefined as per below table.

Pushbutton	Usage	Description	
Shutter	Play	Movie playback control: Play, Pause, Rewind	
Menu	Menu	Switch to Menu mode	
Enter	Unused	No function	
Display	Display	Display mode: Full view, Thumbnail view	
Up	Zoom	2x Digital zoom	
Down	Unused	No function	
Left	Previous	Select previous saved photo or movie	
Right	Next	Select next saved photo or movie	

[&]quot;Play" is for playback of movies only, while "Zoom" is for viewing of photos.

Menu Mode

There are three different setup menus in the camera — Capture setup, Playback setup and Options setup. Options setup menu is always available no matter you are in Capture mode or Playback mode. But you can only access Capture setup menu and Playback setup menu under Capture mode and Playback mode respectively.

1. Capture Setup Menu

The following setup items are available in Capture setup menu.

White Balance	Auto, Sunny, Cloudy, Tungsten, Fluorescent

2. Playback Setup Menu

The following setup items are available in Playback setup menu.

Item	Available Selections / Description
Erase One	Delete current selected photo or movie
Erase All	Delete all saved photos and movies
Protect	Unlock, Lock - For current selected photo or movie only
DPOF	Print 0 ~ Print 9 - For current selected photo only

3. Options Setup Menu

The following setup items are available in Options setup menu.

USB Mode

The camera enters USB mode whenever it is connected to USB port of powered-on PC or Mac. No driver is needed except the camera is connecting to PC running Windows 98. TFT LCD on the camera will always be turned off in USB mode to save power.

There are two USB modes supported – Mass storage and USB video, which can be selected through options setup menu. Mass storage mode is used for downloading photos and movies to computer, while the camera can be used as PC camera under USB video mode.

Operation Instruction
