Powering On Your Smart Car Charger


- 1. Start the engine of your vehicle

Linking your Smart Car Charger to the App

 Tap the + button on the Things tab of the app




2. Select the Leaf Car Charger in the list




3. Sit on your vehicle and wait until the "Next" button appears at the bottom of the screen. It normally takes less than 10 seconds.
