WEB not only gives you the full Web experience where you stay in touch with your friends, obtain information, do your online banking etc., but also saves time by using compressed web pages.

11.2 WAP

11.2.1 Homepage

Launch the WAP browser with the preset homepage.

11.2.2 Bookmarks

Access your favorite sites.

11.2.3 Go to URL

Enter the URL of WAP site.

11.2.4 Open file

Open web pages stored on your phone.

11.2.5 Last web address

Last visited URL.

11.2.6 Recent pages

Pages which you recently browsed.

11.2.7 Offline pages

Pages available for offline viewing.

11.2.8 Service inbox

Store WAP push messages.

11.2.9 Settings

Customize your browser preferences.

11.3 News

It is a huge time saver providing news updates from a website in a simple form.

Once subscribed to a channel, it gives you the ability to track and manage all your favorite RSS content on your mobile phone at anytime, anywhere!

Available options:

Update	Refresh the content of a channel.
Create channel	Create a new channel with name and URL.
Delete	Delete the channel.
Edit	Edit the name or URL of a channel.
Update all	Refresh all channels.

- Settings** Select a regular interval to retrieve updates automatically, set to show images or not, as well as a WAP account to connect to.
- Enable/Disable all auto-update** Activate auto-update or not to all channels.
- Send** Share a channel with your friend by sending it by SMS, MMS or Email.

11.4 Weather

Your phone is equipped with a weather function for consulting up to 3-day forecasts of favorite cities.

To access the function, you can press "**Menu**" through Left softkey to access the main menu and select the .

 Select "**AccuWeather.com**" to access online website, which may charge extra fee.

Available options:

- More information** Search more weather information online.
- Forecast** Display 3-day weather forecast.
- Update** Refresh weather information.
- My cities** List all my cities, you can add new city, set default city, delete the selected city, etc. via "**My cities\Options**".
- Settings** Set unit, update mode and network.

11.5 mTweet

Twitter is a social networking and microblogging service that has gained notability and popularity worldwide. This feature enables phone users to exchange news updates and ideas with a community in the form of messages or posts. Posts are displayed on the author's profile page and delivered to the author's subscribers or followers.

12 Apps



Apps store is an online software store, where you can download and install applications and games to your phone.

You can access this function by selecting "Apps" from the main menu.

12.1 Locate the item you want to download

The Apps store home page offers several ways to find applications. It showcases different kinds of applications in **Featured** and **Categories**.

Featured: This shows pictures of recommended applications. You can select one to view its details.

Categories: This arranges applications under Feature, New, App and Game headings. Select a category to choose the application you require.

Also, you can press the Search tab, enter the name of an application, and then press **Go** to find the result.

12.2 Download, install and manage applications

- Navigate to the item you want to download and select it to enter the details screen from which you can read its overall rating or comments, view developer's information, etc.
- To download an application, you can press **Options\Download** or press **Download** from the application details screen.
- You can check the status of any application that is currently being downloaded using the Download tab. This enables you to delete, pause or resume downloading.
- When downloading has finished, you can manage your application using the Manager tab. You can select an application, and then press **Options\Run** to install it or **Options\Delete** to delete it.



Be particularly cautious with applications that can access many functions or a significant amount of your data. You are responsible for the results of using this item on your phone.


12.3 Update and settings

In the Apps store home page, you can press **Options\Update** to check for and install any updates for your applications. You can also press **Options\Setting** to automatically check for updates at either weekly or monthly intervals.

3 Facebook

Facebook is a social utility that connects people with friends and others who work, study and live around them. It provides a number of features with which users may interact: Wall, a space on every user's profile page that allows friends to post messages for the user to see; Pokes, which allow users to send a virtual "poke" to each other, etc.

To get a Facebook account, please visit <http://m.facebook.com>.

You can access this menu from the main menu by selecting "**Facebook**". You can also press  key on the keypad to enter the Facebook page.

Before accessing Facebook page, you must log in by selecting "**Facebook update status**" bar in home screen, then input your facebook account and password.

13.1 News feed

To access this feature, select "**Facebook\News Feed**" from the main menu screen.

This menu enables users to view a constantly updated list of their Facebook friends' activity, profile changes, upcoming events, birthdays, conversations taking place between the walls of their friends, etc.

This menu displays the following tabs when accessed:

News Feed	Displays latest news or status update of your Facebook friends.
Favorites	Displays the News Feeds of all friends selected as favorite contacts.

13.2 Me



To access this feature, select "**Facebook\Me**" from the main menu screen.

This menu displays the following tabs when accessed:

Info	Displays your Facebook profile information.
Wall	Displays your status and all messages posted from your Facebook friends.
Groups	Displays group information.
Likes and interests	Displays all pages that you like or find interesting.

13.3 Messages

From this menu, you can exchange messages with your Facebook friends.

Select "**Write new Facebook message**" to enter the message editing screen, enter your friend's name or select one or more friends from your friends list by pressing the  key, then enter your message text. When finished, press the  key to send it.

Press "**View**" using the  key to view all the message threads of the Facebook friends you selected.

Available options:

View recipients	View recipients' profiles if there are two or more recipients.
Delete	Delete the current conversation thread.
Delete all	Delete all threads.
Refresh	Data refresh.

13.4 Friends

You can access this function from the main menu screen by selecting "**Friends**".

When accessing this menu, you will see a list of all contacts.

Available options:

- Set as favorite/ Remove from favorites** Select (or deselect) a contact as a favorite.
- Merge to local contact** Merge a Facebook contact with your local contact.
- Copy to phone** Copy the selected contact.

13.5 Photos

This menu displays photos downloaded from Facebook.

Select "**Create new album**" to enter a caption and description, then press key to finish creating the album.

Your Facebook gallery is displayed in albums. The first album will be "**Fan photos**" which is generated automatically and contains all photos where you have been tagged.

13.6 Events

To access this feature, select "**Facebook\Search**" from the main menu screen.

This menu displays the list of all events and the list of birthdays of all Facebook friends.

13.7 Search

To access this feature, select "**Facebook\Search**" from the main menu screen.

This menu enables users to search for a friend they want to connect with, or locate a page they want to view, etc.

13.8 Notification

To access this feature, select "**Facebook\Notification**" from the main menu screen.

This menu displays all notifications from your Facebook friends.

13.9 Settings

As your phone supports Facebook, you can access settings for this feature by selecting "**Facebook\Settings**" from the main menu screen.

Background updates

Select to set the Background updates mode for updating Facebook features.

Logout

Select to log out the facebook.

14.1 Stopwatch.....

The stopwatch is a simple application for measuring time with the possibility to register several results and suspend/resume measurement.

14.2 Ebook.....

A bookshelf contains the electronic books (.txt and .pdb file only). While reading the book, you may add bookmark, or reach the text by searching words, phrases (**Options\Find**, **Options\Jump to**).

Available options:

Refresh bookshelf	Delete cookies from browsing history.
Book information	Display the detailed information (title, size and format) about the book.
Delete	Delete the current book.
Delete all	Delete all books.
Sort	Sort the books by name, type, time or size.
Global settings	Set the font, scroll mode, display format, etc.
Apply global settings	Select to apply global settings.
Help	List all hotkeys.

14.3 Java.....

14.3.1 Launch an application

Select "**Java applications**" to launch applications.

14.3.2 Download application

Download Java applications from ALCATEL ONE TOUCH website.

14.3.3 Java settings

The "**Java**" menu allows you to manage Java settings, in which you may set Java audio, backlight, vibration, network and identify how much Heap size is available.

15 Camera.....

Your mobile phone is fitted with a camera for taking photos and shooting videos that you can use in different ways:


- store them in your **"File manager\ Phone"** or **"File manager\SD card"**.
- send them in a multimedia message (MMS) to a mobile phone or an email address.
- send them directly by MMS, Email, Bluetooth, to Facebook.
- customize your Home screen (see page 83).
- select them as incoming call image to a contact in your Contacts.
- transfer them by data cable or microSD card to your computer.

15.1 Access

Select  from the main menu to access this function.

15.2 Camera

15.2.1 Take a photo, save or delete

The screen acts as the viewfinder. Position the object or landscape in the viewfinder and press  to take the image and the images will be automatically saved. If you don't want it, you may directly delete it.

15.2.2 Settings in framing mode

Before taking the photo, you can adjust a number of settings:

From the photo shot screen, press "**Options**" through Left softkey not only to access: "**Flash LED**", "**Image size**", "**Capture mode**", "**Image quality**", "**Timer**", "**Night mode**", "**Banding**", "**Exposure Value**", "**White balance**", "**Color mode**", but also following ones:

- My creations** • Go to "**File manager\Phone**" or "**File manager\Memory card**" to view the photos you have taken.
- Storage** • You may choose saving location if microSD card is inserted.
- Access video** • Access video recording mode.
- Restore default** • Return all settings to default values.

15.2.3 Options available after taking the photo

Once you have taken a photo, you can send your photo by Bluetooth, Facebook, MMS and Email, assign it to a contact, set as wallpaper, or go to "**My creations**" to view it.


15.3 Video

You can record a video clip of unlimited length, as long as the battery sustains and there is sufficient memory.

15.3.1 Framing mode

When you enter the "**Video**" function, you are in Framing mode. Use the mobile screen as a viewfinder and press "**Settings**" for the settings of **Video quality**, **Night mode**, **Record audio**, **Color mode**, **Exposure Value**, **Resolution** and **Storage**, to **Access camera** and "**My videos**".

15.3.2 Recording mode

Once you have chosen your settings, you can launch the recording of your video-clip by pressing the  key.



If you receive a call in recording mode, video recording will stop and save automatically.

15.3.3 Further operations after shooting a video

After shooting a video, you can choose to send your video by Email, MMS, Bluetooth or go to "**My videos**" to view it.


In the list of "**My videos**", press "**Options**" to rename the video, set as power on/off screen, etc.

16 Profiles.....

With this menu, you may personalize ringtones for different events and environments.

16.1 General

To modify the sound settings, press "**Options\Customize**" and you will see the functions below using the navigation key:

Alert type You may set your phone ringtone to Ring only, Vibration only, Discreet (ring with beep), Vibration (all sounds are replaced by vibrations except for alarms), Vibration and ring, Vibration then ring, Beep and vibration, Silence (no sounds except for alarms, the icon  will be displayed).

Ringtone Select a melody from the list by scrolling up/down.

Ring type Select the type for ringtone.

Ringtone volume Adjust the volume by key.

Keypad Select silence or the type of keybeep.

Message beep Select a melody for a new incoming message.

Power on beep Select a Power on melody for your phone.

Power off beep Select a Power off melody for your phone.

16.2 Meeting

When this is selected the phone will not ring or beep unless an alarm has been set. A new event will cause it to vibrate.

16.3 Outdoor

It is a profile designed for outdoor users who require louder ringtones.

16.4 Indoor

Ringtone/beep volume will be slightly lower than General mode volume.

16.5 Silence

This profile will turn off all ringtones, even notification sounds.

17 File manager



You will have access to all audio and visual files stored in phone or SD card in File manager.

17.1 Phone

An entry to access all files in all folders stored in phone.

17.1.1 Audios

Choose an audio for an incoming call ringtone, a message alert beep, power on/off ringtone, incoming call ringtone, etc.

The "Audios" album contains the following folders ⁽¹⁾:

- Music: full track music.
- Melodies: melodies that can be set as ringtone.
- Recorded: all recorded sounds.



DRM: Digital Rights Management feature allows sounds and images to be played while protecting the associated copyright. DRM counter-based files and files with expired rights will not be automatically played when scrolling the list.

17.1.2 Images

You can select an image or a photo as wallpaper, power on/off screen, or assign it as incoming call image.



The images will be displayed in alphabetical order.

17.1.3 Videos

"Videos" album contains video clips recorded, received or downloaded.

17.1.4 Ebook

A bookshelf containing the electronic books (.txt and .pdb files only).

17.1.5 Creations

This feature stores all the photos captured by your mobile phone.

17.1.6 Received

This feature stores all received files by Bluetooth.

17.2 SD card

You can access all files stored in the SD card here.



When a SD card is inserted for the first time, it will be scanned and the default folders will be created.

Inserting the SD card:



Firstly, release the microSD card holder. Then insert the microSD card with the golden contact downward. Finally, turn down the microSD holder.

Available options

Create folder	Create more folders.

Format	Format SD card.

17.3 Managing audios, images, videos and others

According to the item chosen, you can access some of the functions below:

Send ⁽¹⁾	Send the audio/image/video/Java.
Delete	Delete the audio/image/video selected (not applicable for embedded items).
Set as	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Image→wallpaper, power on/off, assign it to a contact.• Sound→ringtone, message beep, power on/off, assign it to a contact.• Video→power on/off.
Multi-mark	Mark/Unmark a tick on a file for further operation. Press Left softkey to mark all directly.
Download	Download new items.
Rename	Rename the audio/image/video.
Sort	Sort the files by name, type, time and size.
Move	Move a file from the phone memory to the SD card and vice-versa.
Properties	Display part of the ID3 Tag content of an MP3 file.
Activate	DRM file option.
Copy	Copy a file to the phone memory or the SD card.
Delete all	Delete all the files except the embedded ones.
Details	View details of the file.

17.4 Formats and compatibility⁽¹⁾

17.5 Memory status

Indicates how much space is used and how much is currently free on your phone and SD card (if any).

17.5.1 Phone

View available memory space.

Your phone's memory is shared among several functions: contacts, calendar, messages, images, melodies, games and video clips.

17.5.2 MicroSD card

View the memory available on your microSD card.

You are advised to save large files (like songs) on your microSD card.

18 Bluetooth™

Access this feature by pressing "**Menu**" through Left softkey from the Home screen to enter the main menu, then selecting "**Bluetooth**".

To use your phone with a Bluetooth device, you need to proceed in two steps:

- Pair and register the device to your phone,
- Select it to use hands-free communication. Only one Bluetooth audio device (your Bluetooth headset or your Bluetooth car kit) can be connected during the communication.

Pair and register your Bluetooth device

Activate the Bluetooth feature by selecting the "**Bluetooth\Activation\On**" option. Then enter the "**Device list**" menu to search for connectable Bluetooth devices. From the list, select the device you want to pair directly. If the bluetooth device has no keyboard, enter its default password to register it with your phone. If the Bluetooth device has keyboard/keypad, enter the same set of password on both handset and the device to get it registered.

Press the "**Options**" to show service, rename, authorization, delete and delete all from the connected list.



Don't forget to turn on your Bluetooth device and activate the pairing mode while pairing it with your phone.

Available functions

Data transmit Exchange files with another Bluetooth device.

Handle a call Initiate or receive a phone call with a Bluetooth headset.

Listen to music Listen music by Bluetooth headset.

Dialup networking profile Network connection can be activated via bluetooth.



Always activate Bluetooth in your phone first before connecting it to a Bluetooth device. Be aware that Bluetooth activation will slightly affect battery life of your phone.

Bluetooth technology allows free wireless connections between all Bluetooth-compliant devices within short range. Please make sure that the Bluetooth headset or the Bluetooth car kit and your mobile phone are in this range and set as visible.

19 Wi-Fi.....

Using Wi-Fi, you can connect to the Internet when your phone is within range of a wireless network. Wi-Fi can be used on phone even when no SIM card is inserted.

To access this function, press "**Menu**" to enter the main menu, and select  .

To connect and disconnect to a wireless network

To connect a Wi-Fi network, select one of the following two ways:

- Press "**Connect**"
- Select "**Options\Connect**"

If the network you selected is secured, you are required to enter a password or other credentials (contact network operator for details). When finished, select "**Options\Done**".

To disconnect a Wi-Fi network, select "**Options\Disconnect**".

20 Tethering.....



Tethering is a method for connecting a computer or other devices to the internet via an internet-capable mobile phone. They will then be able to share your phone's internet connection.

Access this feature by pressing "**Menu**" through Left softkey from the Home Screen to enter the main menu, then selecting "**Tethering**".



The functions below may incur additional network charges from your network operator. Extra fees may also be charged in roaming areas.

To share your home data connection via a USB cable

Use the USB cable that came along with your phone to connect the phone to a USB port on your computer, and then press USB tethering.

To share your phone's data connection as a portable Wi-Fi hotspot

Your phone will become a Wi-Fi hotspot when you turn it on by selecting the "**Tethering\Wi-Fi hotspot\Switch\On**" option.

Additionally, if you want to save power when there is no Wi-Fi client, you can select "**Tethering\Wi-Fi hotspot\Switch\On\Auto turn off\On**".

To rename or secure your portable hotspot

When Portable Wi-Fi is activated, you can change the name of your phone's Wi-Fi network (SSID) and secure its Wi-Fi network by using a password.

Access this feature by selecting the "**Tethering\Wi-Fi hotspot\Switch\On**" to set or rename the SSID and when you activate the Wi-Fi hotspot, please enter a password to secure your portable hotspot.

21 Others.....

21.1 Calendar



Once you enter this menu from the main menu, there is a monthly-view calendar for you to keep track of important meetings, appointments, etc. Days with events entered will be marked in color.

Available options:

View	See today's appointments.
View all	See all the created appointments.
Jump to date	Input the required date and it will be immediately highlighted.
Go to today	Focus on today's date.
Create	Create an appointment.
Settings	Set the first day of the week and the first week of the year.

21.2 Calculator



Access this feature by selecting "**Calculator**" from the main menu.

Enter a number, select the type of operation to be performed using the navigation keys, and enter the second number, then select "=" to display the result.

Once an operation is complete, you can select "**Clear**" to clear numbers and carry out a new operation.

To return to the main menu, select "**Back**".

To return to the Home screen, press the  key.

21.3 Notes



You can create a note in text format by accessing "**Notes**" from the main menu.

Available options:

- Create text note** Add new text note.
- Delete** Delete note.
- Rename** Rename the note.
- Delete all** Delete all notes.
- Send** Send note by SMS/MMS/Email/Bluetooth.

21.4 Memo



Accessing "**Voice memo**" from the main menu allows you to make voice or sound recordings.

Available options:

- Send** Send by MMS, Email or Bluetooth.
- Edit reminder** Edit the time, mode, and melody of a reminder.
- Set reminder on** Set the reminder.
- Create voice memo** Add new voice memo.
- Rename** Rename a recorded file.
- Delete** Delete the selected voice/sound recording.
- Delete all** Delete all recorded files.

21.5 Tasks.....

Enables you to easily manage and track the progress of a task with priorities. All the tasks will be sorted by due date.

Available options:

- View** View current task
- Create** Add new task
- Delete** Delete the current task
- Mark as done/Mark as not done** Change task's status

21.6 Alarm

Your mobile phone has a built-in alarm clock with a snooze feature. You can set up to seven separate alarms and choose whether or not the alarm should repeat.

- Repeat** You may select **Once** (default)/**Every day/Days** or **Customize** to your desire.
- Snooze** The alarm will repeat at regular intervals.
- Mode** You may select the mode of Ringtone: **Ring only, Vibration, Silence, Vibration and melody.**
- Alarm tone** You may choose one melody or FM radio as the alarm ringtone.


21.7 World clock.....

The World clock shows current local time and the time zone in different cities. You may view up to 3 cities at one time.

21.8 Converter

You can use the Weight and Length conversion by selecting the unit you wish to convert, then press to input the digits. Finally confirm with "OK".

22 Settings.....

From the main menu, select the menu icon  and select the function of your choice in order to customize your telephone.

22.1 Phone settings

22.1.1 Date and time

Allows you to have settings of home city, date and time, including 12/24h format.

You can also set the daylight saving adjustment and activate auto update if needed.

22.1.2 Display

Wallpaper

The wallpaper is displayed when you switch on your telephone.

By selecting "**Wallpaper**" you can customize it by replacing the default image or animation displayed on your telephone.

Theme

This function enables you to customize the graphic style and the colours of your telephone.

Power On/Off

You can customize your welcome animation or image that appears when you switch on your phone.

You can also customize your ON/OFF screen with an image or animation.

Brightness

You may adjust black level with respect to LCD display by using the navigation key.

Backlight

- **Screen** Allows you to reduce brightness for enhanced battery performance and to save power during periods of expected inactivity.

22.1.3 Languages ⁽¹⁾

Display language for messages. The "**Automatic**" option selects the language according to the home network (if available).

22.1.4 Headset mode

Switch audio play (incoming call, message beep, alarm beep...) between **Headset only** and **Phone and headset**.

22.1.5 Keypad shortcuts

Numeric keys

By customising your keys, you can access any function directly from the Home screen.

Combined Fn keys

By pressing Fn key and other keys, you can access some function accordingly. Followings are default combinations:

Fn + B: Access Bluetooth

Fn + M: Access Music

Fn + P: Access Profiles

Fn + J: Access Java applications

Softkeys, Navigation key and side key

These keys have predefined functions, which vary from one model to another (operator services, games access, or Games & Applications...) You can customize ⁽¹⁾ them, assigning the functions, numbers from contacts and URL you wish to each key.

22.1.6 Auto keypad lock

Set specific time for phone's auto lock.

22.1.7 Input method ⁽²⁾

Please see chapter "Latin input mode", page 90. In addition to the specific characters table for Cyrillic, Chinese, other data input modes are also available in your telephone. This feature allows you to write short messages and add names with special characters to your contacts.

22.1.8 Default browser

With this option, you can select either WAP or Browser as the default browser.

22.1.9 Widget bar

From Widget bar, you can quickly access the features that you use the most. When activated, pressing left/right to access application shortcuts one by one, and pressing up/down to access a list of available actions of the selected applications. You can choose to display, hide or edit the widget bar (see page 23).

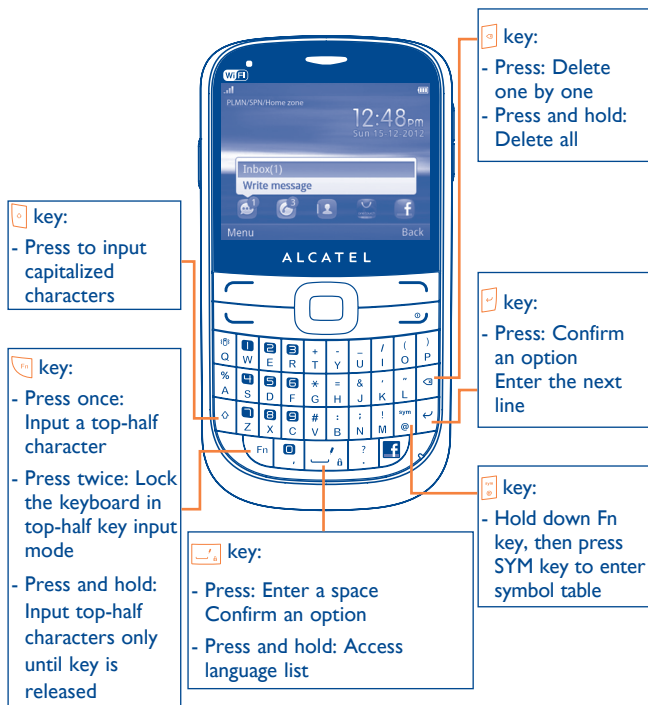

25 Telephone warranty

Your phone is warranted against any defect or malfunctioning which may occur in conditions of normal use during the warranty period of twelve (12) months ⁽¹⁾ from the date of purchase as shown on your original invoice.

Batteries ⁽²⁾ and accessories sold with your phone are also warranted against any defect which may occur during the first six (6) months ⁽¹⁾ from the date of purchase as shown on your original invoice.

In case of any defect of your phone which prevents you from normal use thereof, you must immediately inform your vendor and present your phone with your proof of purchase.

If the defect is confirmed, your phone or part thereof will be either replaced or repaired, as appropriate. Repaired Phone and accessories are entitled to a one (1) month warranty for the same defect. Repair or replacement may be carried out using reconditioned components offering equivalent functionality.

This warranty covers the cost of parts and labor but excludes any other costs.

27 Troubleshooting.....

Before contacting the service center, you are advised to follow the instructions below:


- You are advised to fully charge (🔋) the battery for optimal operation.
- Avoid storing large amounts of data in your phone as this may affect its performance.
- Use User Data Format and the ONE TOUCH Upgrade tool to perform phone formatting or software upgrading, (to reset User Data format, hold down # while simultaneously pressing the power on/off key). ALL User phone data: contacts, photos, messages and files, downloaded applications like Java games will be lost permanently. It is strongly advised to fully backup the phone data and profile via PC suite before doing formatting and upgrading.

and carry out the following checks:

My phone is frozen or cannot switch on

- Check the battery contacts, remove and reinstall your battery, then turn your phone on
- Check the battery power level, charge for at least 20 minutes
- If it still does not work, please use User Data Format to reset the phone

My phone has not responded for several minutes

- Restart your phone by pressing and holding the  key
- Remove the battery and re-insert it, then restart the phone

My phone turns off by itself

- Check whether your phone is locked when not in use, and make sure you don't accidentally turn off your phone when locking it by pressing the power key.
- Check the battery charge level

My phone cannot charge properly

- Make sure you are using an ALCATEL ONE TOUCH battery and the charger from the box
- Make sure your battery is inserted properly and clean the battery contact if it's dirty. It must be inserted before plugging in the charger

- Make sure that your battery is not completely discharged; if the battery power is empty for a long time, it may take around 20 minutes to display the battery charger indicator on the screen.
- Make sure charging is carried out under normal conditions (0°C (32°F) to +40°C (104°F))
- When abroad, check that the voltage input is compatible

My phone cannot connect to a network or “No service” is displayed

- Try connecting in another location
- Verify the network coverage with your operator
- Check with your operator that your SIM card is valid
- Try selecting the available network(s) manually (see page 87)
- Try connecting at a later time if the network is overloaded


My phone cannot connect to the Internet

- Check that the IMEI number (press *#06#) is the same as the one printed on your warranty card or box
- Make sure that the internet access service of your SIM card is available.
- Check your phone's Internet connecting settings
- Make sure you are in a place with network coverage
- Try connecting at a later time or another location

Invalid SIM card

- Make sure the SIM card has been correctly inserted (see page 14)
- Make sure the chip on your SIM card is not damaged or scratched
- Make sure the service of your SIM card is available

Unable to make outgoing calls

- Make sure you have dialed a valid number and press  key
- For international calls, check the country and area codes
- Make sure your phone is connected to a network, and the network is not overloaded or unavailable
- Check your subscription status with your operator (credit, SIM card valid, etc.)
- Make sure you have not barred outgoing calls (see page 45)
- Make sure that your phone is not in flight mode

Unable to receive incoming calls

- Make sure your phone is switched on and connected to a network (check for overloaded or unavailable network)
- Check your subscription status with your operator (credit, SIM card valid, etc.)
- Make sure you have not forwarded incoming calls (see page 45)
- Make sure that you have not barred certain calls
- Make sure that your phone is not in flight mode


The caller's name/number does not appear when a call is received

- Check that you have subscribed to this service with your operator
- Your caller has concealed his/her name or number

I cannot find my contacts

- Make sure your SIM card is not broken
- Make sure your SIM card is inserted properly
- Import all contacts stored in SIM card to phone

The sound quality of the calls is poor

- You can adjust the volume during a call by pressing the navigation key
- Check the network strength 
- Make sure that the receiver, connector or speaker on your phone is clean

I am unable to use the features described in the manual

- Check with your operator to make sure that your subscription includes this service
- Make sure this feature does not require an ALCATEL ONE TOUCH accessory

When I select a number from my contacts, the number cannot be dialed

- Make sure that you have correctly recorded the number in your file
- Make sure that you have selected the country prefix when calling a foreign country

I am unable to add a contact in my contacts

- Make sure that your SIM card contacts are not full; delete some files or save the files in the phone contacts (i.e. your professional or personal directories)

My callers are unable to leave messages on my voicemail

- Contact your network operator to check service availability

I cannot access my voicemail

- Make sure your operator's voicemail number is correctly entered in "My numbers"
- Try later if the network is busy

I am unable to send and receive MMS

- Check your phone memory availability as it might be full
- Contact your network operator to check service availability and check MMS parameters (see page 33)
- Verify the server center number or your MMS profile with your operator
- The server center may be swamped, try again later

The flickering icon is displayed on my standby screen

- You have saved too many short messages on your SIM card; delete some of them or archive them in the phone memory

SIM card PIN locked

- Contact your network operator to obtain the PUK code (Personal Unblocking Key)

I am unable to connect my phone to my computer

- Install ALCATEL ONE TOUCH PC suite first of all
- Check that your computer meets the requirements for ALCATEL ONE TOUCH PC Suite installation
- Make sure that you're using the right cable from the box

I am unable to download new files

- Make sure there is sufficient phone memory for your download
- Select the microSD card as the location to store downloaded files
- Check your subscription status with your operator

The phone cannot be detected by others via Bluetooth

- Make sure that Bluetooth is turned on and your phone is visible to other users (see page 74)
- Make sure that the two phones are within Bluetooth's detection range

How to make your battery last longer

- Make sure you follow the complete charge time (minimum 3 hours)
- After a partial charge, the battery level indicator may not be exact. Wait for at least 20 minutes after removing the charger to obtain an exact indication
- Switch on the backlight upon request
- Extend the email auto-check interval for as long as possible
- Update news and weather information on manual demand, or increase their auto-check interval
- Exit background-running Java applications if they are not being used for a long time
- Deactivate Bluetooth when not in use
