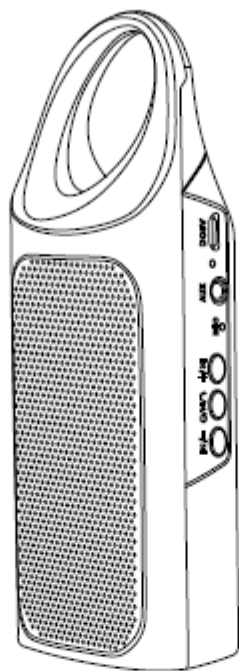

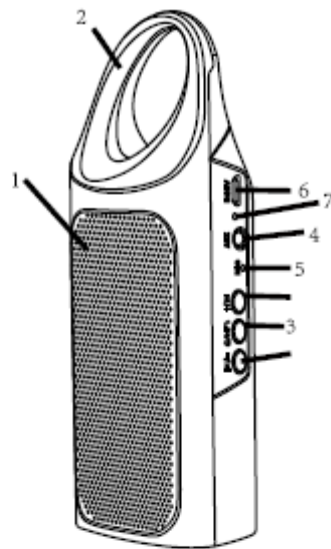

- 1.Mic -Built in microphone for hands free conversation.
- 2.Carabiner- secure,hang the speaker anywhere you like.
- 3.Multi- function button(MFB)- answer call/ hang up/ redial /power ON or OFF button.
- 4.AUX-input port -play music through AUX.
- 5.LED light- charge indicator.
- 6.Micro USB charging Port -charge the speaker
- 7.LED light -operation indicator.

Instructions for use

BT mode

- 1.Turn on the speaker ,a deep sound and flashing blue LED light indicate that you're in Bluetooth Pairing mode .
- 2.Once you have activated Bluetooth on your mobile phone /tablet etc,select the device " 17-B68" from the list of available Bluetooth devices.

3. Once paired successfully, the LED light flashes slowly
4. Choose music from your Bluetooth device and play music wireless through the speaker.

Talking using the Bluetooth speaker

Please ensure that you are paired with the Bluetooth speaker to use the below functions.

1. Answer incoming call- press the MFB once to answer an incoming call
 2. Reject incoming call -long press the MFB button
 3. End call- after your phone conversation ,short press the MFB button.
 4. Redial last number- short press the MFB button twice.
- Note :MFB stands for multi -functional button.

Listening to Music Wirelessly

Please ensure that your device (iPhone, Tablet or Other Smart Phone) is paired with the Bluetooth Speaker to stream music wirelessly. Once it is paired, play music from your device.

1. Pause—A short press on the MFB button will pause the music
2. Play— A short press on the MFB button will resume the music

Play music using "Aux-In"

1. Press and hold the MFB button (Power) for 2-3 seconds until you hear the indication tone.
2. Insert the 3.5 mm Aux in cable (included) in the Aux-in jack of the speaker. And, the other end of the cable, to the audio device (such as computer / tablet etc.).
3. The Blue LED will stay on.
4. Select your favorite song at the source device.

(Note: When you insert 3.5 mm Aux in cable into the Aux-in jack of the speaker, the Bluetooth of the speaker will Turn Off, automatically. Functions except Volume Increase or Volume Decrease can be only controlled through source devices, while playing music in Auxiliary mode. An indication tone will alert you when the volume is adjusted to the maximum level.)

Charging the speaker

This speaker has built in rechargeable battery, When the battery in drained out , device would turn off automatically .You would have to recharge the battery.

Plug the micro USB end of the included USB cable into the charging port. Plug the other end into a USB port on your computer or other devices suitable for USB charging .The red LED light illuminates indicating that the device is being charged.

It takes up to 3 hours to fully charge the device. Once the device is fully charged , LED light would turn OFF

Care and Maintenance

Clean the unit with a soft, damp cloth. Never use chemicals or hard abrasives.

Keep this unit away from wet or damp surroundings.
