

4	LED charge indicator	Red light stays on during charging, and turns off when speaker is fully charged.	
5	LED Lantern button	Short press to turn ON/OFF the LED lantern (to the previous light intensity level), and long press to adjust the required light intensity level.	
6	Volume increase (+) /■	Short press will skip forward to the next track, and long press will increase the volume level	
7		Short press will skip backward to the previous track, and long press will decrease the volume	
8	Power / ▶ / phone button	Power button - To turn ON/OFF the speaker. Play / pause button - Short press will pause or restart the music. Phone button - Answer / reject / end call / redial last number.	
9	Bluetooth / Aux-in mode LED indicator	Bluetooth mode - Blue LED blinks. Aux-in mode - Blue LED stays on without blinking.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Charging the speaker

For best results, fully charge the speaker before its first use.

- Connect the USB charging cord (included) to the DC 5V charging port of the speaker and insert the other end into a port on your computer or similar power
- 2. Red LED glows indicating that the battery is being charged. Once it is fully charged, the Red LED will turn off. It will take around 4 hours to fully charge the

Note: In order to have better battery life, please do not charge for over 6 hours.

Turn On/Off the Speaker

Press and hold the "Power" button for 2-3 seconds until you hear the indication tone. Blue LED light will blink, your speaker is now ON and is entering "pairing" mode

Press and hold the "Power" button for 2-3 seconds to turn off the speaker.

Turn the speaker to Bluetooth pairing mode -

- Press and hold the "Power" button for 2-3 seconds until you hear the indication tone.
- Blue LED light will blink, your speaker is now ON and is entering "pairing" mode. (Note: Speaker automatically pairs with the previously paired devices)

Pairing your device with Bluetooth Speaker -

our Bluetooth Speaker can wirelessly stream audio from any Bluetooth enabled device within the distance of 27-33 Feet. Simply follow the below steps.

- Press and hold the "Power" button for 2-3 seconds until you hear the indication
- 2. Blue LED light will blink, your speaker is now ON and is entering "pairing" mode.
- 3. Turn on the Bluetooth on your Mobile Phone or Tablet or Computer
- It will search for various devices.
 The pairing name of our Bluetooth Speaker is "SL LANTERN SPKR", pair it with this
- If required, enter the password '0000' to confirm to finalize pairing.
- 7. Once paired successfully, you would hear a beep tone and the blue LED light will
- 8. If you fail to pair it within the time frame or you want to pair it with a new device please follows the steps outlined above.
- Select your favorite song at the Bluetooth device and music would now stream through bluetooth speaker.

- Play music using "Aux-In" Jack
 1. Press and hold the "Power" button for 2-3 seconds until you hear the indication
- Insert the 3.5 mm Aux in cable (included) in the Aux-in lack of the sneaker. And
- the other end of the cable, to the audio device (such as computer / tablet etc.).

 The Blue LED will turn on.
- 4. Select your favorite song at the source device.

(Note: When you insert 3.5 mm Aux in cable into the Aux-in lack of the sneaker, the Bluetooth of the speaker will Turn Off, automatically. Functions except Volume Increase or Volume Decrease can be only controlled through source devices, while playing music in Auxiliary mode. An indication tone will alert you when the volume is adjusted to the maximum or minimum level.)

LED Lantern

- Short press the LED Lantern button to turn ON/OFF the lantern (to the previous light intensity level).
- Long press the LED Lantern button to adjust the required light intensity from high to low level; or from low to high level.
