

AA Battery

1. Attach wheel hubs and tires with the wrench tool provided.
2. Open the battery compartment door and insert 4x AA batteries following the +/- markings.
3. Snap to close the battery door.







Thread the antenna through car roof and snap the body top in the direction as shown to the chassis.




- 1.) Insert 1 x 9V battery into the controller following the +/- markings.
- 2.) Set the switch on the controller to ON.




Set the switch on the chassis underneath to ON.




Extend the antenna fully




Trigger moves the car forward and backward.

Clip the car onto the controller for transit.






Tune your car for superb climbing performance with additional motor, gears and suspension available separately. Dress up your car with different body tops and wheel hub also available separately.

To replace motor and compound gear, loosen the screw on engine lid with a flathead screw driver, remove the motor and compound gear installed in engine compartment. Insert motor and compound gear as shown. Close engine lid and screw on.



For Ford F-150 car top, insert the plug as attached into the socket on chassis to have headlights and rear-lights.

Helpful Hints :

- If the car's motor does not respond to the transmitter, move closer to the vehicle and try again.
- If someone uses a CB nearby, it might interfere with control of the car. If this happens, move the car and transmitter away from the CB.
- You cannot operate your car near devices with transmitters that use the same frequency. Check the packaging to see which frequency your car uses.
- If the car moves slowly, recharge the battery, and check the wheel mechanisms for lint, thread, hair or dust.
- If the car is not operating correctly, try changing the batteries. Remember the 9V in the controller will last longer than the 4 x AA in the vehicle.
- When the transmitter range decreases, replace the battery in the controller.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Charger must be operated by an adult only.
- Do not short the supply terminals.

CARE :

The following suggestions will help you care for your vehicle so you can enjoy it for years:

- Never drive the vehicle on a wet floor, on sand, or in mud, rain, or snow. These can damage it.
- Do not expose the vehicle to extreme temperatures.
- To protect the vehicle's wheel mechanisms from lint and hair, do not drive it on carpet.

Modifying or tampering with the vehicle or the transmitter's internal components can cause a malfunction and void your FCC authorization to operate them.

THE FCC WANTS YOU TO KNOW :

Your vehicle or transmitter might cause TV or radio interference even when it is operating properly. To determine whether your vehicle or transmitter is causing the interference, turn off your vehicle and release the transmitter's control levers. If the interference goes away, your vehicle or transmitter is the cause.

Try to eliminate the interference by:

- Moving your vehicle and transmitter away from the TV or radio.

If you cannot eliminate the interference, the FCC requires that you stop using your vehicle.

BATTERY PACK CARE/CAUTIONS:

- If you do not plan to use the car for several days, remove the batteries from the transmitter and charger.
- Do not mix old and new batteries. Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon zinc), or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) or Ni-MH batteries.
- Dispose of old batteries promptly and properly; do not bury or burn them.
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity.
- Keep the package and owner's manual since it contains important information.

Warning: Never play with your vehicle in the street.

Sugerencias útiles:

- Si el motor del automóvil no responde al transmisor, acérquese al vehículo y pruebe de nuevo.
- Si alguna persona usa una radio con banda ciudadana (CB) en un lugar cercano, podría interferir con el control del automóvil. Si esto ocurriera, mueva el automóvil y el transmisor lejos de la radio con banda ciudadana.
- Usted no puede usar su automóvil cerca de dispositivos con transmisores que usen la misma frecuencia. Consulte el paquete para ver qué frecuencia usa su automóvil.
- Si el automóvil se mueve lentamente, vuelva a cargar la pila y verifique el mecanismo de las ruedas para ver si hay pelusa, hilos, cabellos o polvo.
- Si el automóvil no funciona correctamente, trate de cargar las pilas. Recuerde que la pila de 9V del controlador durará más que las cuatro pilas tamaño AA del vehículo.
- Cuando se reduce el alcance del transmisor, cambie la pila en el controlador.
- No recargar pilas no recargables.
- Solamente un adulto debe instalar las pilas.
- No cortocircuitar los terminales de las pilas.

CUIDADO:

Las siguientes sugerencias ayudarán a cuidar a su vehículo para que lo pueda disfrutar durante años:

- Nunca use el vehículo sobre un piso mojado, sobre arena o barro, lluvia o nieve. Pueden dañarlo.
- No exponga el vehículo a temperaturas extremas.

• Para proteger los mecanismos de las ruedas del vehículo contra pelusa y cabello, no lo use sobre una alfombra.
