1. Before You Start

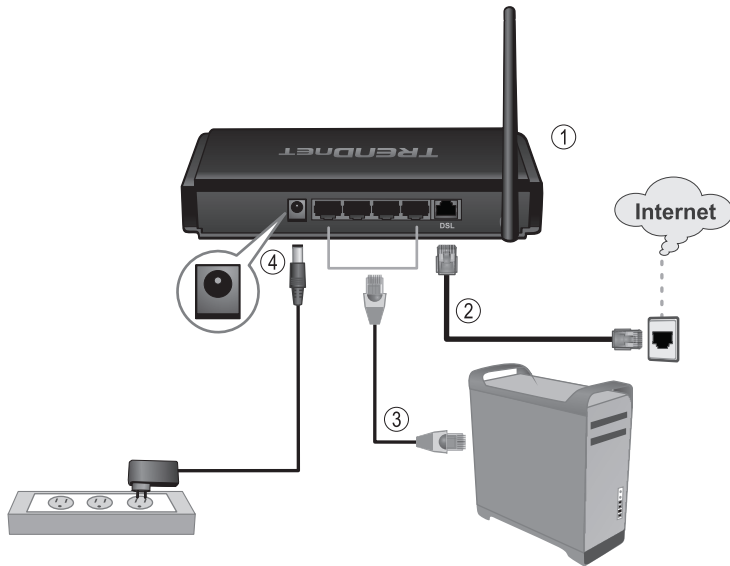

Installation Requirements

- A computer with a wired or wireless network adapter and Web browser
- Broadband Internet

2. Installation

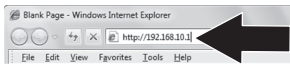
1. Connect the detachable antenna to the TEW-718BRM5.
2. Connect one end of the RJ-11 telephone cable to the TEW-718BRM5's ADSL port. Connect the other end of the cable to the phone jack.
3. Connect your computer to one of the TEW-718BRM5's LAN ports
4. Connect the power adapter to the TEW-718BRM5 and then to a power outlet.



5. Verify that the status LED indicators on the front of the modem to confirm that the device is fully functional: **Status (Green), ADSL (Green), WLAN (Green) and the LAN port (1, 2, 3, 4) your computer is connected.(Green).**

Note: It is recommended that you configure the TEW-718BRM5 from a wired computer.

6. Open your web browser, type **http://192.168.10.1** in the Address bar, and then press **Enter**.



7. Enter the User name and Password, and then click **OK**. By default:

User Name: **admin**

Password: **admin**

Note: User name and Password are case sensitive.

8. The Setup Wizard will automatically appear. Click Setup Wizard if the Setup Wizard does not automatically appear.



9. Follow the setup wizard instructions and then click **Finish**.

Note:

- To protect your network from any unauthorized access it is recommended to enable wireless encryption. Please refer to the User Guide's Guide on the CD-ROM for information on setting up encryption on the modem router.
 - Once encryption is enabled on the modem router, make sure your encryption key is kept in a safe location. Each additional wireless computer/device will require you to input the encryption key.
10. Open up your browser and enter in a URL (e.g. www.trendnet.com) to verify that you have Internet connection.

Wireless modem router installation is now complete.
