



What w ill do:

- Please have your original purchase receipt or proof of purchase (bill of sale or received invoice), the unit's date of purchase, place of purchase and model/serial number ready. The model/serial number information can be found on the back of your unit.
- A representative will troubleshoot your problem over the telephone. If it is determined that your unit requires service, the service location will be at the sole discretion of TTE based upon the TTE Limited Warranty Statement.
- At the sole discretion of TTE, television screen sizes 32" and smaller will either be repaired or exchanged for a new or refurbished/ remanufactured unit.
