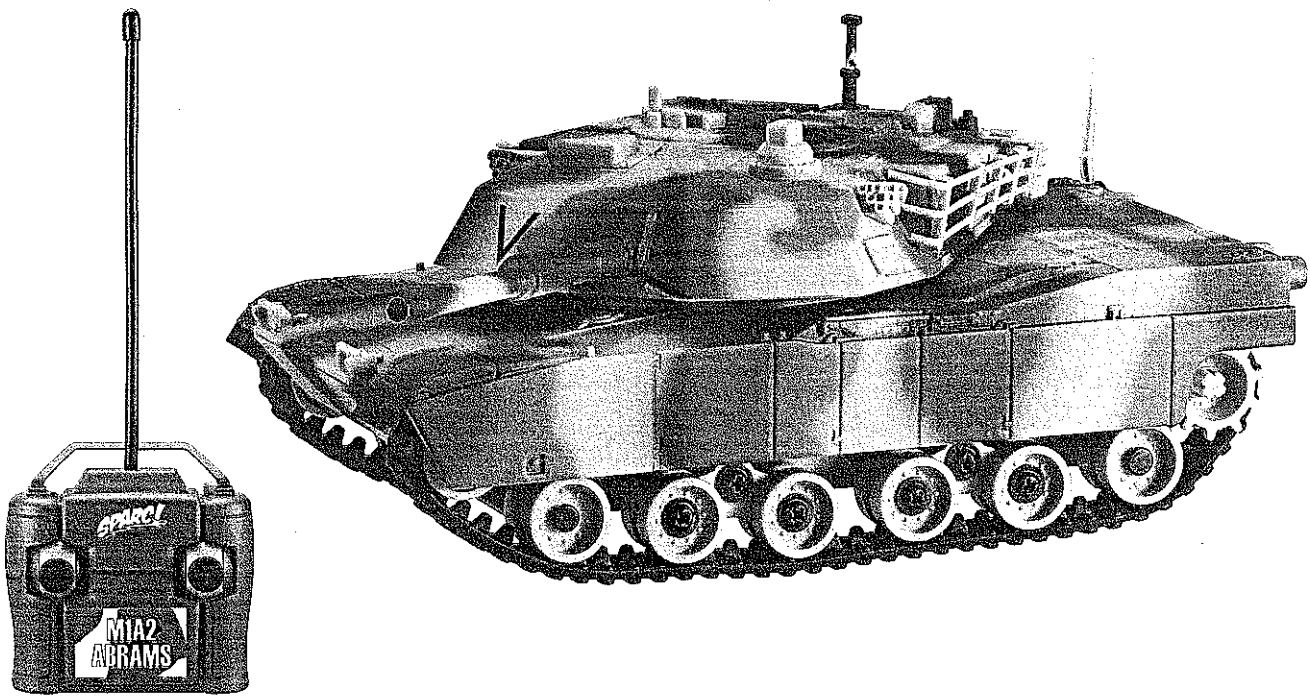




M1A2 ABRAMS BATTLE TANK



OWNER'S MANUAL

Keep these instructions for future reference as they contain important information.

Safety First:

- Adult supervision is recommended.
- Drive your vehicle in a safe area away from people, pets, cars, etc. Do not drive your vehicle in the street.
- Don't touch or try to pick up vehicle when it is in motion. Wait until it stops completely.
- Keep hair, fingers, face and loose clothing away from tracks while the vehicle is switched on or while the transmitter is operating.
- Do not drive your vehicle into walls or other hard objects.
- Be a responsible Mini Abrams operator.

1 Batteries:
Includes 2 x AA alkaline batteries for your Abrams M1A2 Mini Tank as well as 1 x 9V alkaline battery for your transmitter.

2 Transmitter Battery Installation:

- ① Slide open **BATTERY DOOR** on back of **TRANSMITTER**.
- ② Insert a fresh, new **9V BATTERY** with the polarity as shown on the bottom of battery compartment.
- ③ Hold battery in place with thumb and replace **BATTERY DOOR**.
- ④ Check transmitter for operation by looking for the red "**POWER ON**" **LIGHT** on front to light when a **JOYSTICK** is pushed. If **LIGHT** does not come on, check battery polarity. If **LIGHT** still does not come on, install a brand-new battery.

3 Tank Battery Installation:

- ① Slide open the **BATTERY DOOR** on the bottom of the **TANK**.
- ② Insert two fresh, new **AA BATTERIES** with the polarity as shown on the bottom of the battery compartment.
- ③ Hold batteries in place with thumb and replace **BATTERY DOOR**.

4 Transmitter Functions:
LEFT STICK

Left Motor Forward/Release for Left Motor Neutral/Left Motor Reverse

RIGHT STICK

Right Motor Forward/Release for Right Motor Neutral/Right Motor Reverse

ANTENNA

Hold transmitter so antenna points straight up in the air. Don't touch during operation.

POWER ON INDICATOR LIGHT

Note: There is no On/Off switch on transmitter. Moving the sticks turns it on. It turns off after a period of non-use.

FIRING BUTTON

Pressing the orange firing button will "fire" the cannon, emitting a firing sound and causing the tank to recoil, or move backward.

5 Transmitter Operation:

- ① **BOTH STICKS** when pushed up together make the vehicle go straight ahead.

② **BOTH STICKS** when pulled back together make the vehicle go in reverse.

③ **RIGHT STICK** powers right-side tracks. When pushed up (forward) it turns vehicle to the **LEFT**.

④ **LEFT STICK** powers left-side tracks. When pushed up (forward) it turns vehicle to the **RIGHT**.

⑤ **RIGHT STICK** pushed up (forward) **AND LEFT STICK** pulled back (reverse) spins the vehicle to the **LEFT**.

⑥ **LEFT STICK** pushed up (forward) **AND RIGHT STICK** pulled back (reverse) spins the vehicle to the **RIGHT**.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Probable Cause	Correction
Vehicle runs slowly, or won't move, or won't steer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Batteries dead or low • Batteries installed incorrectly • Power switch is off 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Remove and replace batteries, making sure battery direction is correct and battery compartment contacts are clean • Turn on power switch
Erratic operation, loss of control, short range	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Radio interference • Weak transmitter battery • Weak vehicle batteries 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Move to another location • Point antenna up in the air, not at vehicle. Don't touch antenna • Replace 9V battery in transmitter or replace AA batteries in tank

Warranty Period:

Exclusive Warranty- Horizon Hobby, Inc., (Horizon) warrants that the Products purchased (the "Product") will be free from defects in materials and workmanship at the date of purchase by the Purchaser.

Limited Warranty:

(a) This warranty is limited to the original Purchaser ("Purchaser") and is not transferable. REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT AS PROVIDED UNDER THIS WARRANTY IS THE EXCLUSIVE REMEDY OF THE PURCHASER. This warranty covers only those Products purchased from an authorized Horizon dealer. Third party transactions are not covered by this warranty. Proof of purchase is required for warranty claims. Further, Horizon reserves the right to change or modify this warranty without notice and disclaims all other warranties, express or implied.

(b) Limitations- HORIZON MAKES NO WARRANTY OR REPRESENTATION, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, ABOUT NON-INFRINGEMENT, MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE OF THE PRODUCT. This warranty does not cover cosmetic damage or damage due to acts of God, accident, misuse, abuse, negligence, commercial use, or modification of or to any part of the Product. This warranty does not cover damage due to improper installation, operation, maintenance, or attempted repair by anyone other than Horizon. Return of any goods by Purchaser must be approved in writing by Horizon before shipment.
