2. Plug the USB cord into the drive.




3. Connect the other end of the USB cord to your computer.

To Load a Disc:




To load a disc, slide the OPEN latch to the right to release the top cover and insert a disc.



NOTE: PLEASE MAKE SURE THE DISC IS EVENLY AND SECURELY PLACED.

To Remove a Disc:



To remove a disc, press the STOP button on the top cover and wait for the disc to stop spinning. Slide OPEN latch to the right to relase the top cover. Lift the disc off the pivot and remove.
