
Establishing the Connection

The keyboard can be connected to your tablet using the enclosed USB cable or wirelessly via your tablet's Bluetooth connection.

1. Ensure the Tablet Bluetooth is turned "on":



- Pairing indicators (Blue and Red LEDs) will be blinking until pairing is successful. (Bluebooth setting has to be turned on first on your tablet.)
- 2. To connect your keyboard using the enclosed USB cable:



Slide the connection switch on the front of the keyboard to the left. Plug the micro USB connector into the side of the keyboard and plug the USB connector into your tablet.

3. To turn the keyboard off, slide the connection switch to the middle position.



Power Saving Mode

The keyboard will go into sleep mode if it is idle for 10 minutes. To optimize the keyboard battery life, we recommend that you turn it off when not in use.

Charging the Keyboard



- 1. 3 Connect the wireless keyboard to a laptop computer USB port via the supplied USB cable. Power indicator (Red LED) is on when charging the Lithium battery. You can also use any standard Micro USB AC Charger.

- 2. The USB Connection indicator will blink 4 times (0.1 sec) when the keyboard is switched to USB Connection mode.
- 3. Battery life indicator (Red LED) will blink every 4 seconds when the power level drops below 15%.
