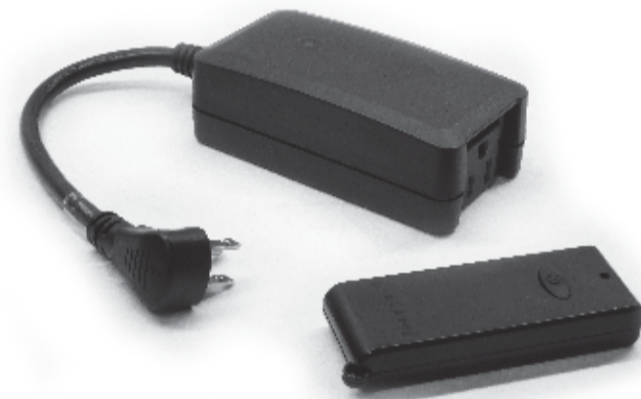

Star Shower Remote Control

Installing Batteries in Remote:

1. Remove battery door by sliding door down. (Figure 1)
2. Insert 2 AAA batteries as indicated.
3. Replace battery door by sliding up until it clicks.

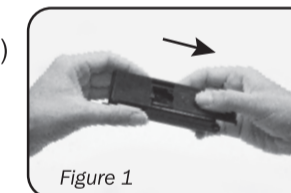

Instructions for Use:

1. Attach the electrical plug on Star Shower to the remote control receiver (Figure 2). If necessary, use an extension cord rated for outdoor use between the electrical plug on Star Shower and the remote control receiver.

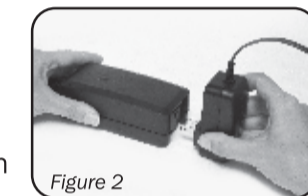

2. Plug the remote control receiver into your household electrical outlet.

3. Select your light mode on the top of the Star Shower unit for either red lights or red and green lights (Figure 3). Light mode must be selected for remote to function. It will not operate if Star Shower unit is turned off.

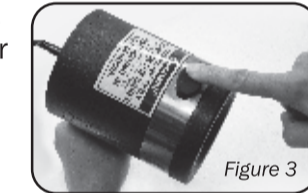

4. Press the power button on the remote control to turn Star Shower on and off. Star Shower includes a light sensor so **it will only turn on in the dark**. To test operation, do so at night or in a dark room.
