


SAFETY AND PLAYING TIPS:

Adults: This toy is recommended for children 5 years of age and older. To ensure that the child's play is both safe and fun, please review the operating instructions and these general safety rules with the child. If there are children under the age of five in the play area, adult supervision is recommended.

- NEVER drive your vehicle on streets.
- DO NOT pick up vehicle while in motion
- Keep fingers, hair, and loose clothing away from the tires and the wheel hubs while the vehicle is switched ON.
- Don't play outdoors during thunderstorms.
- Don't drive your vehicle in sand or through water or snow.
- Do not let your vehicle go beyond the transmitter frequency range of 20-25 feet.
- When you are through playing with your Vehicle, turn both the Vehicle and the transmitter to "OFF". Always turn your Vehicle 'OFF' first before turning the transmitter 'OFF'.
- Wipe clean with a dry towel after playing. Do not use chemicals as they can deform or damage the body.
- The radio circuitry in your vehicle and transmitter is sensitive. Do not store the vehicle or transmitter near heat or in direct sunlight.

BATTERIES FOR THE TRANSMITTER:

- Place all the batteries in the battery box as illustrated making certain that negative (-) and positive (+) poles are positioned properly.
- · Do not use rechargeable barreries in the transmitter.
- . Non rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged
- . Different type of batteries or new or used batteries are not to be mixed
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Remove barreries if the toy will not be used for a long period of time
- Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire. Dispose of batteries safely.
- · For best performance only use alkaline batteries. Battery life may vary depending on battery brand. Toy performance may decrease as barceries weaken.

CHARGING YOUR VEHICLE: Your Vehicle has rechargeable barteries inside that you should not remove from the Vehicle. You can charge your vehicle by either using he transmitter or using the wall adapter. To charge the batteries in your vehicle:

- a) Make sure the Vehicle is in the "OFF" position
- b) To charge by using your transmitter:
- 1. Make sure the transmitter is in the "CHARGE" position
- 2. Place the transmitter jack into the vehicle jack (see diagram A). The red light on the transmitter should turn on when you areach the transmitter jack into the vehicle jack.
- 3. When the green light on the transmitter goes on your rehicle is fully charged
- 4. The transmitter has a built in temperature gauge, if the batteries get too hor, it will not allow you to charge your vehicle. Remove your vehicle from the transmitter and allow it to cool before recharging. Caution: Do not recharge battery if the transmitter is hot. Allow it to cool before recharging.
- :) To charge by using your well adapter: 10 minutes charge / 7-10 minutes play
- 1) Plug the timer circuit unit into the wall adapter (see diagram B).
- (2) Plug the wall adapter into the electrical wall socket
- 3) Place the jack from the timer circuit unit into the vehicle jack (see diagram C). The red light on the timer circuit should turn on when you attach the timer circuit unit into the vehicle jack
- (4) When the green light on the timer circuit unit goes on, your vehicle is fully charged.
- (5) The timer circuit unit has a built in temperature gauge. If the batteries in your vehicle get too hot, it will not allow you to charge your vehicle. Remove your vehicle from the timer circuit unit and allow it to cool before recharging.
- d) Do not recharge a battery pack that shows leakage or corrosion
- 2) Do not disassemble the battery pack. The battery pack is a scaled rechargeable nickel cadmium battery.






