Connecting to AC Power

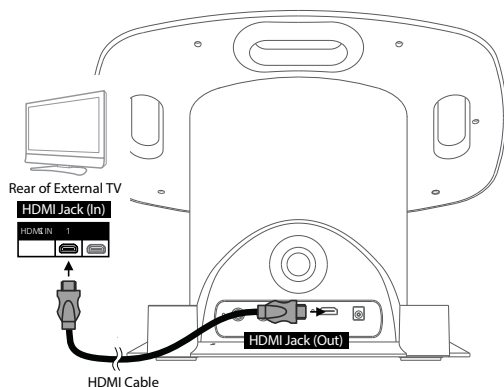


- 1 Insert the DC plug of the adapter into the DC IN Jack located on the main unit.
- 2 Insert the AC adapter into a conveniently located AC outlet having 120V AC, 60Hz.
- 3 Secure the power cord into the pre-installed Power Cord Clamps.

NOTE:

- Make all connections prior to plugging the AC adaptor into a power outlet.
- The AC adaptor has a polarized plug that fits into the AC outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit properly, turn it over and try again. Do not force and do not file or cut the wide blade.

Connecting the Unit to a TV



The video and lyrics will be displayed on the built-in screen. You may also want to connect a TV to display a larger image (follow the steps below):

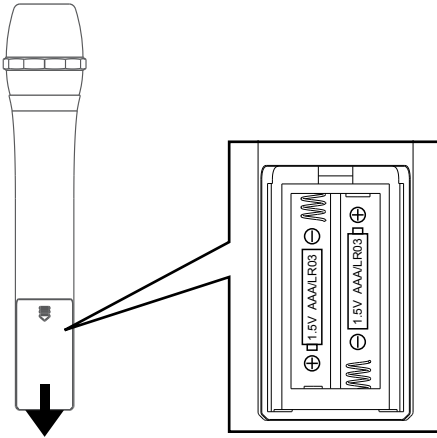
Plug the HDMI cable (not included) into the HDMI Jack on the back of the unit. Plug the other end of the HDMI cable into the HDMI input on your TV.

NOTES:

- This unit can be used with or without a TV.
- Also refer to the TV's or external unit's User Guide.
- Audio and mic input cannot be output to your TV.

Connections

Changing the Wireless Microphone's Battery



When the wireless mic batteries are low the battery indicator will flash. Change the batteries as follows:

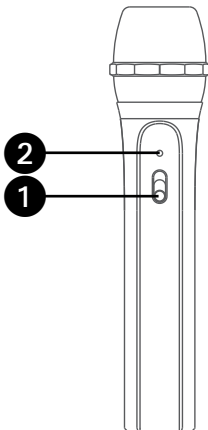
- 1 Slide the battery door in the direction the arrow indicate to reveal the battery compartment.
- 2 Replace the batteries with 2 x "AAA" size/LR03 battery (not included).
- 3 Replace cover tightly before operating.

Battery Precautions

The precautions below should be followed when using batteries in this device:

1. Use only the size and type of batteries specified.
2. Be sure to follow the correct polarity when installing the batteries as indicated in the battery compartment. Reversed batteries may cause damage to the device.
3. Do not mix different types of batteries together (e.g. Alkaline and Carbon Zinc) or old batteries with fresh ones.
4. If the device is not to be used for a long period of time, remove the batteries to prevent damage or injury from possible battery leakage.
5. Do not try to recharge batteries not intended to be recharged, they can overheat and rupture. (Follow battery manufacturer's directions.)
6. Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the product before being charged.
7. Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
8. Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the product.

Connecting the Wireless Microphone(s)



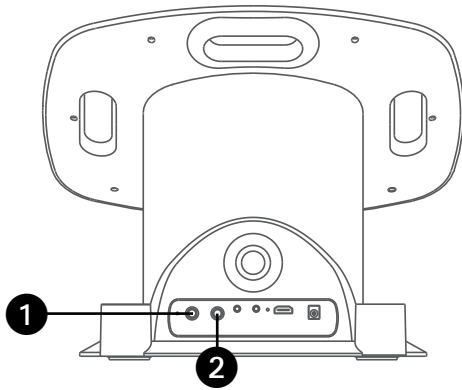
Slide the Wireless Mic's **ON/MUTE/OFF** switch to the **ON** position. The Mic power indicator **2** will light solid.

NOTES:

- Working distance of up to 66 feet/20 meters in open space.
- If there is no audio input for 15 minutes, the wireless mics connection will automatically turn off. Press and rotate the **VOLUME/EFFECTS** control to reactivate the connection.
- Sliding the switch to **MUTE** will temporarily stop the microphone input.

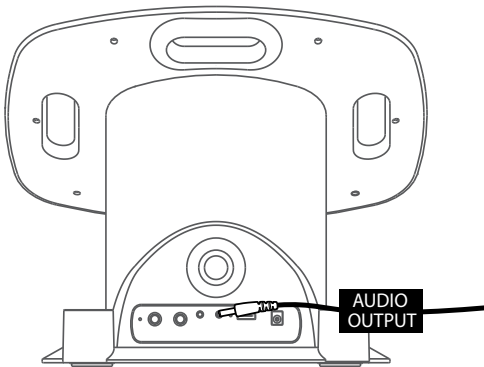
Connecting the Microphone(s)



Connect the wired microphone (not included) into Mic jack **1** or **2** (when desired).

NOTE: Maximum of two microphones (wired or wireless) can be connected to the unit at one time. After inserting the wired microphone (Mic 3), the wireless microphone 1 (Mic 1) will be turned off automatically.

Connecting to Line Out Jack



This unit can be connected to another audio system for greater audio output via 3.5mm AUX cord (not included).

Plug one end of AUX cord into the **LINE OUT** jack located on the rear of the machine.

Plug the other end of the AUX cord into the Line In jack on your separate audio device. You may need to refer the instructions of your separate audio device for more details.

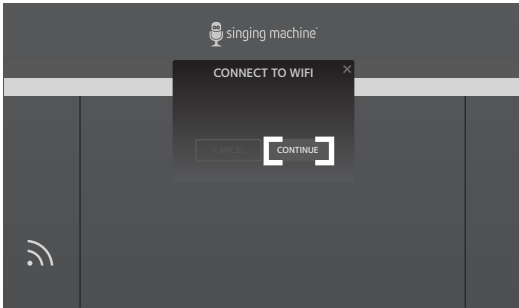
Energy Saving (Auto Power System-APS)

This unit will automatically turn to Screen Saver mode after 15 minutes of inactivity, and automatically turn off after 10 minutes. The unit can be powered back on by pressing the **⏻** (ON/STANDBY) button once. APS is for energy saving purposes.

NOTE: You can change the energy saving setting in the **Screensave** option, see the section of **Wi-Fi & setting**.

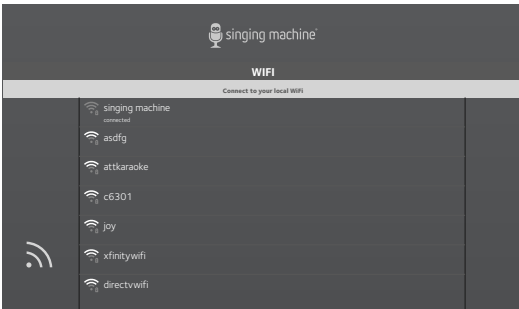

Wi-Fi & Settings

Connect the unit as described previously. Press the **⏻** button to turn the unit on. The set up Wi-Fi connection window will pop up. Select **CONTINUE** on the touch screen.

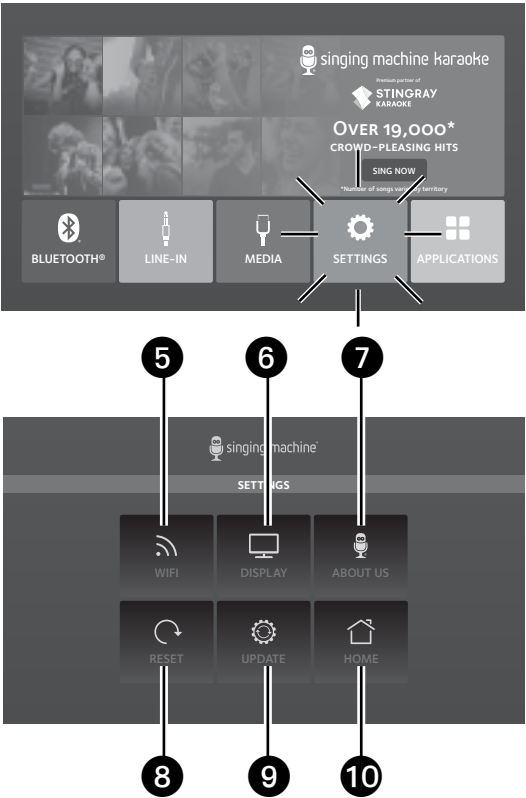
Select your Wi-Fi network using the touch screen.

Use the keyboard on the touch screen to enter your Wi-Fi password and press the **ENTER** button. “**Connected**” will appear if the connection is successful. If unsuccessful, check your password and Wi-Fi frequency and re-connect.

4 You can always change the Wi-Fi network, by selecting the **SETTINGS** icon on the touch screen to enter Wi-Fi settings mode.

5 Select **WIFI** and connect as previously described, if you want to connect to another network.

6 To adjust the language, brightness, sleep time, HDMI, screen, time setting and screensave select **DISPLAY**.

7 Select **ABOUT US** to check the current version and serial number of this unit.

8 Select **RESET** to reset this unit to factory settings.

9 Select **UPDATE** to set the date and time.

10 Select **HOME** to go to main menu.

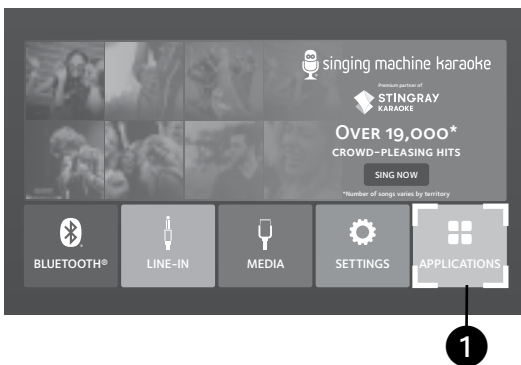

- 4 Select your favorite songs using the touch screen to playback.

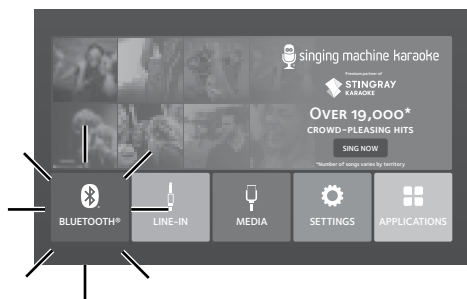

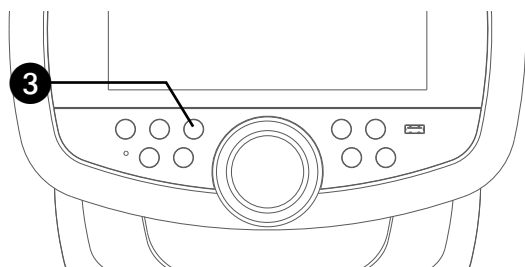
2 RECORD YOUR SINGING PERFORMANCE

During music playback, press the **REC** button to record your singing and the music. Recording will begin and the recording indicator will appear on-screen.

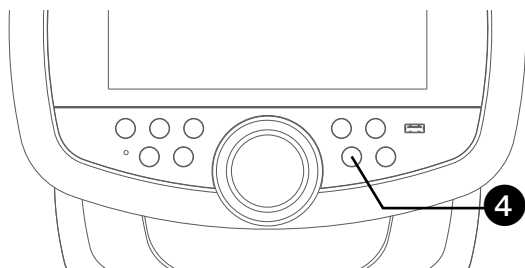

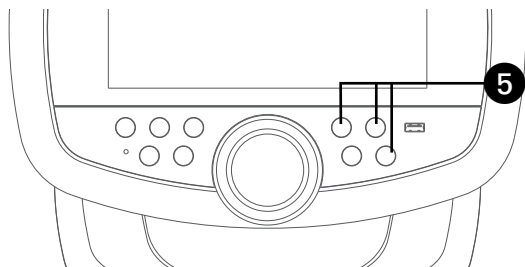
3 There are 9 built-in light modes. Repeatedly press  button to switch between lighting effects.



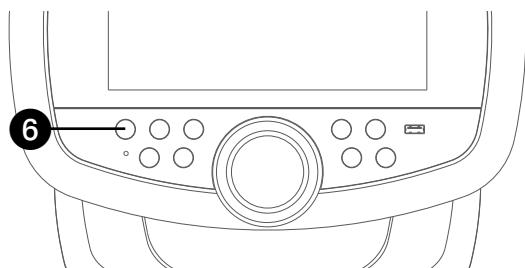

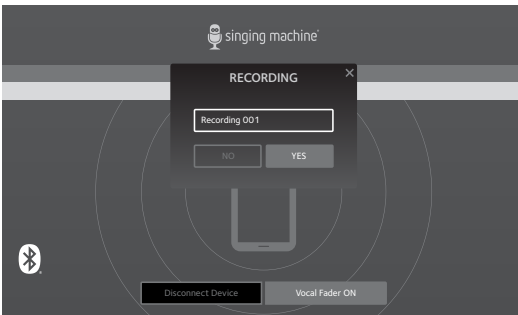
Record songs



1 During music playback, press the **REC** button to record your singing and the music. A timer will appear on the screen.



2 Press the **REC** button again to stop recording. A box will pop up to choose **Delete** or **Save**.



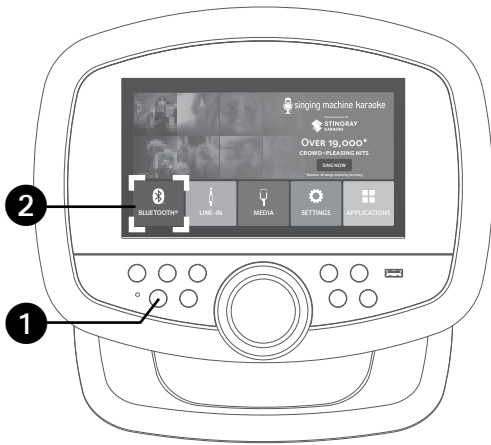
3 If selected **Save** the rename box and save box will pop up.

NOTES:

- You can save the recorded vocals and music to the built-in memory or USB flash drive.
- If the recorded audio files will be recorded on a USB drive, Insert a USB flash drive into the USB port on the unit.

Using a Bluetooth Device

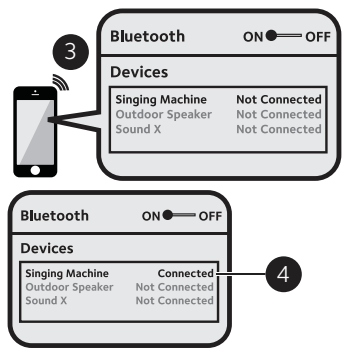


1 Connect the unit as described previously. Press the **⏻** button to turn the unit on.

2 Select **BLUETOOTH** to enter the bluetooth mode.

3 Turn on your device's Bluetooth option in settings to search for a discoverable device with a Bluetooth signal. Select "**SINGING MACHINE**" from the device results on the Bluetooth menu.

NOTE: Also refer to the user manual of your Bluetooth device for detailed instructions.



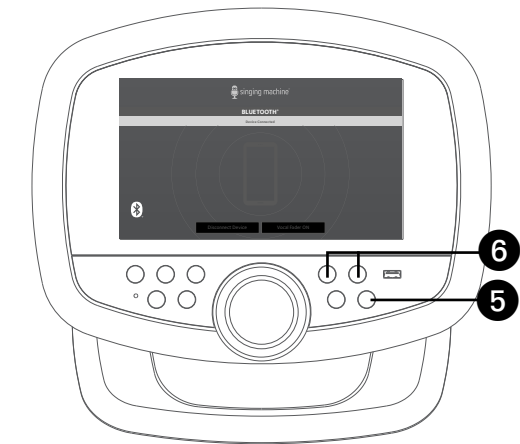
4 The screen will show that your Bluetooth device is connected.

NOTES:

- If your Bluetooth prompts you for a passcode during the pairing process, please enter "0000" to connect.
- On some Bluetooth devices, once pairing is complete, select your Bluetooth device as "Use as Audio Device" or similar.
- If connection is lost after successful pairing, check to make sure the distance between speaker and Bluetooth enabled device does not exceed 30 feet/10 meters.

Using a Bluetooth Device (Continued)



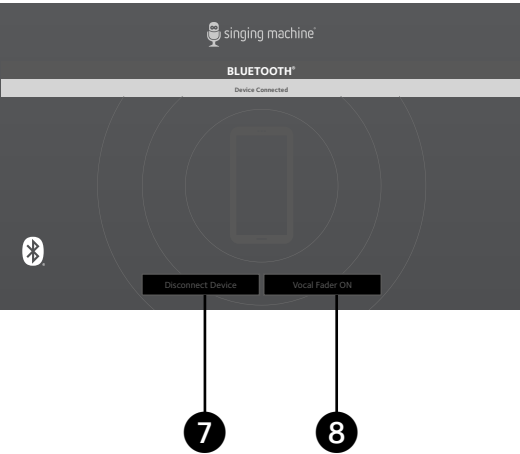
5 To control your Bluetooth device from this unit, press the ►|| button to start playback (music app must be open). Press the ►|| button during playback to pause the song.

6 **SKIP:** Advance or go back one track by pressing the ◀◀ or ▶▶ button.

7 Press **Disconnect Device** to disconnect the bluetooth connection.

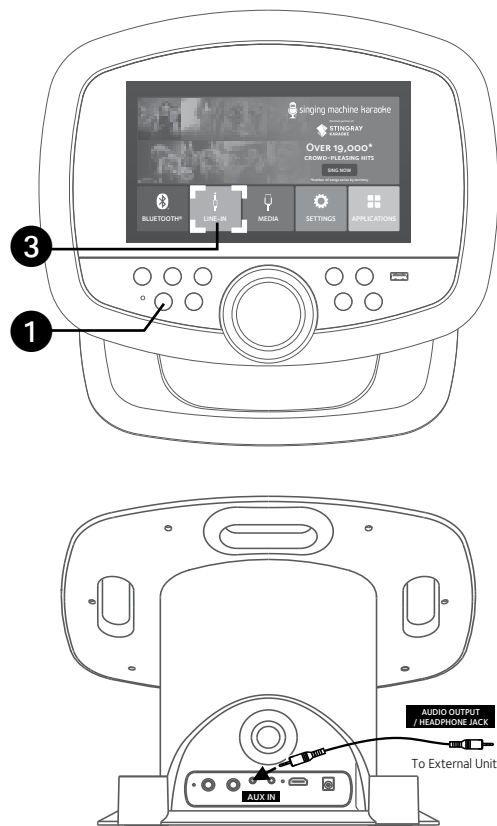
8 To sing without the lead singer on the recording, press the **Vocal Fader OFF**. To resume the lead singer, press **Vocal Fader ON**.

NOTE: Lead vocal removal might work better on some songs than others.



Operation

Using the LINE IN Jack



1 Connect the unit as described previously. Press the **⏻** button to turn the unit on.

2 Connect the external device by using an appropriate cable (3.5mm audio cable not included) to the **LINE IN Jack** on the rear of this unit as previous described. Connecting an external unit will allow the audio to be played through your Singing Machine.

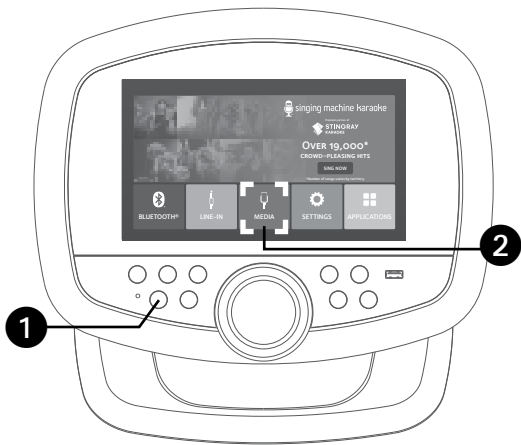
NOTES:

- It is highly recommended to set the volume on the auxiliary unit to 1/3 or lower to avoid distortion.
- Skipping files/tracks is not possible on this unit when using an external device.

3 Select **LINE IN** to enter the line in mode.

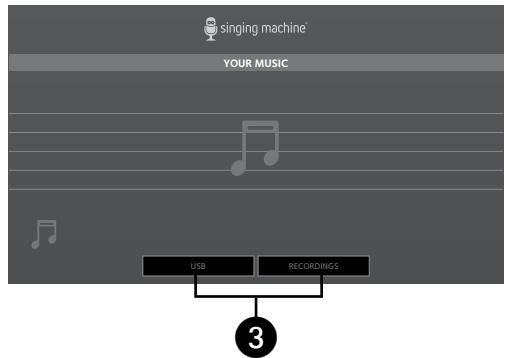
Operation

Playing Songs from the Recorded Files



1 Connect the unit as described previously. Press the **⏻** button to turn the unit on.

2 Select **MEDIA** to enter.



3 Press **USB** or **RECORDINGS** to choose your desired playlist.

NOTE: If the audio file to be played is recorded on a USB flash drive, please insert the USB flash drive into the USB port of this unit.



4 Use the touch screen or the **⏮** or **⏭** button to select a recorded audio file from the song list. Press once on touch screen or **⏭** to start playing the audio file. Press **⏮** on the touch screen or **⏭** on the control panel buttons during playback to pause the file.

NOTE: To delete a file, press and hold the file on the touch screen.

Troubleshooting Guide

Should this unit exhibit a problem, check the following before seeking service:

No Power

- Power is not on; press the  button to turn power on.
- Confirm that the AC adapter is connected securely to the rear of the unit.
- Connect the unit to a different outlet.
- The normal function of the product may be disturbed by strong Electro-Magnetic Interference. If so, simply restart the product to resume normal operation by following the instruction manual. In case the function could not resume, please use the product in another location.

No Sound – General

- Music Volume is set to minimum; raise volume.
- If using an external device, raise the volume.

No sound from the microphone

- Make sure the microphone is firmly connected to the MIC 1 or MIC 2 jack.
- Make sure the mic's **ON/OFF** switch is set to the ON position.
- Make sure the **MIC VOLUME/ECHO** control is not set too low.

File(s) on USB jack not playing

- The file is corrupted; replace the file.
- The file is not in a format this unit will play.
- The connected USB device is not supported by the product.

The Bluetooth device cannot be paired or connected with the unit

- Ensure any other Bluetooth devices are turned off to avoid accidental pairing.
- You have not activated the Bluetooth function of your device; see page E16 or refer to the Bluetooth device user's manual.
- The system is not in pairing mode; press and hold the  button to restart pairing.

The Music is not available on the unit after successfully connecting the Bluetooth

- Ensure your Bluetooth device can support the A2DP Bluetooth profile.
- The volume on the external Bluetooth device is set too low or muted; raise as desired.

The unit will not record

- No USB drive inserted or the USB drive is full. Move all recordings to your computer to make room.

Failed to connect to the Wi-Fi network

- The unit is not within the Wi-Fi signal range.
- Ensure the unit's Wi-Fi signal has NOT been turned off.
- Ensure you have entered the correct password.
- WPA3 security settings can cause connection issues. If you have WPA3 security, we recommend lowering to WPA2 or lower. Or contact us for further help.

Troubleshooting Guide (Continued)

No Internet connection

- Ensure the unit is not too far from your router (recommended maximum of 10 meters). If the Wi-Fi signal strength is weak, the password might not be verified as correct.
- The unit Date and Time have been set to synchronise to internet time by default. In the event that "Automatic date & time" (under Settings menu) function is set to OFF, you will need to set the date and time manually. If Date and Time have not been set correctly (e.g. December 31, 1969), you might not be able to access some websites.
- If the unit's Wi-Fi is connected to the router successfully. But you still cannot connect to the internet. You might need to check the Router's settings to verify if that the unit is not restricted from going online. You are highly recommended to refer to your router's instruction manual.
- To ensure the unit's Wi-Fi function works fine, you can connect your unit's Wi-Fi to your mobile device's hotspot with data service.
- If the Singing Machines unit's Wi-Fi is connected to the router successfully. But you still cannot connect to the internet. You might need to check for any internet connection problems on your router. Or check out the router's settings to verify if the unit is blocked from going online. You are highly recommended to refer to your router's instruction manual.
- To ensure the unit's Wi-Fi function works fine, you can connect your unit's Wi-Fi to your mobile device's hotspot with data service to verify.

7. Ne bloquez pas les ouvertures d'aération. Installez conformément selon les consignes du fabricant.
8. N'installez pas à proximité de sources de chaleur telles que les radiateurs, registres d'air chaud, cuisinières, ou autres appareils (notamment des amplificateurs) produisant de la chaleur.
9. Ne nuisez pas à la fonction de sécurité de la fiche polarisée ou de mise à la terre. Une fiche polarisée est dotée de deux broches dont l'une est plus large que l'autre. Une fiche de mise à la terre est dotée de deux broches et d'une troisième broche de mise à la terre. La broche la plus large ou la troisième broche est conçue pour votre sécurité. Lorsque la broche fournie ne convient pas à la prise, consultez un électricien afin de remplacer la prise défectueuse.
10. Protégez le cordon d'alimentation afin que personne ne marche dessus ou le pince, particulièrement au niveau des broches, de la prise et du point où ils sortent de l'appareil.
11. Utilisez seulement les accessoires spécifiés par le fabricant.
12. Utilisez seulement avec un chariot, une sellette, un trépied, un support ou une table. Lorsqu'un chariot est utilisé, prenez garde

de ne pas déplacer la combinaison chariot/ appareil pour éviter toute blessure causée par un renversement.

13. Débranchez cet appareil durant un orage ou lorsqu'il n'est pas utilisé pendant de longues périodes.
14. Confiez toutes les réparations à un technicien compétent. La réparation s'avère nécessaire lorsque l'appareil a été endommagé, par exemple, si le cordon d'alimentation ou la fiche a été endommagé, du liquide a été renversé ou des objets sont tombés dans l'appareil, ou si l'appareil a été exposé à la pluie ou à l'humidité, ne fonctionne pas normalement, ou a été échappé.
15. **AVERTISSEMENT :** Pour réduire le risque d'électrocution, évitez d'exposer l'appareil à la pluie ou à l'humidité. Ne déposez pas d'objets remplis d'eau, tels qu'un vase, sur l'appareil.
16. La fiche de secteur c.a. est utilisée pour débrancher l'appareil et doit être facilement accessible et utilisable durant l'usage prévu. Afin de couper complètement l'alimentation de l'appareil, la fiche de secteur doit être complètement débranchée de la prise c.a.
