
SETTING UP YOUR CHAR-G

Not for children under 3 years




HUB CAPS: Gently snap off the hub caps from their plastic holding frame. Carefully press the large hubcaps into the rear tires and the smaller hub caps. into the front tires.






CHARGING: Only charge the car when it is: drained of power and has stopped running. Push the "ON/OFF" switch underneath the car to "CH/OFF". Insert. the plug on the handset. onto your Char-Gis. charging socket.



CHARGING (CONT.): Hold Char-G onto the handset and press either. button on the handset. When the green light goes out after 45 seconds, remove the car and flick the switch on the car's. base to the "ON" position. Char-G is ready for action! If the car runs for less than 1. minute after a full charge. replace handset batteries.



RECHARGEABLE BATTERY: There is a small rechargeable battery pack located inside of Char-G. You should be able to recharge your Char-G numerous times without the need to change the battery pack. Should you find your Char-G no longer holds a charge, it is time to replace the rechargeable battery pack. Contact Tomy via email at "consumer@tomy.com" for information about how to purchase a new pack. To access the pack located inside your Char-G race car, remove the three screws on the underside of the car located in the positions shown on diagram to the left. Remove body of car from chassis. Rechargeable battery pack is located at rear of chassis. The pack contains rechargeable Nickel-Metal Hydride cylindrical ceil batteries. Contact your local recycling center for information on where to return the used batteries.
